

<p>PAIRING A SECOND NARWHAL® SPEAKER LID (STEREO SOUND)</p> <p>1) Connect to your primary lid as described on the previous page "CONNECTING AN AUDIO DEVICE". (Make sure the device is powered off during this step)</p> <p>2) While in close proximity to the primary lid, power on the second lid. Then double-click the power button on either lid to engage the sync function to the nearest speaker that's not in stereo mode.</p> <p>NARWHAL® Speaker Lids will each say "Connected" and the LED will blink twice on both lids.
