A4: Mp3 input jack

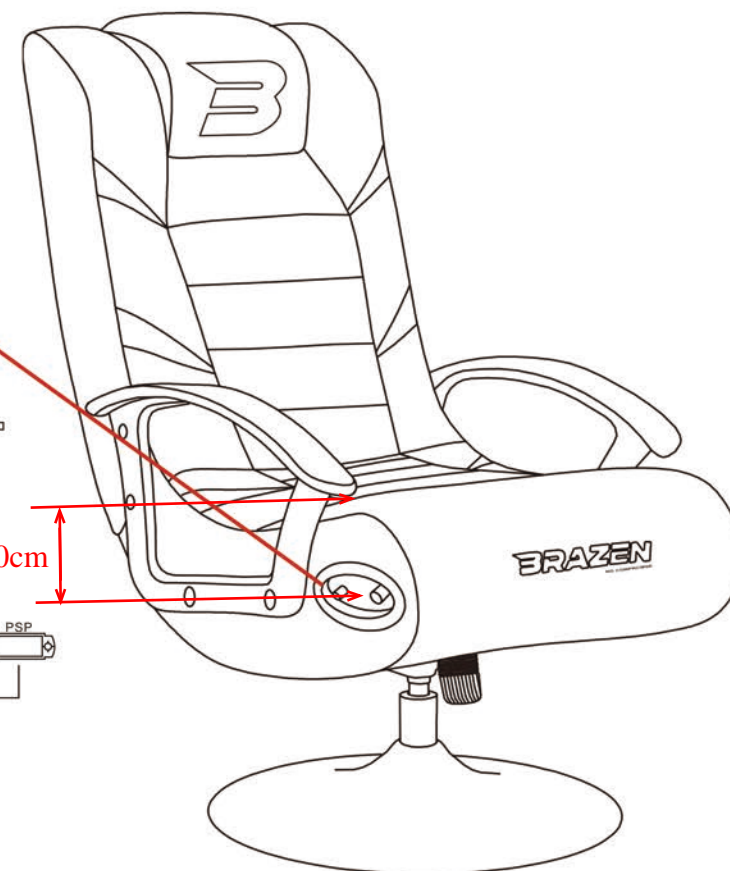
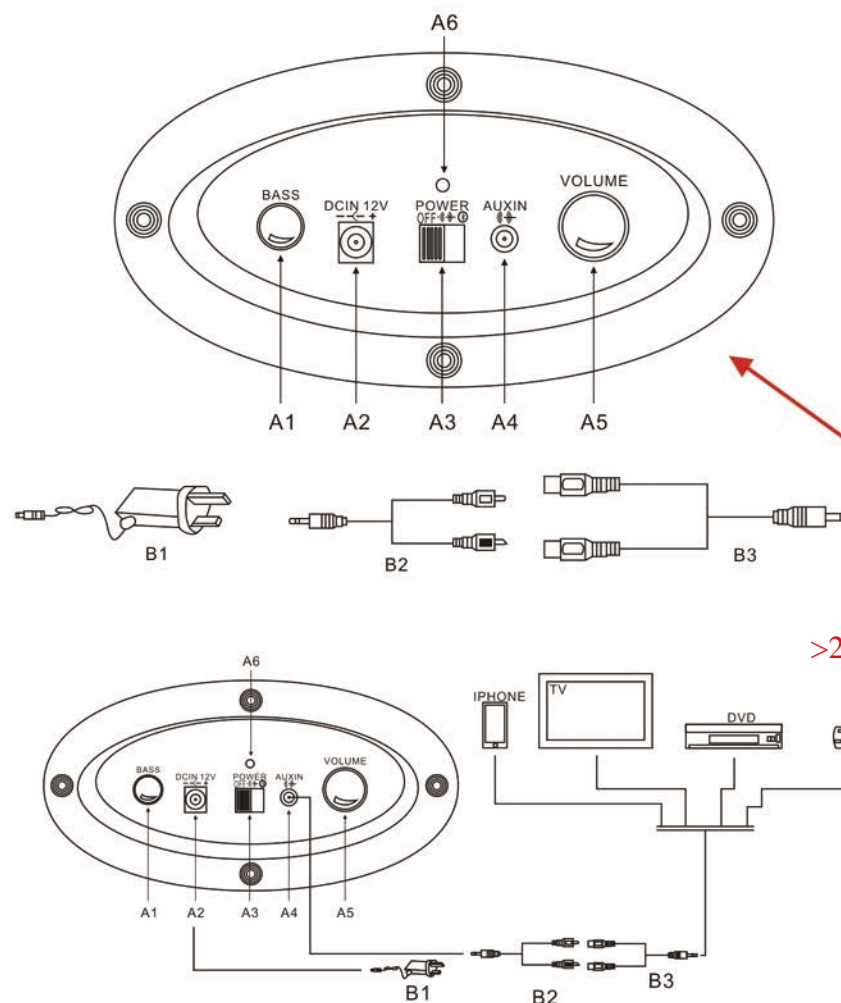
A5: Volume Adjustment
