

A USB-C charging cable (charge only) is included for standard USB compatible device. Please use a 5V/1A or above power adapter (not included). Caution: - Other incompatible charges may cause damages. - Do not use if the connector or device is wet or damaged.</p> <p><b>Power On/Off</b></p> <p>To turn on the speaker, press and hold the Power On/Off Button for 2 seconds, you will hear a power on tone. To turn off the speaker, press and hold the Power On/Off Button for 2 seconds, you will hear a power off tone. Caution: If no Bluetooth device is connected, the speaker will turn off in 5 minutes.</p>	<p><b>Bluetooth Connection</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When first used and turned on, the speaker will automatically enter a waiting mode for connection.</li> <li>• If the Bluetooth device is already connected, long press "▶" button to disconnect the current connection so that you can connect to another device.</li> <li>• The speaker will automatically enter pairing mode if it is not connected to a Bluetooth device.</li> </ul> <p><b>Volume Control</b></p> <p>Short press the "+ " button to turn up the volume. Short press the "- " button to turn down the volume.</p> <p><b>USB IN (Audio) Playback</b></p> <p>When speaker is on and USB drive is inserted, USB IN (Audio) is the priority playback source. If you want to use Bluetooth function, press the "O" button to switch the source.</p> <p><b>Music Control</b></p> <p>Short press "▶" music can be played or paused. Long press "▶" to go to the previous song. Long press "+ " to go to the next song.</p> <p><b>Micro SD Card Playback</b></p> <p>When speaker is on and micro SD card (not included) is inserted, micro SD card is the priority playback source. If you want to use Bluetooth function, press the "O" button to switch the source.</p>	<p><b>Call Mode</b></p> <p>Answer a call: Short press the "▶" button. End the call: Short press the "▶" button. Reject/return a call: Double click the "▶" button.</p> <p><b>Connect Two Speakers, Stereo Mode (Same Model Only)</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Turn on two Shock speakers and do not connect to a Bluetooth device (such as a mobile phone).</li> <li>2. Double click the "O" button on one of the speakers twice, and you will hear a voice prompt. The two speakers will automatically pair. After the connection is successful, the blue indicator light is flashing the main speaker , and the blue indicator light long on the secondary .</li> <li>3. Enable the Bluetooth function of the mobile phone, search for "Monster Shock" and connect. After the connection is successful, you will hear a voice prompt, the blue indicator light long on the main speaker , and the blue indicator light long on the secondary .</li> <li>4. To exit TWS pairing mode, double click the "O" button again, and blue indicator light is flashing</li> </ol>	<p><b>AUX IN Playback</b></p> <p>When speaker is on and audio source is inserted via AUX IN , AUX IN is the priority playback source.
