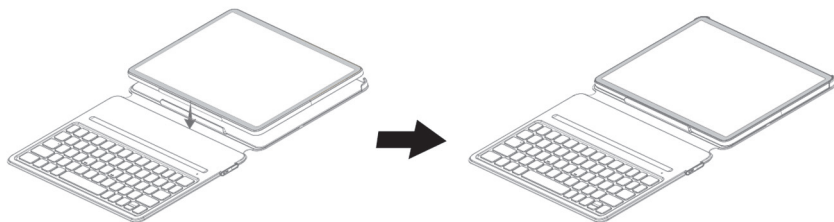
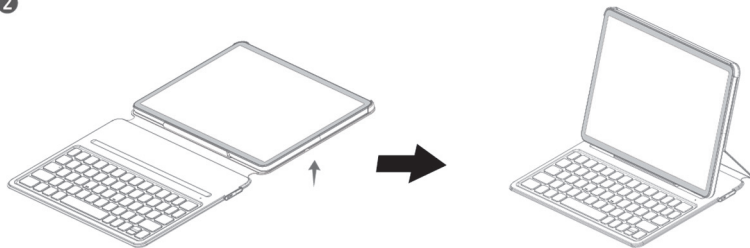

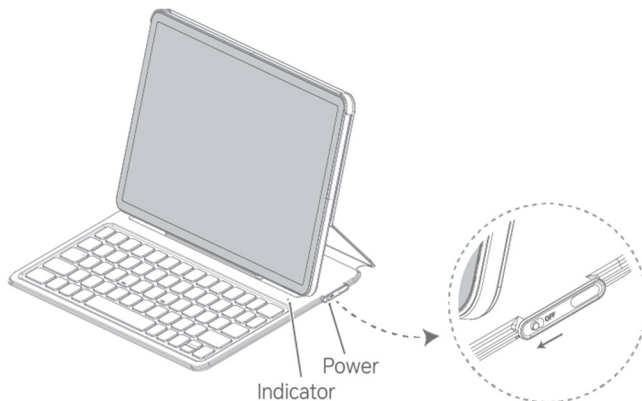

Power on and pairing

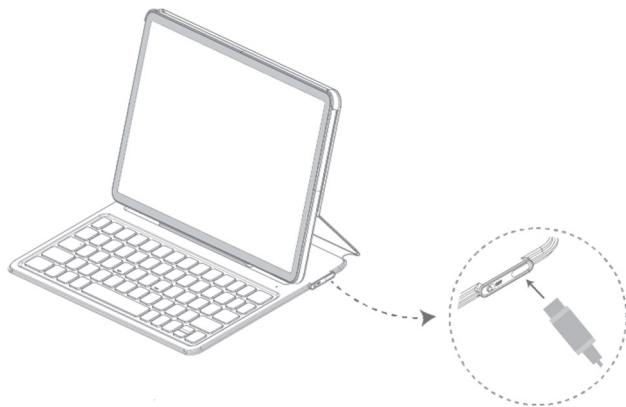
1. Turn on the keyboard.
2. Turn on the tablet's Bluetooth and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Bluetooth pairing of the keyboard and the tablet.



Tips: The keyboard can only pair and work properly when the tablet is secured in the notch. This keyboard is suitable for HONOR Pad X9.

Charging

Use a USB Type-C charger to charge the keyboard.



Tips: When the indicator flashes red, it means the battery is low, please charge it promptly.

Safety Information

Operation and safety

- Ideal temperatures: 0°C to 35 °C for operating, -20°C to +45 °C for storage.
