

The correct speaking voice is a soft tone, as though speaking not to disturb a sleeping child. Quieter than a normal speaking voice but above a whisper. The key to speaking in the proper voice lies in lowering the volume of your voice and maintaining the same voice level.

Care and Maintenance

DO NOT USE ALCOHOL OR OTHER TOXIC MATERIALS TO CLEAN THE INTERIOR OF THE MASK!!!

Make sure your mask is disconnected from your device and turned off. Remove the rubber mouthpiece from the body by pinching the rubber where it meets the body and lifting up gently. Inside the acoustic chamber is acoustic foam. Pinch the foam on both sides, rotate 90° and gently remove. The foam and mouthpiece can be washed regularly in warm soapy water. While removed wipe interior walls of the acoustic chamber to keep clean.

To reseal the mouthpiece on the body press around the outside edges of the mouthpiece where it meets the acoustic chamber to ensure it is properly seated. Finally, check inside where the mouthpiece overlaps the body to confirm the lip is seated all the way around in

inside slot.

CAUTION: Do not wet the microphones. Moisture proof under normal conditions it may not function properly if saturated with liquid.

Introduction

Very often we come across a situation when we need to answer or to make an important call but there is no way we can do this, mainly, because of several reasons: first of all, we don't want to bother people nearby, second of all, we don't want them to tap our conversation. Now there is a solution how to avoid such inconveniences: **Hushme** - personal acoustic device that will help you to protect speech privacy in open space environments.

Important to Know

Hushme has two modes: normal headset mode and passive voice masking mode.

In the normal headset mode, Hushme connects to the smartphone via Bluetooth and you can use it as hands-free headset while speaking on the phone or listening to music.

In the passive voice muffling mode, Hushme is locked over the mouth using a specially designed hook.

Adjust neck-band using sliding buckle in such way that the mouthpiece placed snugly against your face and move it around slightly to find the most comfortable fit. Now you are in the proper position to begin speaking into

your voice mask. The breathing port inside the mask allows the air you naturally expel while speaking to escape without permitting the sound of your voice to be heard.

It is very important that the air does not escape between your face and the mouthpiece. If air escapes, sound escapes!

Connecting to Your Smartphone / Computer / Game Console

This requires a traditional 3,5" mini jack connector (for computers/consols) or Bluetooth interface for smartphones, tablets.

1. Plug your 3,5" mini jack into your computer or turn on Bluetooth on your smartphone/tablet.


2. Insert your plug into the Hushme microphone port or turn on Bluetooth on your Hushme, find it in the list of BT devices on your smartphone/tablet and pair them. (Connection password????). When devices will be paired via BT connection, you will see the blue light (???) on Hushme.

Remember that one kind of connection can be active at a time. If you are using a traditional 3,5" mini jack, then a Bluetooth connection is not possible.

Control Buttons

Hushme has 4 (????) control buttons on its housing.

- 1 ON / OFF | Play / Pause
- 2 Volume Up
- 3 Volume Down
- 4 Mic Mode Switch



Proper Breathing and Speaking

Breathing while speaking into the mask is done the same way as ordinary conversation. Inhale through nose and expel air through the mouth as you speak.

Do not try to hold your breath while speaking!
