
## **WMBTCTL**

## **User Manual**



- 1. Long press POWER button 3 seconds to power on / off the machine, short press INPUT button to shift between BT/AUX/MEMORY play
- 2. Earphone out interface
- 3. USB interface: To charge the machine, or transfer data from computer
- 4. Audio input interface, get music from other devices
- 5. Working Status indicating Light
- 6. Short press "VOL+" to increase the volume and short press "VOL-" to decrease the volume
- 7. Short press "TRACK +" to select next song and short press "TRACK " to select next song
- 8. Short press "PLAY/PAUSE" to play / pause the device
- 9. Short press "SLEEP" button the device will start sleep mode, the volume will decrease 50% from current volume after 26 minutes, the volume will decrease 20% again from 28<sup>th</sup> minutes, the device will power off automatically in 30<sup>th</sup> minutes.
- 10.Transfer data or copy songs from computer to controller: connect controller with computer via USB cable, turn on the controller, computer recognizes the controller and you can copy & edit data
