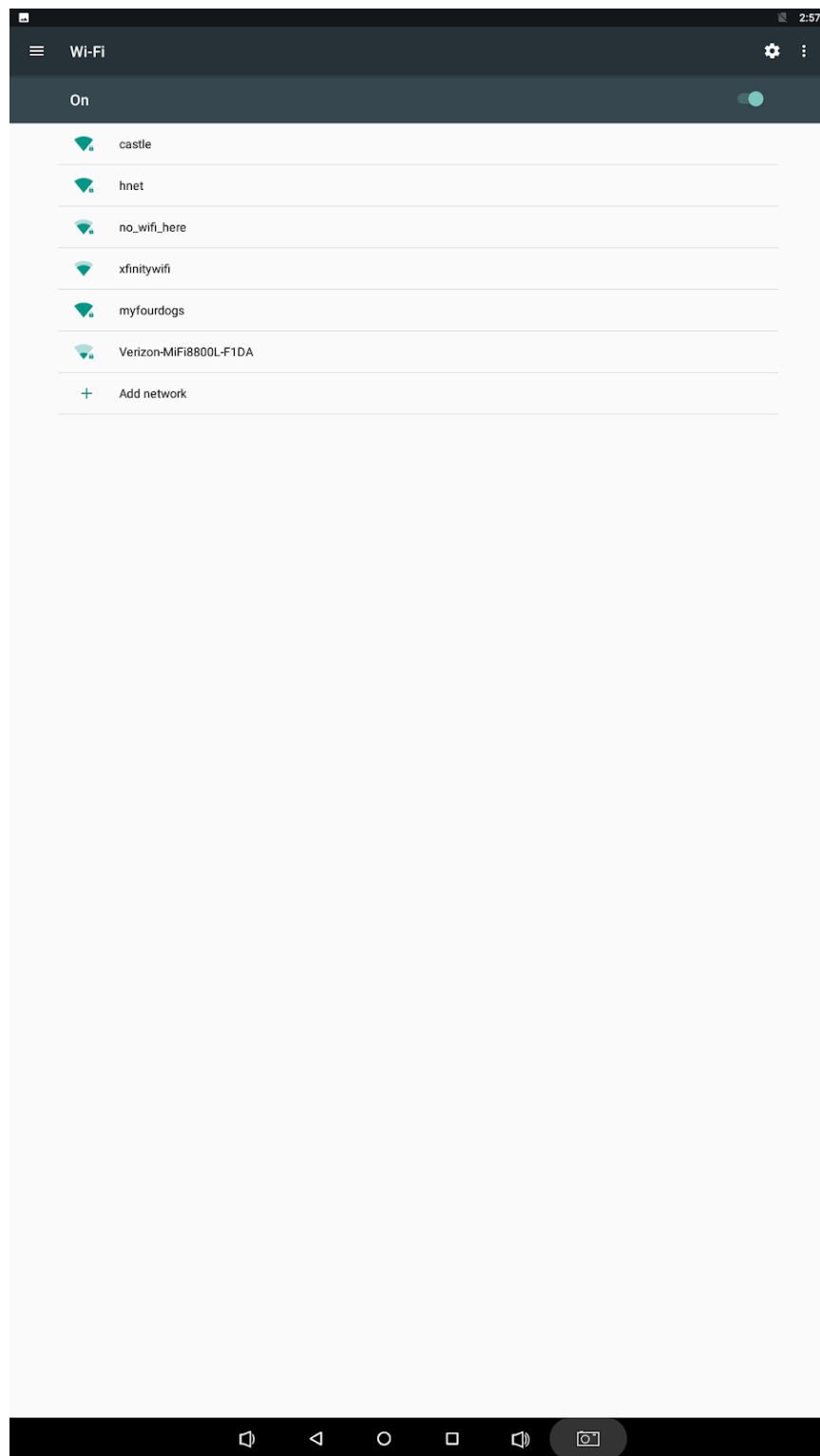

3. Select your WiFi Network



