



Initial Use



The earbuds will be activated automatically once open the

Note: Both earbuds will be charging after putting them into charging case and cover the lid. If the earbuds can not be charged, please charge the charging case by inserting the Type-C cable at the same time. (more details as per the following instructions)

TWS Pairing and Connection with Cell Phone

Open lid to activate the earbuds automatically, both earbuds will auto pairing. Search for "DK2" in cellphone and tap to connect both earbuds with cellphone.

Restore the factory setting (in the case of TWS pairing failure)





Press and hold the MFBs of both earbuds for 8 seconds in power off mode. Don't release your fingers untill the red & purple lights flash alternately. At this moment both earbuds will auto pairing and the red & purple lights turn off. Put the earbuds into charging case and power on the earbuds, the earbuds will auto pairing. Search for 70kZ in cellphone and tap to connect both earbuds with cellphone.

Charging the earbuds



Put both earbuds into the charging case (Pins need to be well-contacted), the earbuds will be auto power off and start charging after cover the lid.

O Charging the earbuds

Method 1: Open the lid of charging case and the earbuds will auto power on. Method 2: Press and hold MFB for 3s to power on.

Method 1: Put both earbuds into charging case and cover the lid, the earbuds will auto power off.

Method 2: Press and hold MFB for 3s to power off.

Press MFB to answer inco ng call and press again to hang off it.



8 Reject Call

Press MFB for 1-2s to reject incoming call.



Automatic connect with last device

Open the lid to connect automatically with the last device which had been connected.
