Regarding internal photos of the product and the user manual are considered confidential not only since they contain trade secrets, but also because the product photos will reveal the entire operation method of the system, which we cannot assure that will be protected by IP. As such, we do not wish to reveal its inner workings to harm does who might be able to reverse engineer the system.

The product is eventually being placed inside an isolation panel in such a way that users will not be able to open the external package or view the internal parts, unless will tear down the panel. No product maintenance is required and in any case of malfunction the users are prompted to send the faulty units to company technicians for repair. Product is installed outdoor, usually poles/walls that are not accessible without specials means (lifts/ladders, etc.).

All our customers are required to sign an NDA prior to receiving the product, the user manual or any other technical material. Attached is an example of such an NDA.
