

EL228 Manual



Connection method

Remove earphones and get close to the unlocked phone.

Wait 8 seconds or so to turn on Bluetooth.

Search for Bluetooth name **(EL228)** and click connect.

AUTO-CONNECT: The phone does not delete the connection through the headset matching name, take out the headset can reconnect automatically

When charging the charging case,
orange light flashes.

When the charging case is fully charged, **orange light always on.**

Left side earbuds

Pause/play (touch **1 time**)

ANC on - transparency mode - ANC off (touch 2 times)

Reduce volume (touch 3 times)

Previous song (touch four times)

Reject call (press for 2 seconds)

Voice Assistant (press 3 seconds)



Right side earbuds

Pause/play (touch **1 time**)

ANC on - transparency mode - ANC off (touch 2 times)

Increase volume (touch 3 times)

Next song (touch 4 times) Reject

Call (press 2 seconds)

Game Mode-Music Mode (press 3 seconds)
