


Important: Do not use super fast charging with current above 2A to avoid damaging the circuit chip due to excessive current



Open the cover, the headset automatically turns on, automatic pairing, headset indicator light white-orange light synchronization alternating slow flash when pairing is successful



Turn on your mobile phone, search for BD2 devices and click on the connection.



The phone is successfully connected. Both headphone lights are off

If only one side has sound, please first delete the BD2 that has been connected, turn off the wireless of your phone, the earphones need to be paired once, enter the tws mode, and return to the first step

The connection steps are as follows:

Open the cover of the phone, first make sure the wireless of the phone is off, Take out the two headphones from the charging case, wait for 10 seconds, the headphone indicator light changes from fast flash to one headphone red and blue light blinking, one headphone light off, it means the headphones have been paired. Open the Bluetooth of your cell phone, search for "BD2", click to connect

Touch function

- 1: Click the headset touch area Play/Pause/Answer/Hang up
- 2: Double click on the left ear to open the ANC function
- 3: Double click on the right ear to open the pass-through function
- 4: Triple-click the headset touch control area Volume down/volume up
- 5: Four click on the headset touch control area previous song/next song
- 6: Long press the left earphone for 2 seconds to start Siri function
- 7: Long press 2 seconds on the right headset Game mode / music mode switching
