3. Introduction to Tattoo Transfer Paper

Yellow Bottom Paper
Blue Transfer Paper
Protect Paper

4. Paper Installation Guide

① Remove the protect paper.
② Tear off the yellow bottom paper.
③ Disconnect the charger immediately upon completion of charging.
④ Open the app and connect to the printer H2.
⑤ Turn on the printer.
⑥ Insert the blue transfer paper facing down.
⑦ Close the cover and turn on the printer.

5. Mobile Device Usage Guidelines

① Use a smartphone to scan the QR code.
② Download the app from the App Store or Google Play.

6. Transfer Guide

① Turn on the printer.
② Insert the blue transfer paper facing down, flat into the printer.
③ Close the cover and turn on the printer.

7. Charging Instructions

① Use isopropanol to clean your skin and apply a handwriting or rising words, should be cleaned in time.
② Turn on Bluetooth on your mobile phone.
③ Use a smartphone to scan the QR code.
④ Turn on the printer.
⑤ Insert the blue transfer paper facing down, flat into the printer.

8. Printer Cleaning

① Use isopropanol to clean the printer.
② Turn on the printer.
③ Insert the blue transfer paper facing down, flat into the printer.

9. FCC Statement

① Turn on the printer.
② Insert the blue transfer paper facing down, flat into the printer.
③ Close the cover and turn on the printer.
