





Power On/Off and Pairing:
• Please Turn Press Rocker Switch 1 to Power On "I" / Power Off "O".
• Please make sure that the Bluetooth® of SP-PA200BT is in the Bluetooth®ready to pair state - LED Display is blinking "1111" while SP-PA200BT is Power On.

Bluetooth® Pairing:
• Place the Speaker within 33 ft for the Bluetooth®-enabled device.
• On your Bluetooth®enabled Device (Smartphone, Tablet, Media Player) navigate to the Bluetooth®setting menu, Turn On your Bluetooth® feature, and search for "JVC SP-PA200BT".
• Type Password "0000" or "1234" if requested.
• You will hear the Notification Beep, and the LED display "1111" will change from blinking to lit when both devices are paired.
• SP-PA200BT will be automatically reconnected to the last Paired Bluetooth® Device when Powered On again.
• Press and hold "1" button 3 to disconnect Bluetooth®, Press and hold again to re-connect Bluetooth®.

Bluetooth® Audio might have a choppy sound while a SP-PA200BT is scanning another SP-PA200BT, depends on Bluetooth® Paired Device. However, it is not defective. It will recover Short-Press "1" Button 3 or Power Off and On by Power Button 1 or leave it for around 30 seconds till completes TWS Scanning Mode.

Mode Change:
• With USB Drive attached, you can change Mode by Short-Press "MODE" Button 9 as below.
• It will skip the USB Mode, if USB Drive is removed.
