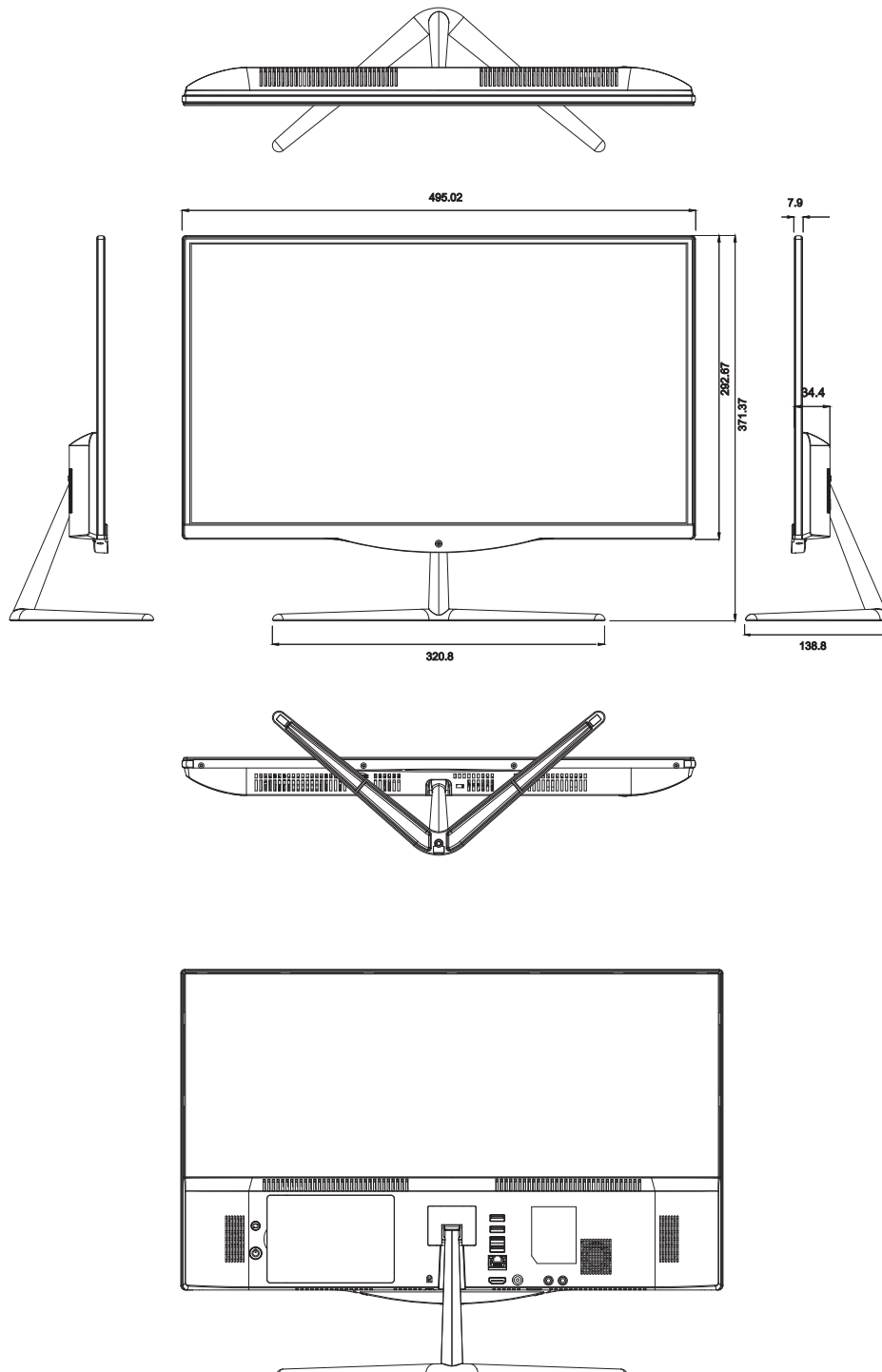

3.1 Windows 10 start screen image:

On the start screen, many applications are shown on the initial page. These applications are displayed in the form of “magnet”. You can easily run any application by simply clicking on it.

You need to log on your Microsoft account before the application program runs.

