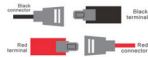


4. User Instruction

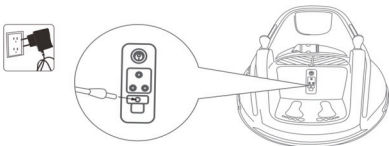


For first use, open the seat cover and insert the wires into the socket, red to red, black to black. While connecting the connectors to the storage battery, make sure they are connected in correct polarity.



Before Use

- Unscrew the screw and remove the seat cover.
- Connect the battery terminal (red to red, black to black).
- Replace the seat cover and tighten the screws.



1. The unit will not operate while charging.
2. Charge after each use.
3. Turn off the power when not in use.

Charging the battery

- Plug the charger into the charging port.
- Insert the charger's power plug into a stable matching AC power as shown above.
- Fully charge the battery for 4-6 hours.
- Do not charge the battery for more than 10 hours.
- Make sure the battery and charger are not damaged. Do not charge if any sign of wear or damage is found.
- To ensure safety, the vehicle must be charged by adults.

4. User Instruction

Operating the vehicle

- Press the power switch to turn on the vehicle.
- Push or pull the control sticks to move the vehicle.
- Release the control sticks back to the center position to stop.

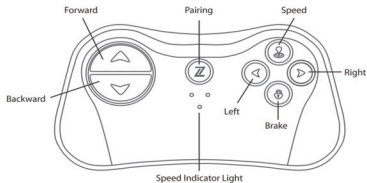
Constant close supervision by an adult is needed when your child is operating the vehicle.

5. Remote Controller

Features

- Supply voltage: 2 x 1.5V
- Frequency: 2450 MHz

Button description



- Forward: Direct the ride-on car to move forward
- Backward: Direct the ride-on car to move backward
- Pairing: Pair the ride-on car with a remote controller
- Left: Direct the ride-on car to turn left
- Right: Direct the ride-on car to turn right
- Speed: Adjust the speed of the ride-on car's movement as low, moderate or high
- Brake: Immediately stop the ride-on car and render it immovable until unlocking

6. Care and Maintenance

- Turn off the product and disconnect the battery if the product is not in use for a long period of time.
- Check the product regularly and make sure there are no missing or loose parts. Re-tighten any loose parts if necessary.
- Make sure there are no cracked or broken plastic parts.
- Always use the product away from any heat source, cover it with a tarp and away from wet weather.

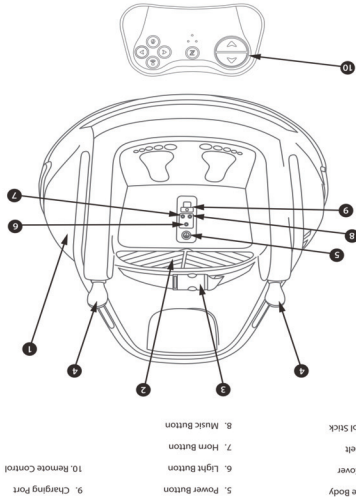
FCC Caution

- 1. Turn on the power of the ride-on car, press and hold the pairing button until the speed indicator light switches on without flashing.
- 2. Release the pairing button, and the speed indicator light will switch off.
- 3. If the speed indicator light switches on again, then the pairing is successful. If not, please repeat steps 1 and 2.

- 4. Once successful pairing is all you need, no more pairings are needed in later use.

1. Safety Instruction

When using an electrical product, basic safety precautions should always be followed including the following.

1. When charging you must turn off the power switch.
2. It is recommended to charge 4-6 hours before first use, but no more than 10 hours.
3. When the speed of the vehicle is significantly slowed during normal driving, the battery power is insufficient. Please charge it in time.
4. Please charge 8-12 hours after each use, but do not exceed 20 hours.

6. Care and Maintenance

- Clean the product with a cloth. Use a non-wax furniture polish to restore shine to plastic parts. Do not use abrasive cleaner.
- Do not clean the product with water or wash the product with a hose or immerse any parts in water or other liquid.
- Occasionally use lightweight oil to lubricate moving parts.

	Low Battery	Fully charge the battery
Vehicle runs very slow	Old Battery	Replace battery if necessary
	Vehicle is overloaded	Make sure user's weight is under 60 lb / 30 kg
	Vehicle is being used in harsh environment	Avoid using the vehicle in harsh environment
Vehicle needs a push to go forward	Poor wire connection	Check if the battery connectors are firmly connected.
	Disconnected / Badly connected Battery	Reconnect the battery
Battery does not charge	Disconnected / Badly connected Charger	Make sure the charger is firmly plugged into the power source and connected to the charging port
	Charger not working	Replace the charger
Charger feels warm with charging	Normal	

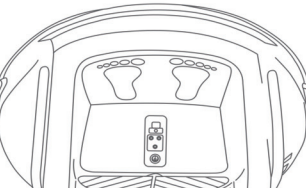
