Tip:

- 1. **Screen Image:** First, correct the keystone to a rectangle.
- 2. Adjust the focus button to gain the best clarity.
- 3. **Effective Projection Distance:** 2.4-2.6m

3. Mounting Hole: Adjusting a single mounting hole outside design, the projector is compatible with the standard corner hole and 1/8 inch deep projector hole. However, you can rotate up and down the screw to meet different height needs.

4. Attention: There are a few types of mobile phones on the market and the motherboard cannot support all mobile phones.