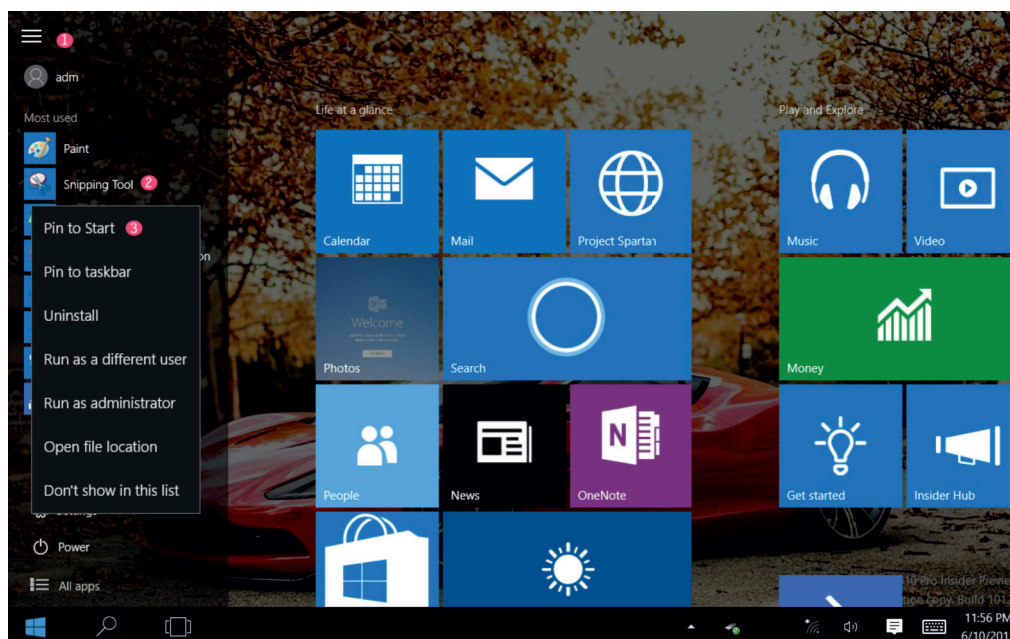


3.2 Introduction to app Interface

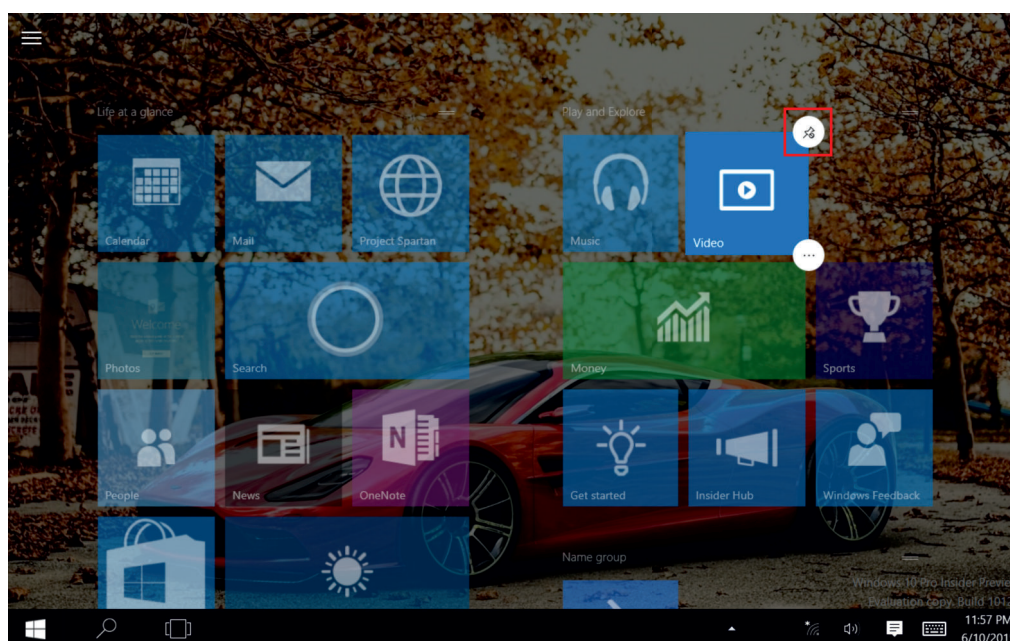
Besides the applications initially shown on the start screen, you can also start other applications in the all application programs section, such as other software applications attached to the PLATINUM AIO PC.



