The Server is **security hardware made for data exchange of isolated Systems and network segmentations** for which reason the internal photos should not be accessible publicly/ without special approval.

This information is only available for the producer and specific evaluated clients and is not shared publicly.

The product is only for digital defence purpose and must be kept secret. Only the producer should know and will have to work with the components which are mounted inside the server.

**Requesting Long-Term Confidentiality for internal photos:**

- The internal components are not accessible for users. Therefore, the product was designed with sheet metal case. This case is closed with a seal and must not be opened after delivery. (Tempest approved Product/ BSI German Zoned Products List)
- The product is not accessible to the public. It is only for digital defence purpose and is sold only to selected third parties. In this environment only professional technicians, underlying the NDA, will work with/ on the product itself.

iesy GmbH requests the exhibits selected above as short-term confidential to be withheld from public view for the period as indicated above.
