NO.	Function	Operation method	NOTE
1	power on	Press and hold the function key for 3 seconds, the red and blue lights flash alternately, and the voice prompt is: power on	
2	Shut down	Press and hold the function key for 5 seconds, the red light flashes, the voice prompt is: power off	
3	pair	In automatic pairing mode, the two headphones are turned on, and the prompt tone: pairing, pairing left and right automatically, after the pairing is completed, the host red and blue lights flash alternately, the auxiliary lights are off, and the voice prompt is: connected	
4	Connected devices	Open the Bluetooth device search, search the headset model, click the corresponding model to connect, after the connection is successful, the voice prompt is: connected (connected), the host light is off;	
5	Connected devices (Popup version)	After the headset is successfully paired, the Apple phone will display a pop-up window. Click "Connect via iCloud" to automatically connect the phone. The voice prompt is: Connected successfully (connected), the host light is off;	
6	Bluetooth disconnect	The mobile phone is actively disconnected or exceeds the use range, the voice prompt is: disconnected (disconnected);	
7	Chinese and English prompt switch	With the headset turned on and not connected to any device, double-click the headset;	
8	play / Pause	When playing music, press any headset function key to switch between pause and playback. Under music playback, the main and auxiliary headset LEDs are all off.	
9	Switch songs	When playing music, double-click the main ear function key to switch to the previous song, double-click the auxiliary ear function key to switch to the next song	
10	Volume up/down	The volume of the triple tap of the main ear is increased; the volume of the triple tap of the secondary ear is decreased;	
11	Last Number Replay	Four strikes with left or right ear	
12	Answer/end call	Press the function key once to answer the call, press again to hang up	
13	Reject call	Long press the function key for 1.5 seconds	
14	Start out	The charging compartment has a maintenance voltage	
15	Wake up Apple Assistant	Press and hold the function key for 2 seconds, and then release it after hearing the prompt tone to wake up the Apple SIRI Assistant	
16	Automatic shut-down	3 minutes	

17	Earphone charging	1. Put the headset back into the charging compartment, turn on the charging compartment switch, the headset automatically shuts down and disconnects from the device, the headset's red light is always on, and the light is off when fully charged. After the headset is fully charged for 1 minute, the charging compartment is automatically closed switch; 2. During the charging process of the headset, press the charging compartment button to turn off the charging of the headset, and the headset will be shut down immediately; 3. Take out the headset from the charging compartment, the headset will automatically turn on;	
18	Charging compartment charging	1. Plug in the USB cable, and the charging compartment starts to charge. During the charging process, the red light flashes slowly; when fully charged, the red light is always on; 2. When charging the headset with the charging compartment, the blue light is always on, and when the headset is full, the blue light is off;