If you want to pin more applications on the start screen, see the operation in the figure below: (1) Click the properties icon, (2) press and hold the application program magnet for about one second and then let go (3) Choose Pin to start

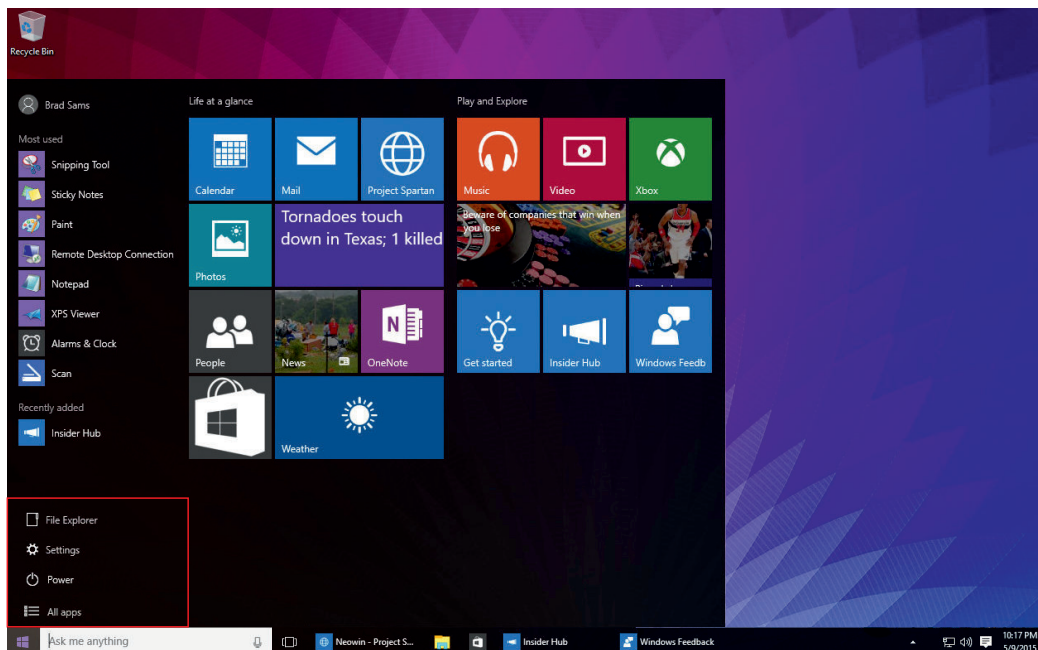

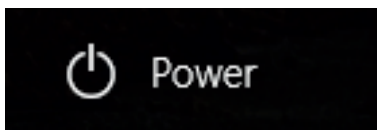


4.. Start Menu

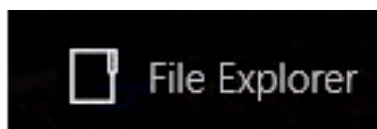
Under PC mode, press the Start icon; the Start Menu will display, including Start, Device, Setup, Share, and Search Program.



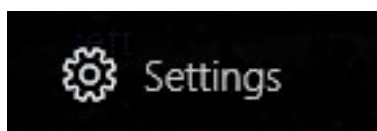
Usually: File Explorer, Settings, Power, and All apps



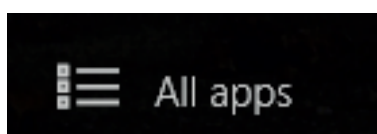

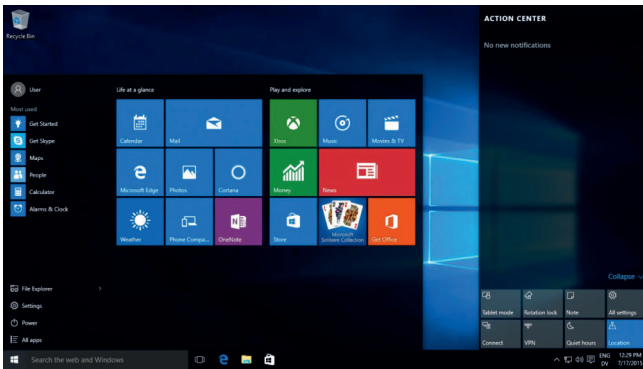


Can let you set up the Table PC.

