This letter grants authorization for representative of Fluid Life to apply to the FCC for a change in identification as specified under 47CFR section 2.933 of the FCC rules.

The original certification FCC ID TFB-TIWI1-01 will remain valid.

This authorization applies to the Laird model TIWI1-01, FCC ID TFB-TIWI1-01. The original grant date was 12/10/2010.

Fluid Life will be marketing the TFB-TIWI1-01 module as a product under a new FCC Identifier. Fluid Life's grantee code is 2AYWR and proposes that it be issued FCC Identifier 2AYWR-FLWIFI1 for the module.

Laird has no control or responsibility with regards to the installation and use of the 2AYWR-FLWIFI1 module in the products outlined by Fluid Life. As a result, Fluid Life takes ownership and responsibility for compliance of their products which include the 2AYWR-FLWIFI1 module.

Any confidential information regarding the TFB-TIWI1-01 module shared to various test and certification firms shall remain confidential amongst the parties involved and not be shared to other third parties (including Fluid Life) unless authorized.