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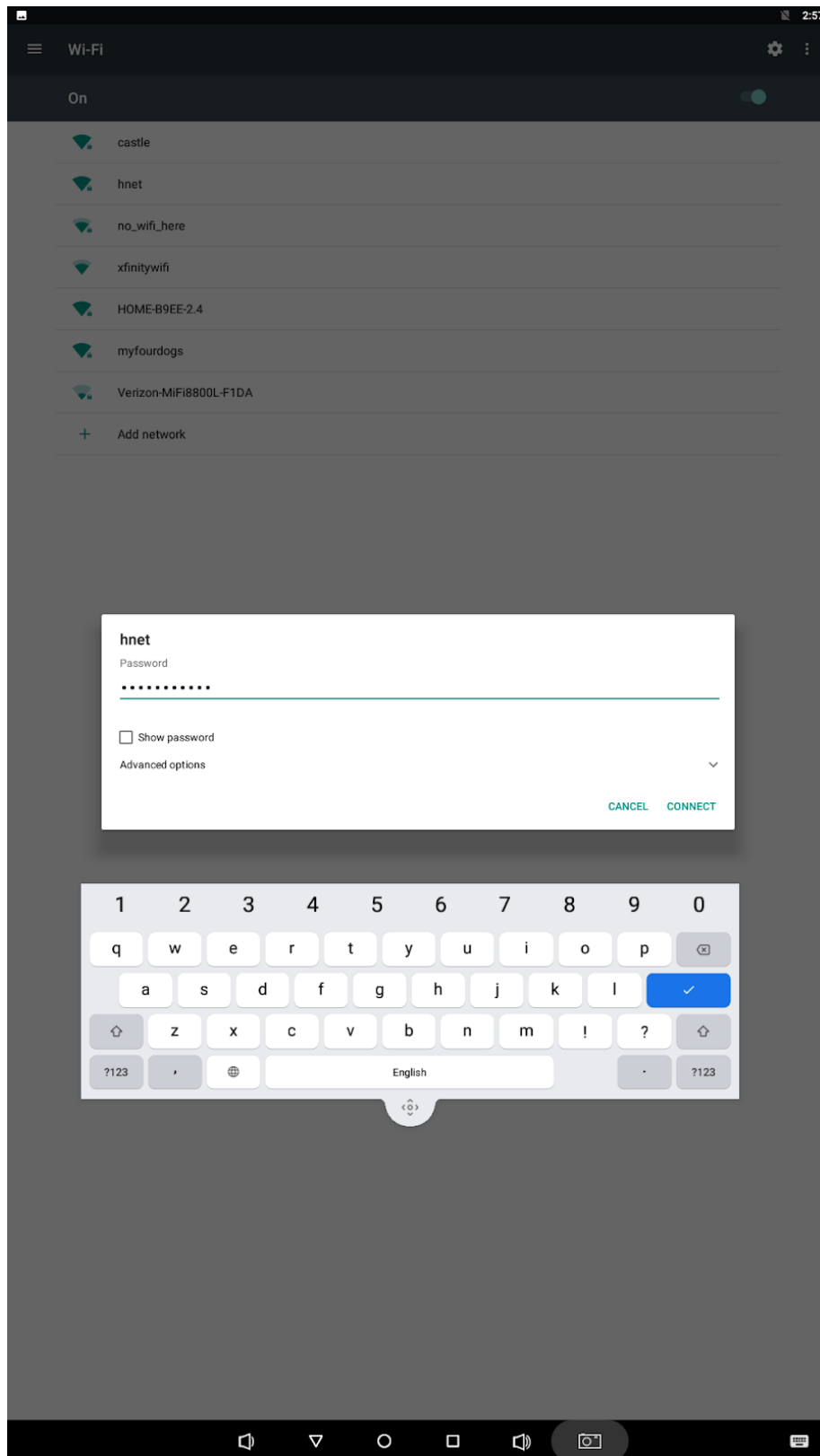


