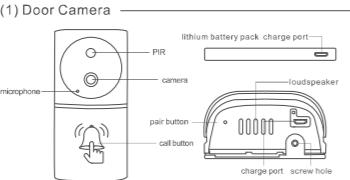

### User Manual

**1. Product Description**

(1) Door Camera



(2) Gateway

(style 1) pair button, loudspeaker, TF card slot, work indicator, network indicator light, RJ-45 port

(style 2) loudspeaker, RJ-45 port, power port, TF card slot, pair button

**2. Preparation before Installation**

Check packing content



**3. Operation Instruction**

Scan QR code to download APP



Account Registration

Input your email address and set up a password. Click "Verify"; a verification code will be sent to the email you input. If you do not find the email in your inbox, please check your spam filter. Enter the code and click "Sign Up".

**4. Pair between Gateway and Door Camera**

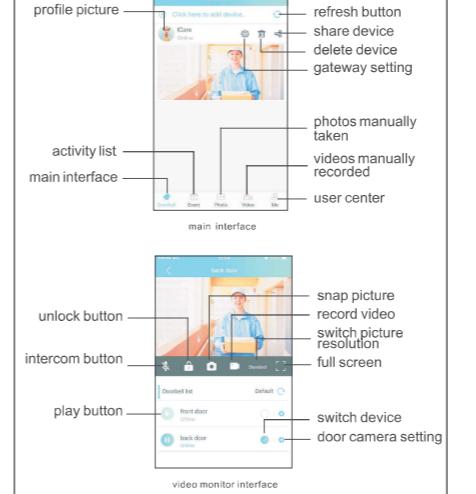
Tip: This step is not required because gateway and door camera are paired well before delivery. If APP alerts no pair between them, please contact local sellers before taking this step.

- Long press "pair" button (also "reset" button) on gateway for 10 seconds till it alerts "restoring factory setting".
- Long press "pair" button on gateway for 10 seconds till it alerts "factory setting restored".
- Then fast press "pair" button on door camera for 3 seconds. It will alert "pairing". Next fast press "pair" button on gateway for 3 times, it will alert "pair success".
- When two devices both alert "pair success", pair complete between them.

**5. Add Device on APP**

- Connect gateway with router via network cable; then connect it with power via adapter and connect power adapter to gateway.
- Enter gateway IP (WPS) which is available on phone.
- Open APP and click "add device" (see Picture 1).
- Click "pair" via QR code (view image 2).
- Scan QR code (view image 3) to auto recognize and add device (see picture 5). Or enter device ID number and password (default: 888888) to add device. Click "V" (Image 3).
- device is added then back to main interface. (Pic 6)

**7. Share Device to More Users**

Gateway is allowed to be added to only one account, which is called admin account. If other users want to be connected, admin user should first list them friend then share this device to them. Below steps shows how to add friend and share device.

**1. How to Send Friend Request**

- Click "User" at the lower right corner
- Tap "+" button in the upper left corner
- Click "My Friends"
- The account is added to your friend list

**2. How to Accept Friend Request**

- Click "User" at the lower right corner
- Tap "New Friends" to view friend request
- Click "Add" to accept friend request
- Click "Add" to accept friend request

**3. Share Device from Admin Account to Common Account (both must be listed friends first)**

- After device is added, click "share" button
- Click "share" button to share device to friend account
- Device is added on common account
- Device is added on common account

**4. How to Accept Friend Request**

- Click "User" at the lower right corner
- Tap "New Friends" to view friend request
- Click "Add" to accept friend request
- Click "Add" to accept friend request

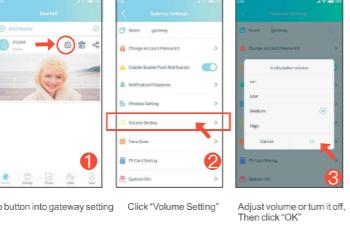
**5. How to Share Device**

- Enter user account and search it
- Click searched user account
- Click "Add" to send a friend request
- Click "Add" to send a friend request

