



Set up



1) Screw control module into bottom of module firmly but do not overtighten.



2) Fill bottle with liquid and attach drink cap.



3) Place on top of desk charger to keep desired temperature

Operating instructions



Long press the C/F Selector for 2 seconds to switch the temperature unit.



Selected temperature unit will illuminate



Use up and down arrows to set the temperature. Press once to increase or decrease by 1 degree, long press to scroll.



If overheating occurs due to lack of liquid, the no water light will illuminate.



When Bluetooth is connected, the Bluetooth icon illuminates.



Short press the brightness button to change the brightness of the display.