4. Type Your WiFi Network Password



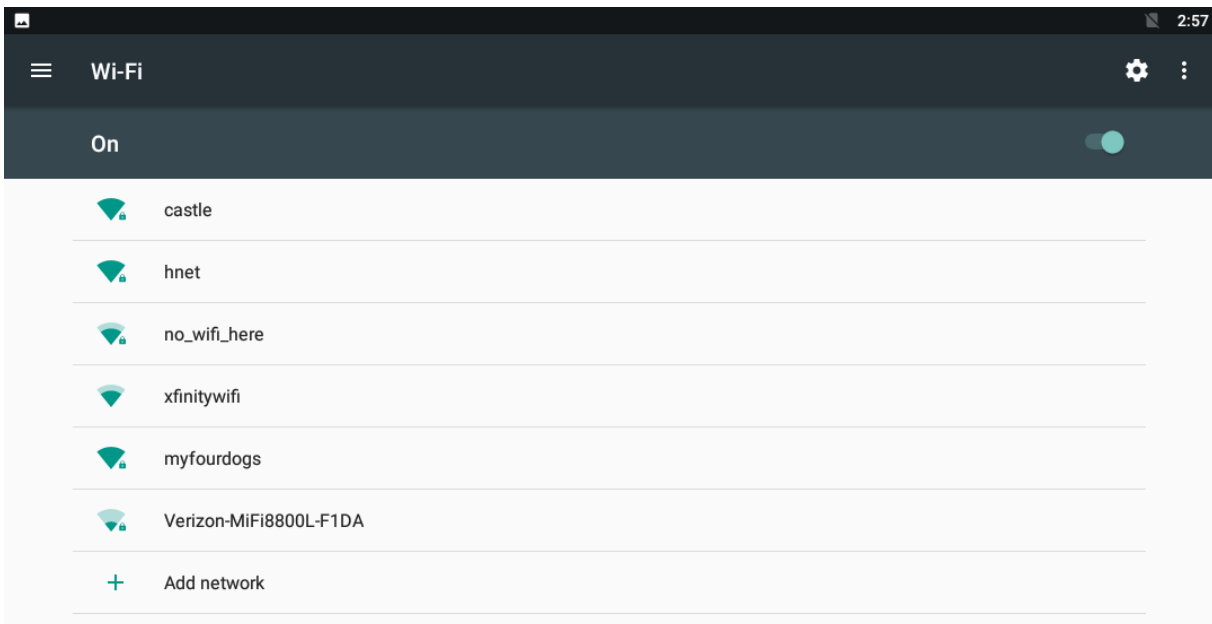

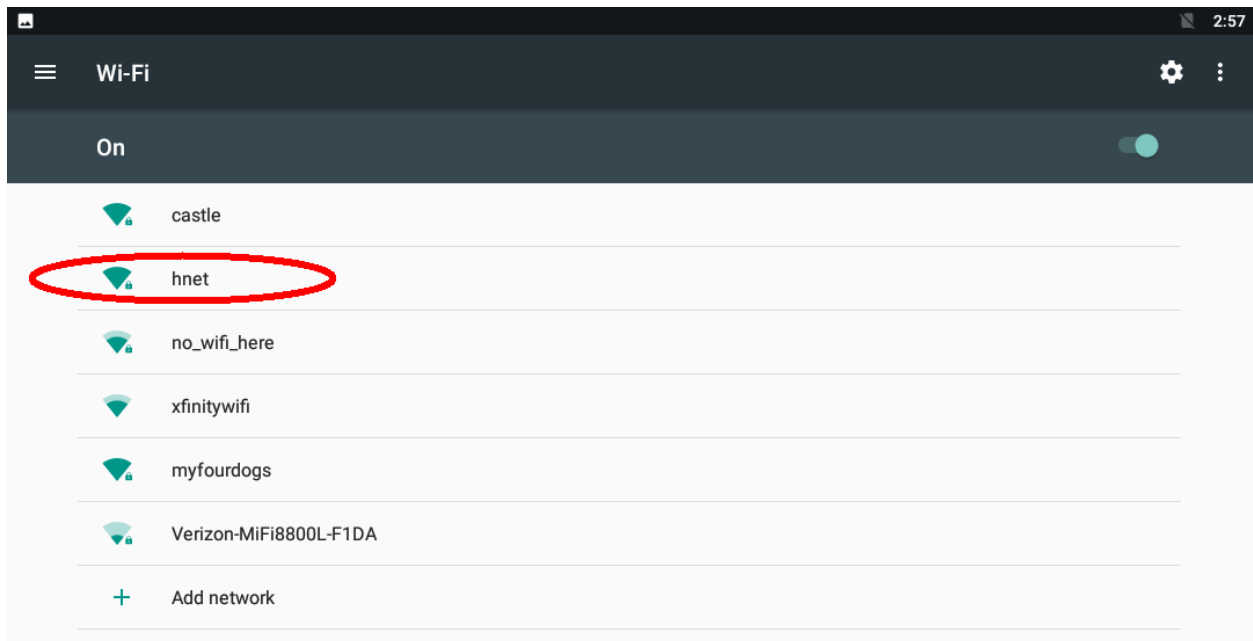

3. Find Your WiFi Network