**6. How to Add Device to Admin Account**

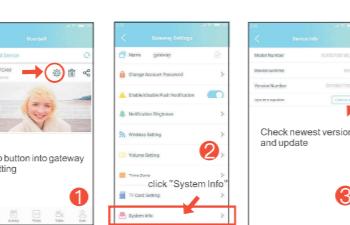
- After device is shared from admin account, click "share" button
- Click "share" button to share device to friend account
- Device is added on common account
- Device is added on common account

**5. Gateway Speaker Volume Setting**



Tap button into gateway setting → Click "Volume Setting" → Adjust volume or turn it off. Then click "OK".

**6. System Update**



Tap button into gateway setting → click "System Info" → click "System Info" → Check newest version and update.

**4. Function**

**Video Intercom**

After each visitor makes a call, you will get an instant notification on your mobile app and view visitor on phone if you answer the call. Then you can hear and speak to them at your door anytime from anywhere. At the same time, visitor picture will be stored in TF card on gateway. If call is not answered in a specified time, visitor can leave a message.

**Unlock via APP (An extra unlock module is a must)**

In intercom or live view video state, press "unlock" button on APP and enter unlock password (default password: 0000) to release door.

**Remote Monitoring**

You can monitor your front door at any time by starting the video from the app.

**Data Storage**

A TF memory card (max support 32GB) can be inserted on gateway. Activity videos of visitor call, motion detection, unlock and leave message will be saved in this TF card.

**Other operations:**

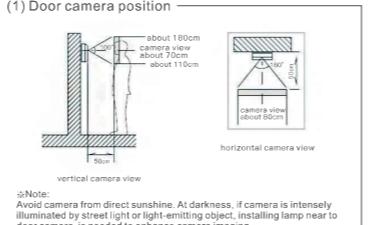
Gateway password, unlock password, friend nickname, etc can be changed.

**Motion Detection:**

If someone moves within the camera view, an instant alert will be sent to mobiles; and a video of anyone approaching will be captured and saved. (please view below screenshots for operation)

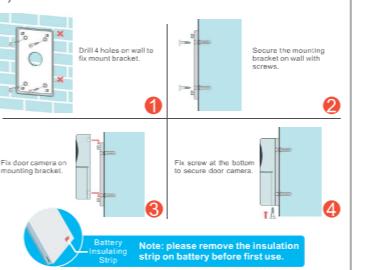
**5. Installation**

**(1) Door camera position**



Notes: Avoid camera from direct sunshine. At darkness, if camera is intensely illuminated by street light or light-emitting object, installing lamp near to door camera is needed to enhance camera imaging.

**(2) Installation**



1. Drill 4 holes on wall to fix mount bracket. 2. Secure the mounting bracket on wall with screws. 3. Fix door camera on mounting bracket. 4. Fix screw at the bottom to secure door camera. Note: please remove the insulation strip on battery before first use.

**6. Precautions**

- Leave door camera and gateway from strong magnetic field.
- Do not spray water or other liquid to door camera and gateway.
- Do not heavily hit gateway and doorbell.
- Leave it from direct-sun exposure and strong reflected light.
- Do not install door camera near to place with ammonia or toxic gas.
- No disassembling this product because high voltage current exists inside it.
- Do not wipe door camera and gateway with detergent or other chemical solvents.
- Do not disassemble this device in case of failure. Please repair it at your local maintenance locations or direct contact our after sale customer service.

**7. Troubleshooting**

**(1) No sound in intercom state.** (Picture 1)

- Check whether mobile allows APP to access microphone and record audio.
- Check whether microphone is blocked up.

**(2) No alerts to mobile phone.** (Picture 2,3)

- Check whether gateway and door camera are paired well; and whether device status is online.
- Check whether notification permission to APP is allowed on mobile setting.