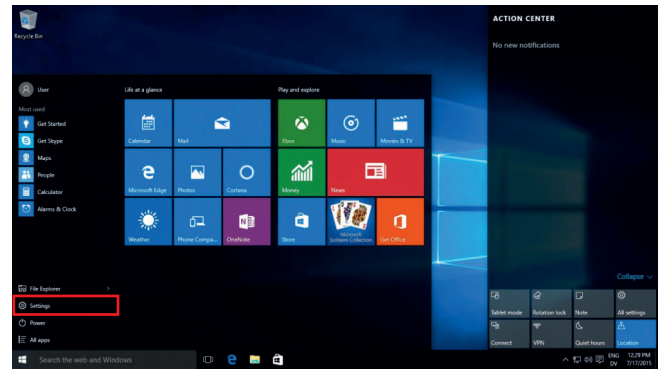

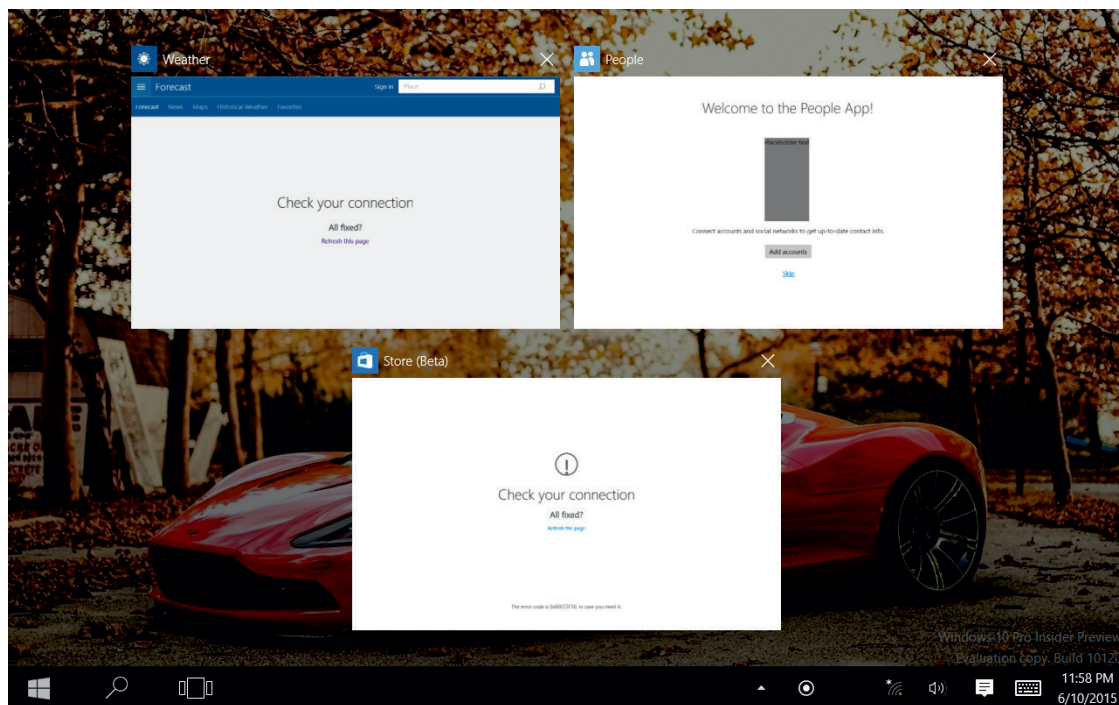

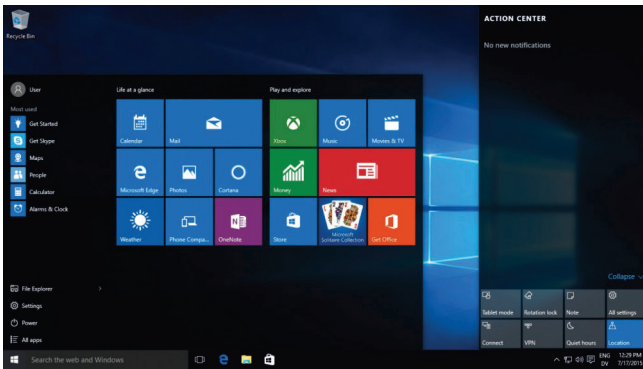

5.. Multitasking Operating Interface

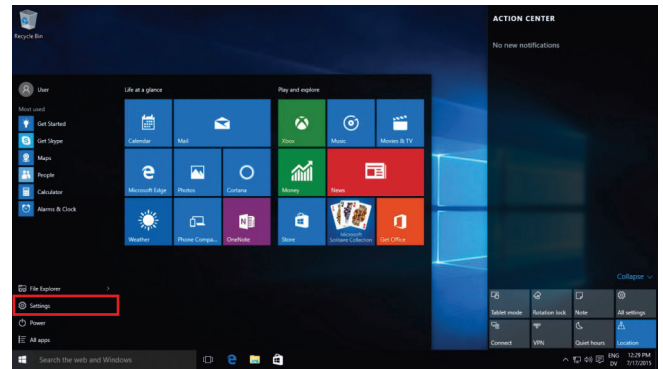
Slide the window to the right from the left side of