## RGB LED DUAL MOUNT WIRELESS SPEAKER



### How to Use:

#### Power/Charging:

Connect the type-C charging cable to port that is to the left of the on-speaker control buttons and to an available USB the power adaptor. Please use a power adaptor with 10W or above to boost the speaker.

#### Turn ON/OFF:

Press and hold to turn ON/OFF the unit.

**Switch between Bluetooth and FM Mode:**  
Press 2 seconds to switch between Bluetooth and FM mode.

#### Connect to Bluetooth®:

1. Switch to Bluetooth® mode if in FM mode.
2. Search for Bluetooth® device named "BC-BS-128" on your mobile device when the LED indicator light flashes in blue.
3. You will hear a prompt sound when they are successfully paired.
4. The speaker will automatically turn off without connection after 5 minutes. To reconnect, you can turn on the speaker and it will automatically connect back to your device once they have been previously paired.

#### Bluetooth® Music Playback:

- Press once to play / pause the music.
- Press once to play the previous song.
- Press and hold to reduce the volume.
- Press once to play the next song.
- Press and hold to increase the volume.

**FM Radio Mode:**  
1. Switch to FM radio mode by pressing the button twice.

2. Press button to scan and save the radio stations with strong signals. The first scanned station will then be played.

3. Press button to play the next station;  
Press button to play the previous station.
