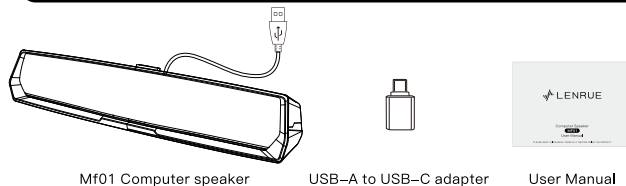

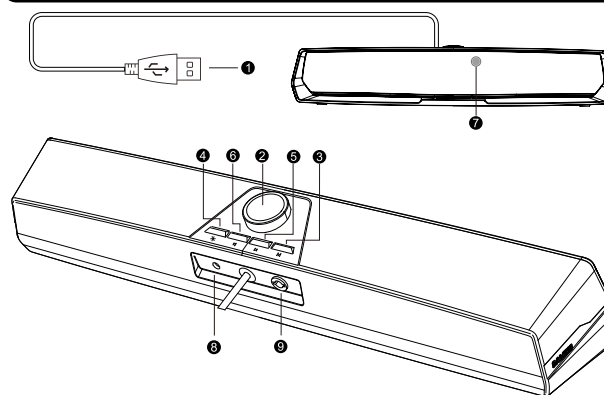

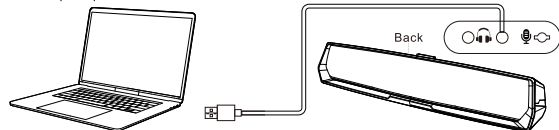
Product Diagram

- 1 USB Power:**
 - Connect to computer USB → Auto PC Mode (Data transfer). Can be switch to BT Mode by pressing the "M" button.
 - Connect to power USB → Auto BT Mode (Powered only), no other mode to choice.
- 2 Knob Controls:**
 - Long press → Power on/off ● Short press → Play/pause music ● Rotate → Adjust volume
- 3 M Mode Button:**
 - Short press → Switch between PC Mode/BT Mode ● Long press → Disconnect BT
- 4 Light Button:**
 - Short press → Turn light ON/OFF
- 5 Previous Track**
 - Short press → Previous Track
- 6 Next Track**
 - Short press → Next Track
- 7 Blue Indicator:**
 - PC Mode → Slow flashing BT Ready to Pair → Fast Flashing BT Connected → Steady
- 8 Headphone Port:**
 - Support 1/8 inch headphone
- 9 Microphone Port:**
 - Support 1/8 inch TRS microphone

Wired connection

The MF01 computer speaker does not have a built-in battery, when you insert the USB plug into the USB port on the desktop, laptop, tablet etc, the computer speaker defaults to "PC Mode" with voice prompt and "Power-on state".



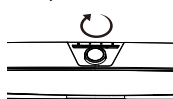
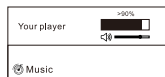
Step 1. Power on and Audio connection: Plug the USB cable to Your laptop or desktop.

Step 2. Control the Volume:

- 1 Set the computer sound at about 90% level.
- 2 Set the player sound at about 90% level.
- 3 Rotate the Speaker KNOB to adjust the volume.

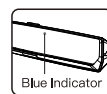

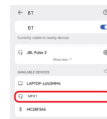
Wireless Connection Via BT

1. Switch MF01 to BT Mode



- 1 Plug the USB Plug to the computer USB port, Such as desktop, laptop, tablet etc, the computer speaker defaults to "PC Mode" with voice prompt, you should press the "M" button to switch to "BT Mode".
- 2 Plug the USB Plug to USB Power Port. Such as a usb power bank, a power strip with USB port, the speaker defaults to "BT Mode" with voice prompt.

2. Pair with your device



- 1 Turn on the BT of your device and search for nearby devices.
- 2 Find "MF01" in the search results and tap to connect.

Once connected, a beep will be heard and the flashing blue light will become steady.

NOTE:

- Make sure MF01 computer speaker isn't connected to other devices, otherwise please disconnect this device by long press the "M" button.
- Keep MF01 and your device within 16ft/5m.

Troubleshooting of Sound

If there is no sound comes out or the sound is low from the speaker, please try the following operations:

- > Rotate the volume knob clockwise to raise the volume of the soundbar.
- > Adjust the volume on your device.
- > Adjust the volume on the playing player.
- > Re-insert the USB plug.

Troubleshooting of BT Connection

- > Make sure that the Speaker is on BT Pairing mode (BT blue indicator flashes fast)
- > Make sure the BT of the Speaker is not connected by other devices.
- > Disconnect the BT connection to all the device, research "MF01" to pair with.
- > Delete "MF01" memorized on your device, then search for "MF01" and connect again.
