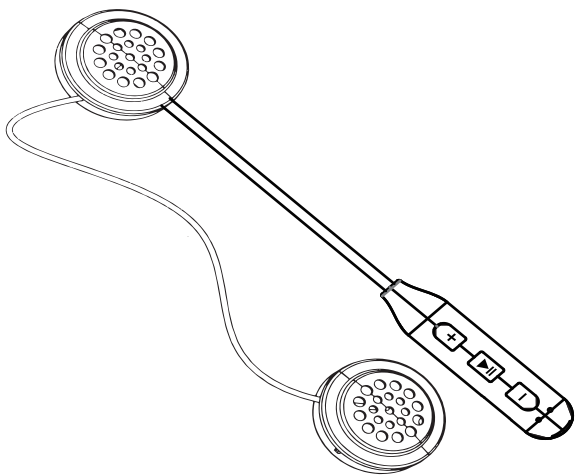


# User Manual



## HELMET BLUETOOTH HEADPHONE

Thank you for choosing our products. To make sure you can use the product correctly, please read the following directions carefully before using, then follow it strictly.

### SAFETY WARNING:

- The device is only IPX7 life waterproof, please do not put it under water or using it in the rain.
- Please do not expose the product into acid, alkaline or hard and pointy objects when using.
- If the product is wet or damp by rain, or moldy, please place it in a low-temperature dry place, do not insolate or put into the oven and other high-temperature places.
- Please do not throw the device and its battery into the fire.
- Please do not disassemble, repair or refit the product.
- Please do not pull or throw the product.

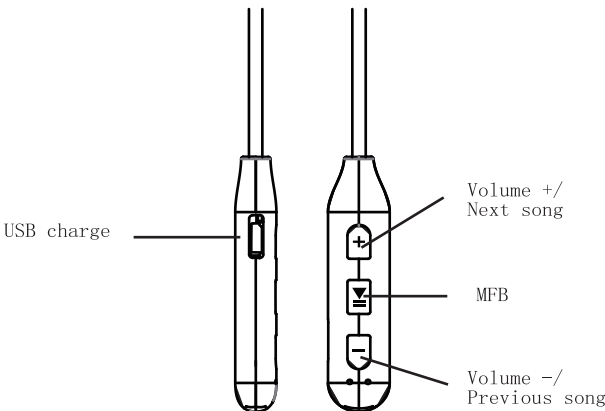
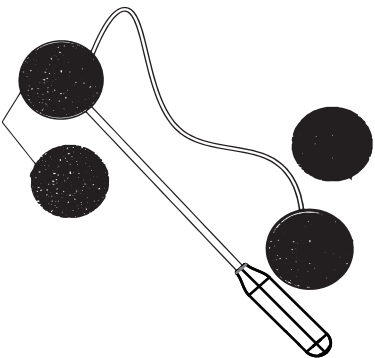

## FUNCTION & OPERATION

### Charging

Plug micro USB port into earphone, then connect it to the computer or adapter by the USB cable, at the time, the LED light will turn red, when the LED light is turn on blue light, it means the speaker is fully charged, please pull out the cable.

#### Notice

- 1) First time using this product, please fully charge the product for 2 to 3 hours.
- 2) When it is charging, helmet headphone can not play music or answer the phone call.

### Power on

Press the “▶||” button 3 seconds, the device is on once “Blue” LED slowly flash.

### Power off

Press the “▶||” button 3 seconds again, the device is off while the LED is off.

### Paring

Press and hold the key “▶||” for 5 seconds until the LED light flash blue and red, please try to search the Bluetooth name of “BT30” on your phone, set-in the password of “0000” if it is the first time to pair the device, when you hear “connected” means paired successful and the Blue LED slowly flashing.

### Automatically Re-pair

Your device can be automatically re-pair promptly once both device not cancel the paring, and hear “connected” means the device is paired.

### Play/Pause

Press “▶||” button to pause the song, press it again to continue the song

### Previous Song/Next Song

Press “-” button one time for previous song  
Press “+” button one time for next song

### Volume Increase/Decrease

**Decrease the volume:** Press and hold the “-” button to decrease the volume and when the volume is reduced to a minimum make “Dong” sound.

**Increase the volume:** Press and hold the “+” button to increase the volume and when the volume is increased to a maximum make “Dong” sound.

### Phone Call Answer

#### (Automatic or Manual Answer)

1. Call answer: When the phone comes in, you can dial the number and answer it automatically, or just press the “▶||” button to answer it.
2. Refuse call answer: Press the “▶||” button for 2-3 seconds.
3. Automatic/Manual Answer: Before connecting the phone to Bluetooth, hold down the volume “+” button and the volume “-” button at the same time to switch between automatic and manual answer.

### Support “Siri” voice assistant

Short press “▶||” three times to start the smart voice assistant to make calls

### Low Power Warning

The device sound “Dong Dong” warning voice while working, it means the power is low, please charge it.

### Power Save Mode

The device will be off automatically after 5 minutes no working device pairing it.

### 1 Drive-2 Mode

The phone support two simultaneous pairing:  
First pair the phone 1 with the Helmet Headset and then disconnect the phone 1's Bluetooth;  
After pairing the Helmet Headset with mobile phone 2, open the Bluetooth of mobile phone 1 and click connect “BT30” to connect two mobile phones at the same time;  
Now phone 1 and phone 2 paired with Helmet Headset together and support to answer any call from two phones (Note: phone1 and phone 2 can not answer calls at the same time.)

### Installing Step

#### Step1

Take out the Helmet Headphone from the color box, stick the “Magic Tape” on both earphones.

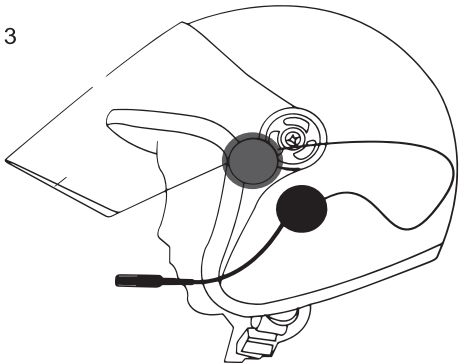
#### Step2

Tear off the 3M tape paper of the earphones, and stick it into the helmet ear position of both sides, before stick it, please align the position well, see Fig3.

### It can automatically answer a call after the number is announced

#### Treble and bass Settings:

Please press and hold “+” button or “-” button to increase or decrease the volume (If you think it is not easy to control the volume on the Bluetooth headset, you also can adjust the volume on your phone to achieve what you want.)

#### Switch between Chinese and English:

The Helmet Bluetooth Headset language is English by default. If you want to switch languages please turn on the headset first without connect to Bluetooth, and then press the power on button twice to switch the language.
