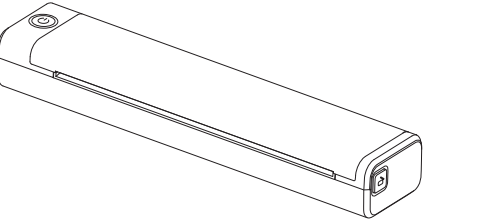

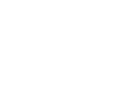

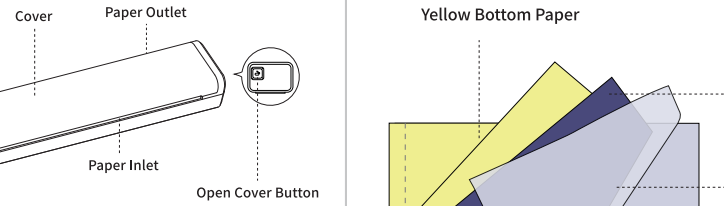

### 2. Printer Components

#### External Structure:



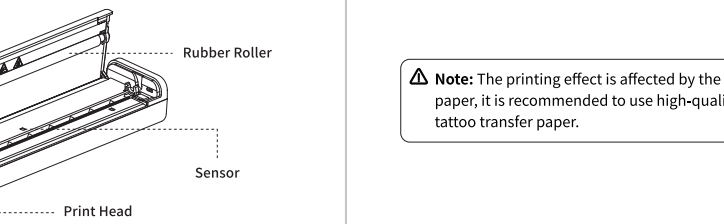
#### Power Button

· Hold down for 3s: On/off.  
· Double-click: Print the self-test page.

#### Power Light

· Green light steady: Standby  
· Red light steady: Out of paper / Cover is open  
· Red light blinking: Low power / Overheat  
· Green light blinking: Charging while powered off

### 3. Introduction to Tattoo Transfer Paper

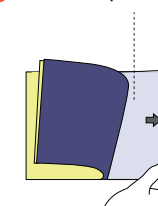
#### Yellow Bottom Paper



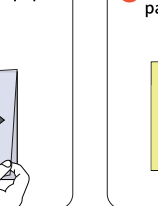
**Note:** The printing effect is affected by the quality of tattoo transfer paper, it is recommended to use high-quality or brand official tattoo transfer paper.

### 4. Paper Installation Guide

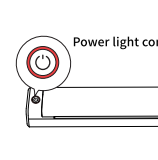
#### 01 Remove the protect paper.



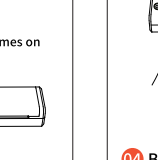
#### 02 Tear off the yellow bottom paper.



#### 03 Turn on the printer



#### 04 Blue transfer paper facing down, flat into the printer

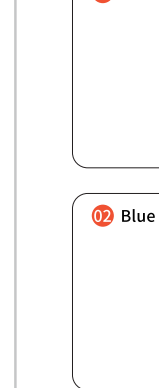


**Note:** If the automatic paper suction fails, please use manual paper feeding method. (See next page for details)

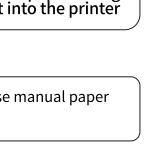
#### 01 Press the open cover button to open the cover.



#### 02 Blue transfer paper facing down, flat into the printer.



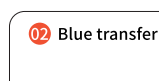
#### 03 Close the cover and turn on the printer.



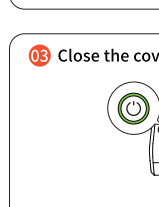
### 5. Mobile Device Usage Guidelines

#### 01 Download the APP

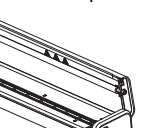
Method 1: Install from app store.



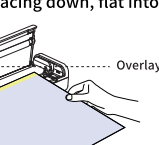
Method 2: Scan the QR code.



#### 02 Please turn on Bluetooth on your mobile phone.



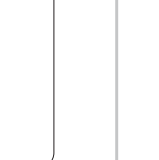
#### 03 Open the app and connect to the printer H2.



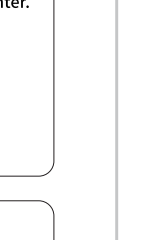
**Important:** To use this product, please ensure Bluetooth is turned on and connect the printer through the app. According to Google's policy, Android devices must have GPS permissions enabled in order to use Bluetooth functionality.

### 6. Transfer Guide

#### 01 Use soap or alcohol to clean your skin and apply a thin layer of transfer paste.



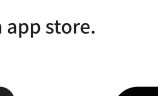
#### 02 The white tracing paper was applied to the skin and pressed for more than 40 seconds.



**Note:** To remove the transferred tattoo, please use alcohol to clean the skin.

### 7. Charging Instructions

#### 1. Please recharge the printer promptly if the battery level is low.



#### 2. Please do not place it on combustible materials such as cotton or linen.



#### 3. Disconnect the charger immediately upon completion of charging.



### 8. Printer Cleaning

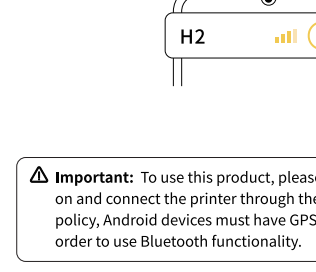
#### When the printer appears blank lines, blurred handwriting or missing words, should be cleaned in time.

1. Power off the printer and open the cover.

2. If you have just finished printing, allow the printhead to cool completely.

3. Wipe with cotton cloth/cotton swab dipped in anhydrous ethanol (should be wrung out).

4. After the alcohol is completely volatilized, restarting the printer.



### 9. FCC Statement
