
Plug the included AC/DC power adapter into the DC POWER INPUT on the sound bar and a standard AC power outlet.

Mounting


We recommend having this bar speaker professionally mounted.

The included spacers should be used at your discretion to extend the face of the bar speaker farther from the wall. These are typically used when mounting the bar speaker under a television, and the face of the bar speaker needs to be flush with the face of the television.



Input Interfaces



- ① **Line In Jack:** Connect the soundbar and LINE out device by 3.5mm audio cable
- ② **USB Interface:** MP3 music playback (support max 32GB U-disk), Software update
- ③ **DC IN:** Power Adaptor Input


Buttons



- ① **Power/Model:** Long press to Power on/off the soundbar, short press to switch among BT, USB and LINE IN mode
- ② **Pause/Play:** Short press to Pause/Play the music
- ③ **Volume +:** Short press to previous music, long press to increase the volume
- ④ **Volume - :** Short press to next music, long press to reduce the volume

Remote Control



- ① Switch to Power on/off
- ② Volume -
- ③ Pause/Play
- ④ USB-Pre music
- ⑤ Repeat Play: One/All Music repeat play (USB Mode Only)
- ⑥ MUTE
- ⑦ Switch to change EQ

- ⑨ USB-Next music

LINE Input

Prepare a Line In cable (Available from the accessories)

1. Plug in the power cable, LED display indicate by Red light;
2. Long press the power button on the control panel or short press the power button on remote control to power on the soundbar, red light turn off and display by flashing , the soundbar enter to Bluetooth Mode(Default mode)
3. Insert 3.5mm audio cable to LINE IN interface, the soundbar enter Line In mode automatically, display by ;
4. Ensure the audio sourcing in the status of line in working;
5. Your device can play music via the soundbar now.

USB

Prepare one piece U disk with MP3 music inside.(Not included in the accessories).

1. Plug in the power cable, LED display indicated by red light;
2. Long press the power button on the control panel or short press the power button on remote control to power on the soundbar, red light turn off and display by flashing , the soundbar enter to Bluetooth Mode(Default mode)
3. Insert U-Disk to USB interface, the soundbar enter USB mode automatically, display by ;
4. Ensure Mp3 songs available in the U disk
5. Your device can play music via the soundbar now.

6. USB play control by remote control only, Pause/Play: , Pre/next: ;
Repeat: Press once for single song repeat and twice for All songs repeat.

Bluetooth

Initial pairing your bluetooth device.

1. Plug in the power cable, LED display indicated by red light.
2. Long press the power button on the control panel or short press the power button on remote control to power on the soundbar, red light turn off and display by flashing , the soundbar enter to Bluetooth Mode(Default mode)

3. Using the native controls on your bluetooth device, search and select the soundbar pairing name "GD19" in your bluetooth settings to pair.
4. When successfully paired and connected, the LED display indicated by solid .
5. Short press POWER button to cancel current bluetooth pairing, it will automatically repair bluetooth device if the bluetooth is not close.

After initial pairing, the soundbar will stay paired unless unpaired manually by user or erased due to a reset of the device.

If your device should become unpaired or you find it unable to connect, repeat the above steps.
