SAR Test Exclusion calculation

For 100 MHz to 6 GHz and test separation distances ≤ 50 mm the 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds are determined by the following:

$$[(\text{max power of channel, including tune up tolerance, mW}) / (\text{min test separation distance, mm})] * [\sqrt{f(\text{GHz})}]$$

Where: power (mW)
 Distance (mm)

Calculation:

(Calculated for max power)

Max power 0.943 dBm (1.246mW) for f=2480 MHz

Calculated at distance ≤ 50 mm:

SAR Test Exclusion = 0.039 mW

Limit: 96 mW