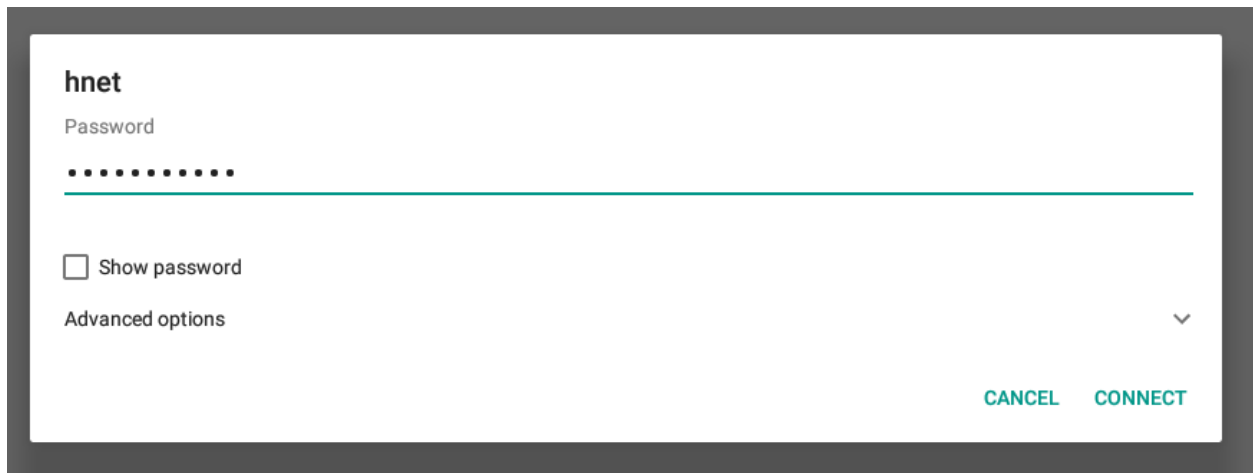

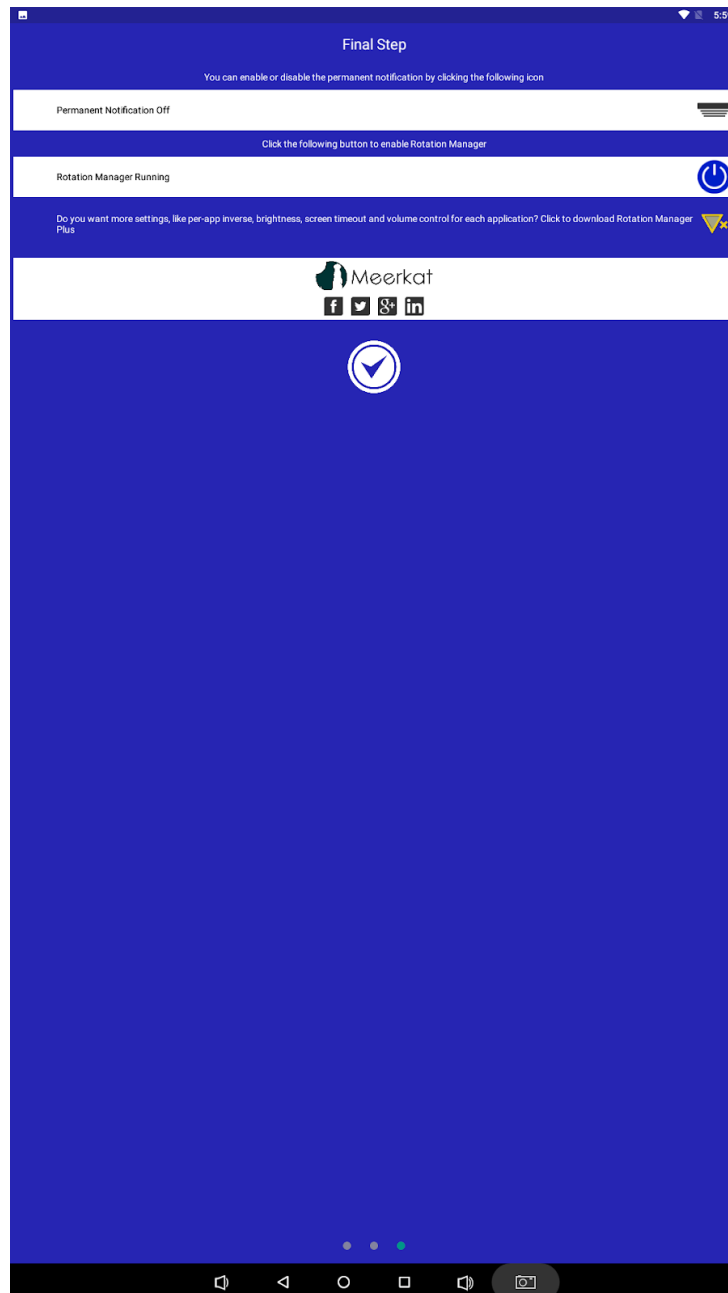
1. Open Rotation Manager App
2. Swipe Left to Continue



