MECHANICAL KEYBOARD MANUAL

DK63 manual



Function:

- Fn+R=Switch between USB mode and Bluetooth mode
- Fn+Z=Switch to the first group of Bluetooth, press for more than 3 seconds to enter the Bluetooth pairing mode
- Fn+X=Switch to the second group of Bluetooth, press for more than 3 seconds to enter the Bluetooth pairing mode
- Fn+C=Switch to the third group of Bluetooth, press for more than 3 seconds to enter the Bluetooth pairing mode



RGB Light

- Fn+=Switch light mode
- Fn+Up key=Adjust light brightness+
- Fn+Down key=Adjust light brightness-
- Fn+Left key=Adjust the speed of the light-
- Fn+Right key=Adjust the speed of the light+

Indicator Light (When holding the FN key, the current keyboard status is displayed, and releasing the FN will restore the original lighting effect)

- **On BT mode** which group of BT is currently connected, the corresponding key will be light up (Blue light)
- **Caps Lock key** Please turn on / off the LED of this key according to the actual situation of the computer
- **On BT mode, holding FN key**, the LED of R key will light up (Blue light), release FN key to restore the current status
- **On USB mode** holding FN key, the LED of R key will light up (Green light), release FN key to restore the current status
- **When the keyboard is in the charging state**, holding the FN key, the right Alt will lights up, release the FN key to restore the current state