the screen, Let go when the running applications appear. Then you can enter the application, or delete it.

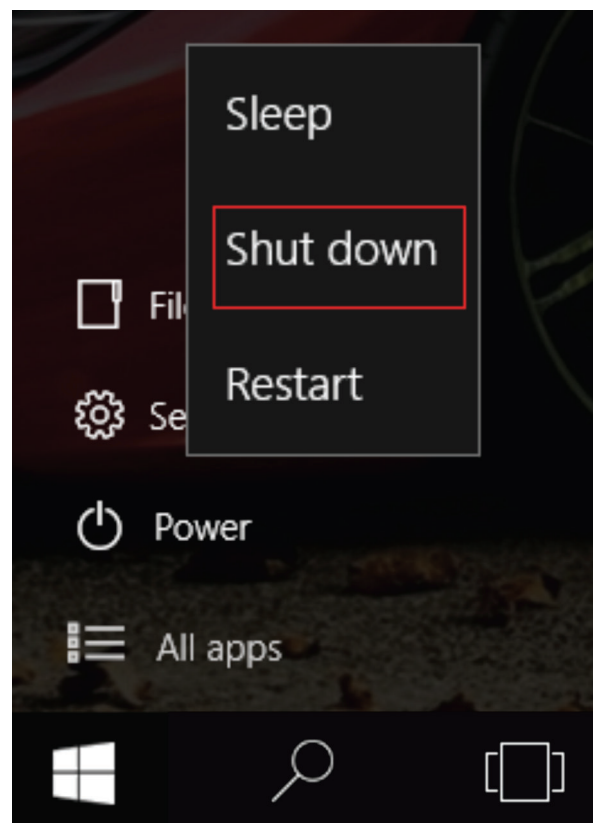
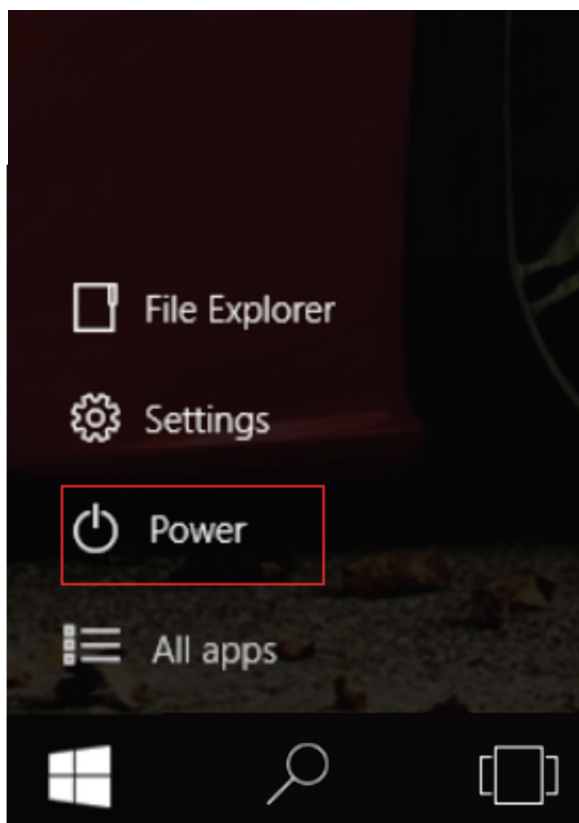

6.. Basic Operations

Sleep, Restart and Power Off



FCC Caution:
