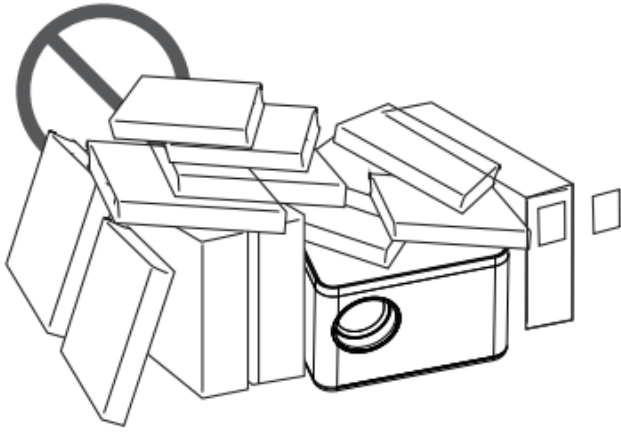

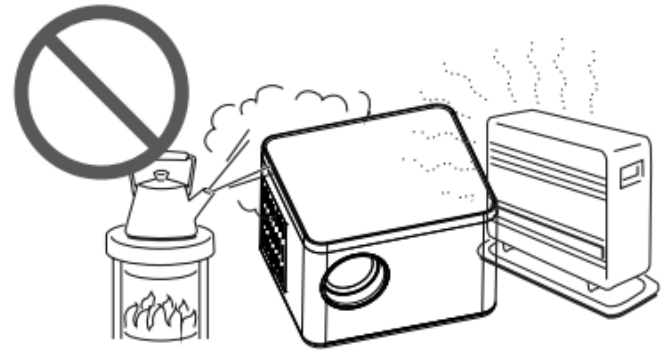
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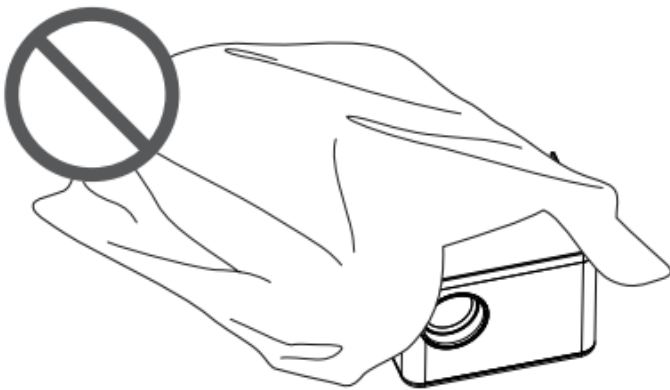
Important safety announcements



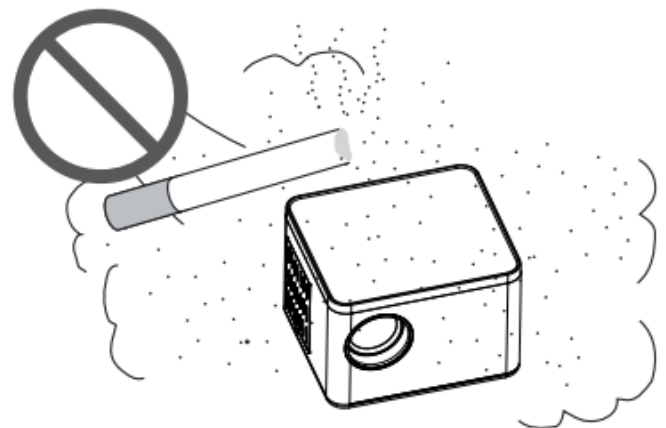
Don't install equipment in a poorly ventilated area



Don't install equipment in hot and humid areas



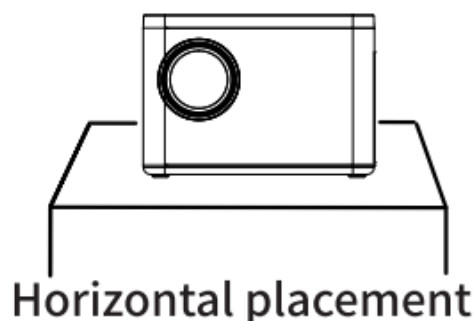
Don't block the vent (intake or exhaust)

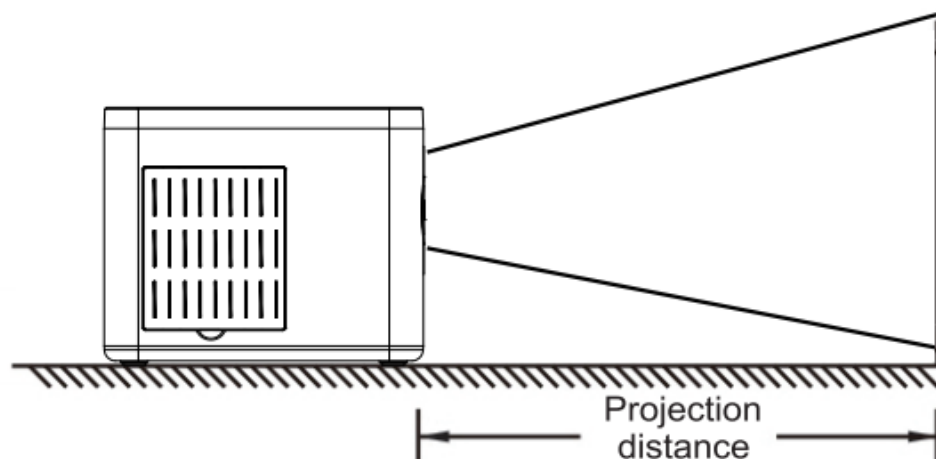
SETTING>SETTINGS>Projection Image Setting>Auto Trapezoid

This projector adds vertical trapezoidal automatic correction technology, you only need to turn on the Auto Trapezoid switch, the machine will automatically correct the image.

Open the automatic trapezoidal correction, four point trapezoidal correction can't be used.

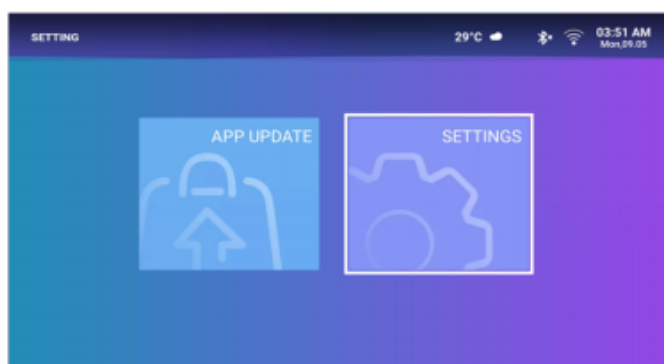
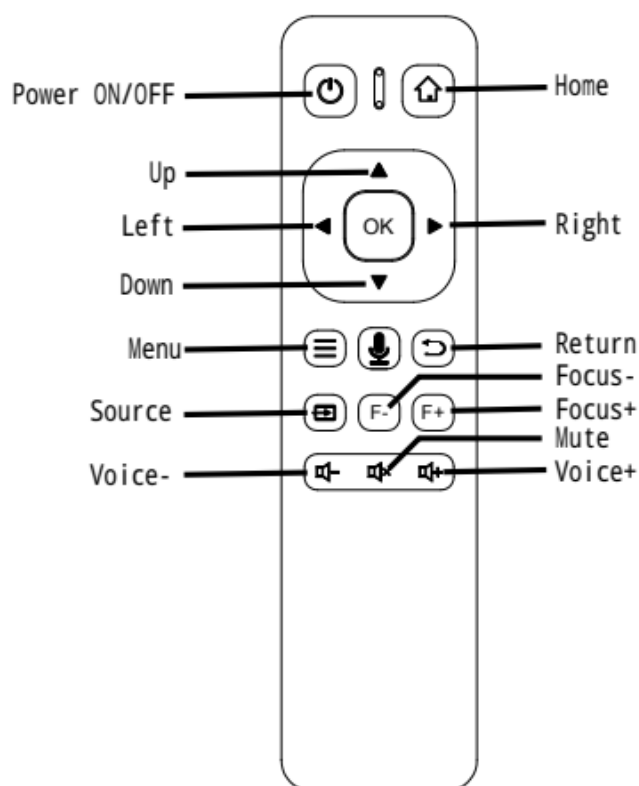
4.Safety shutdowns

You can turn off the projector and safely store the equipment by following these steps.

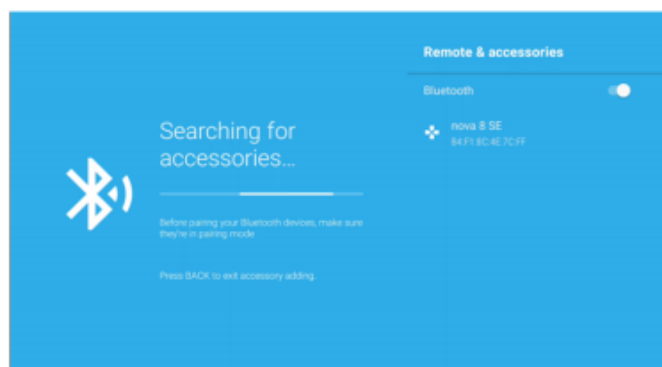
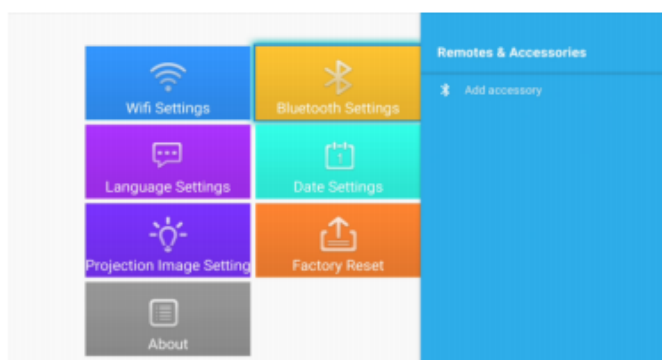
- 1.Press the  key on the projector operation panel or the  key on the remote control to turn off the equipment according to the system prompt.
- 2.Screw the focus ring into the equipment to ensure that the lens is fully incorporated into the equipment.
3. Store the equipment in a dry and cool place.

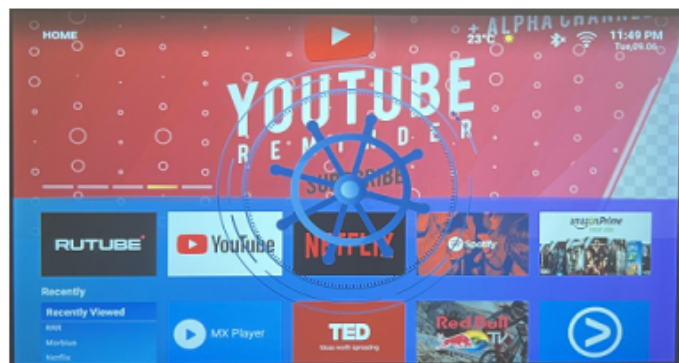

Electronic Focus Function

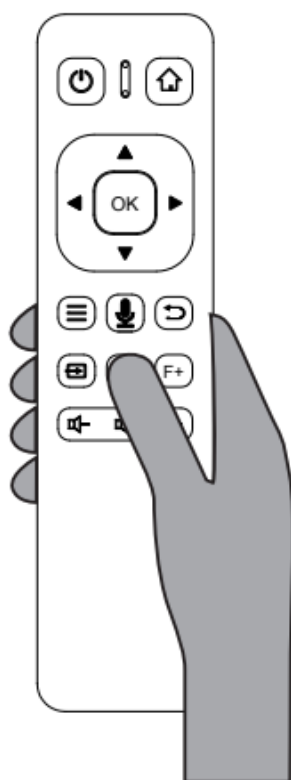
This projector adds the electronic focus function, which is more convenient and smarter than the traditional manual focus method.

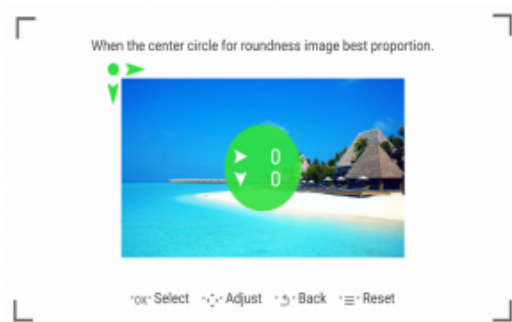
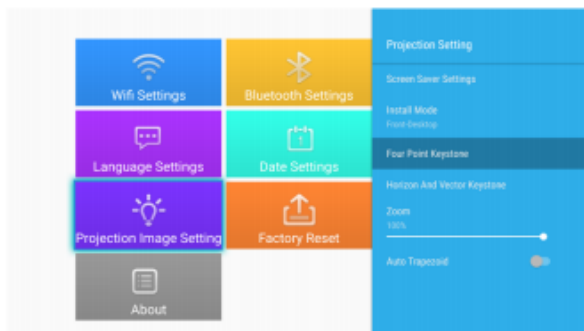
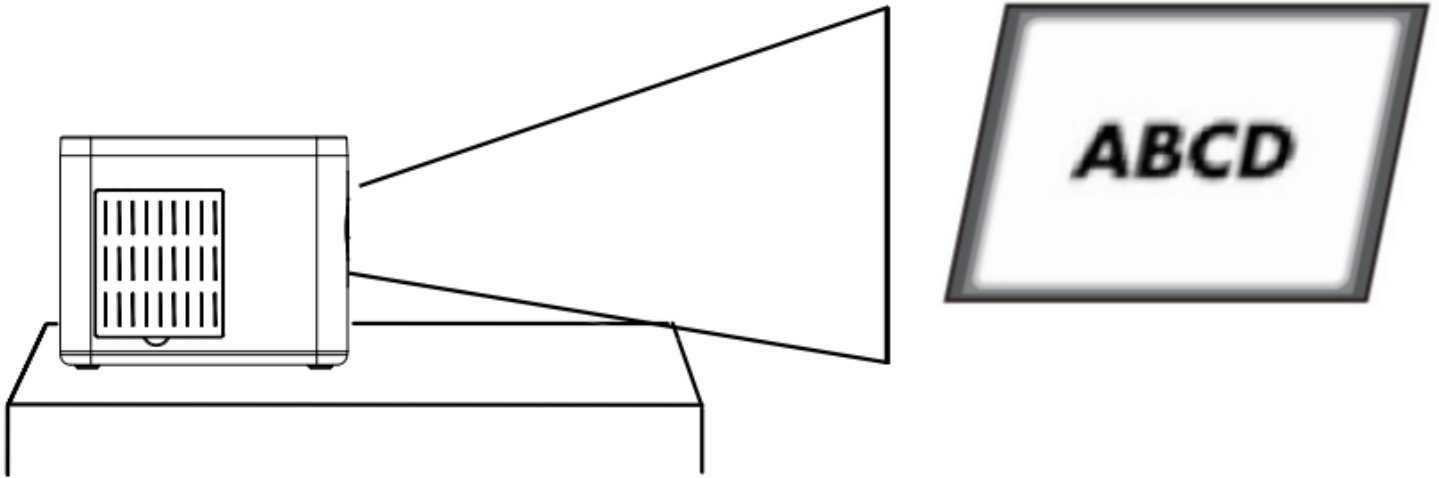

Note: When the lens cannot be adjusted, please release the button immediately to avoid motor damage.

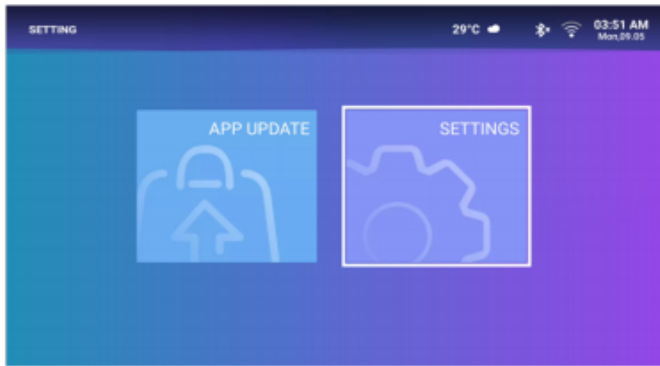
30° side projection image setting



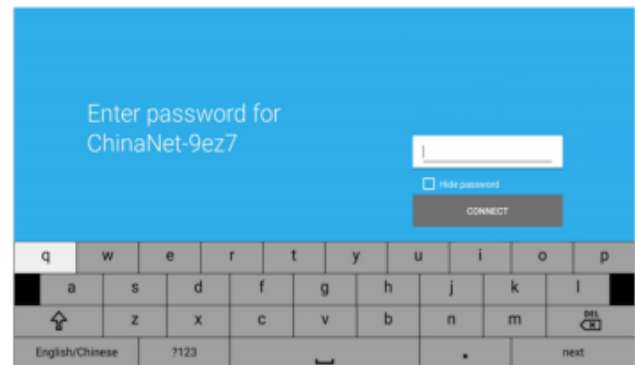
Settings>Projection Image Settings>Four Point Keystone

Chapter 6: Reminder

1. The projector is mainly used to watch native video or online video, and cannot be used as a mobile phone or computer.
2. If the remote control cannot control a third-party APP when in use, you need to use a USB mouse to assist in the operation.
3. To download a third-party video APP, please note that you need to download the TV version of the program, not the mobile version or other versions of the program.
4. This machine does not support Dolby encoded audio and video files.
5. If you don't use it for a long time, you need to cover the lens with a cover to prevent dust.