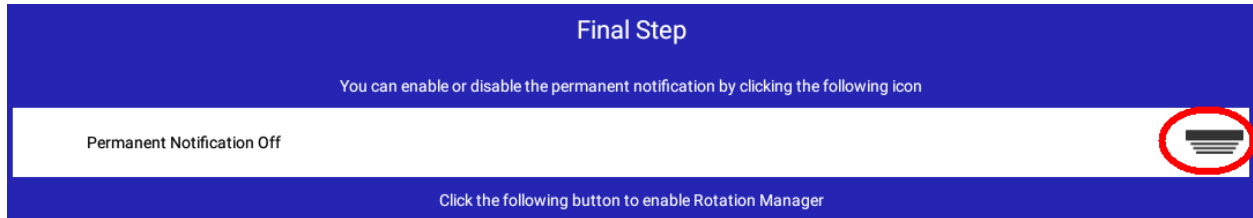

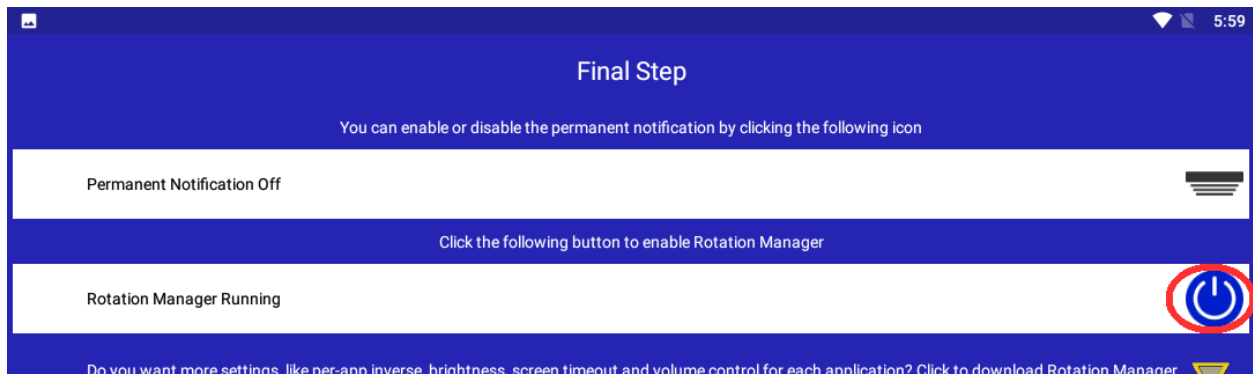

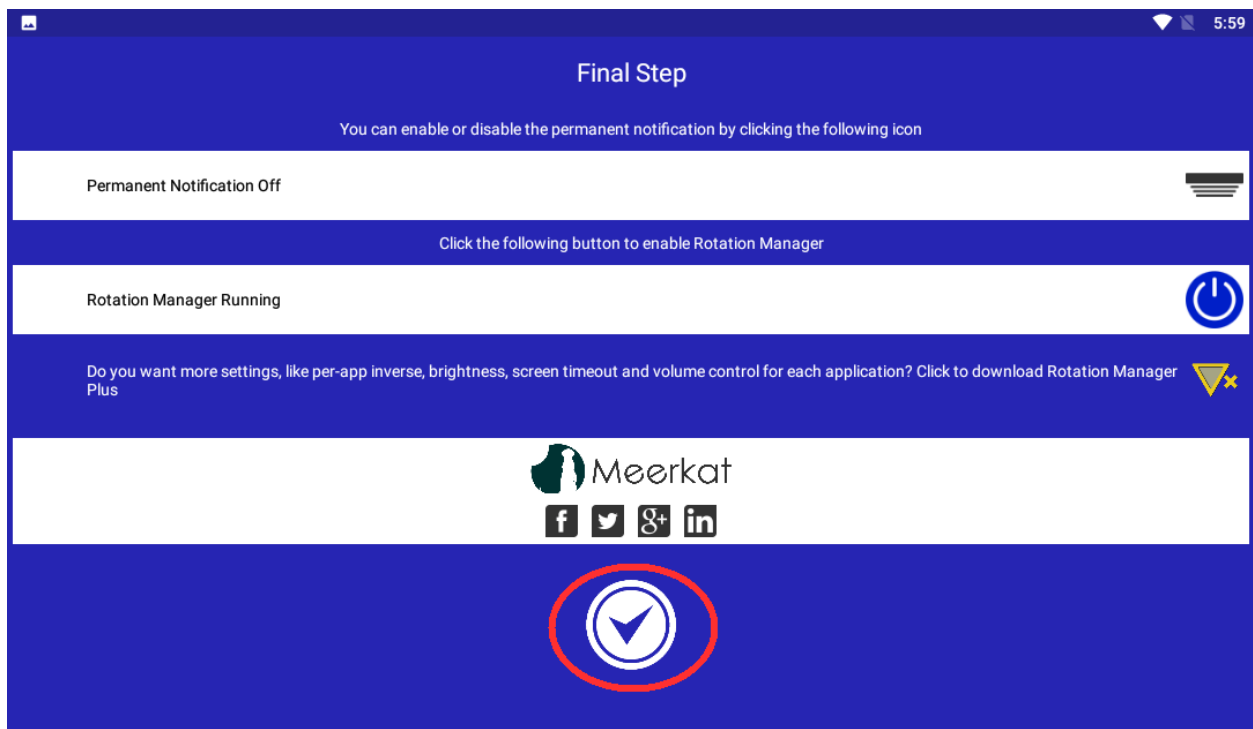

FCC

Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Statement

Important Safety Instructions

Danger - To reduce the risk of electric shock:

Always unplug this appliance from the electrical outlet immediately after using and before cleaning.

Warning - To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock, or injury to persons:

1. An appliance should never be left unattended when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use, and before putting on or taking off parts.
2. Do not operate under blanket or pillow. Excessive heating can occur and cause fire, electric shock or injury to persons.
3. This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Keep children under the age of 13 away from this machine.
4. Use this appliance only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use attachment not recommended by the manufacturer.
5. Never operate this appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or damaged, or dropped in water.
6. Do not carry this appliance by the supply cord or use the cord as a handle.
7. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces
8. Never operate the appliance with the air openings blocked.

5. Naked flame sources, such as candles, must not be placed on appliance.
6. In case of broken cords or plugs, the cable must be replaced.
7. The appliance is suitable for indoor use only.

Cleaning REFLIKO MARA

While cleaning your REFLIKO MARA, use a clean microfiber cloth to wipe down the mirror. Avoid using cleaning fluids as this could damage the oleophobic coating on the glass.
