INSTRUCTIONS

GETTING STARTED

1. Download the Dinobytes game in the App Store or Google Play (see back of booklet for QR code).
2. Make sure bluetooth is active on your phone or tablet.
3. Open the Dinobytes app, agree to share your location and enter skin code (see back of booklet).
4. Wake up the ball by moving it when prompted.
First time you wake it up it needs to be attached to the charger while moving it. You will see a blue light indicator in one of the holes on the ball when it's awake.
5. Follow the instructions on your screen and start playing!



DINOBYTE SKINS

The silicone skins are easily changeable so you can unlock and play more Dinobyte characters.

Simply peel off your current skin, and pull over a new one whenever you want to switch out a character in the game.

YOUR DINOBYTE SMART BALL

To play you need to wake up the ball. This is done simply by moving the ball, just lifting it up from a surface will do.

- When the ball is awake a blue light will blink continuously.
- Turns off after 2 minutes of inactivity, if not actively connected to the game.
- In the app, there is a battery indicator. When the battery is running low, it's time to charge the ball.
- Recharge time: 4 hours

HOW TO PLAY

Dinobytes are digital pets with a bounce!

Help your Dinobyte thrive and grow by bouncing it to reach new levels. In the app, the Dinobyte has a home with several rooms in which mini games are opened and the Dinobyte does activities while you bounce the ball. Give your Dinobyte exercise by bouncing the ball in a frenzy. Then go to the painting room and bounce to create splatter art together!

By keeping the Dinobytes happy and healthy, you'll unlock new features, functions, and badges for being a pet master.

Be sure to keep your Dinobyte bouncing! Inactivity causes Dinobytes to turn into fossils again. But don't worry, you can still save them and break them free to continue playing.

THE SWIMMING GAME

Time to explore the deep sea! Just bounce the ball to make your Dinobyte swim. The faster you bounce, the higher the Dinobyte will swim. Catch boosters to activate a shield to protect you from the dangerous fish. If you hit the ground or swim into a fish, the game is over.

3. Deep seas are for me!





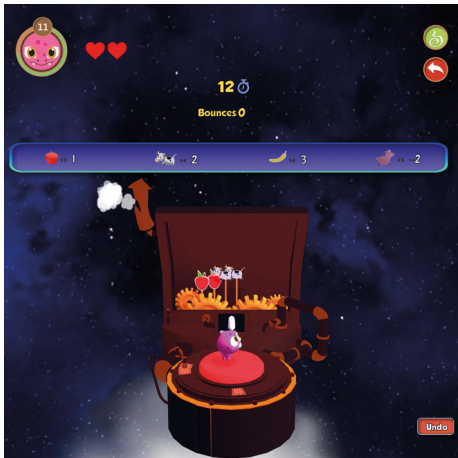
THE PAINTING GAME

Art with a bounce! Choose a color by tapping it on the screen, then tap where on the canvas you want your DinobYTE to go. When your DinobYTE is in the right position, bounce the ball to paint!

THE MATH GAME

Each symbol represent a number. The apple is one bounce, the cow is two bounces, the banana is three bounces and the pig is negative 2 bounces. As the symbols appear, solve the equation and bounce your Dinobyte the same number of times. In the image on the left, the equation would be $1 + 1 + 2 + 2 = 4$ bounces.

SLEEPING GAME

Count the sheep to regain energy! Each time you bounce, it counts. Anytime you see a sheep, bounce your Dinobyte. But beware of the wolf! If you bounce the ball when you see a wolf, or if you miss a sheep, then you loose one life. If you loose all three lives, the game is over and you have to start again.

FEEDING YOUR DINOBYTE

You need to take care of your Dinobyte! Like all creatures they need to eat. Tap the basket of fruit, then bounce your ball to make your Dinobyte eat. Eating not only restores hunger, but also gives you experience points.

Badges you can earn in this game:

1. Yummy that was delicious
2. I'm getting full
3. I'm going to burst!





TIME TO GET COZY!

Even your Dinobyte enjoys cozying up next to a crackling fire! Tap the fireplace to start this game. Go on a treasure hunt to collect the matches and logs lying around in the world. When you have collected all you need, tap the fireplace again and bounce the ball to light the fire.

Badges you can earn in this game:

1. Keeping warm
2. Getting hot in here
3. Burning down the house!





LET'S GO SPINNING!

Take your Dinobyte for a run in the wheel to keep it active! Just tap the wheel, then bounce your ball. Keep the arrow in the green zone to make your Dinobyte run while you're bouncing away! Running will prevent your Dinobyte from turning into a fossil.

Badges you can earn in this game:

1. Running all day
2. I could do a marathon now





HYGIENE

Even digital creatures need to take a shower now and then. Tap the lake so your Dinobyte jumps in, then bounce the ball to activate the shower and soon your Dinobyte will be fresh as a daisy!
