

Cautions

Precautions and Maintenance

- · For indoor use only.

- Iffingerprints or dust accumulate on the LCD screen, we recommend using a soft.
 non-abrasive cloth such as a camera lens cloth to clean the LCD screen.
 Moisten the cleaning cloth with the cleaning solution and apply the cloth to the screen.








Get the App and Create Account

You'l need the free app to use the features of your Al-Calendar to their full potential. Download theapp on Google Play or APP Store and get started.










Initial Setup on Device

Turn on your Al-Calendar, select (your preferred) language, connect to wifi and choose the time zone and city,then enter your 6-digit activation code to get started.



Syncing a New Calendar (Syncing can only be done through the app.)

- 1. Open Sync on the home screen.
- 2. Select"Sync a NewCalendar"
- 3. Syncing Google Calendar If you're syncing a work calendar that uses Google Workspace, select Google.
 - ① Choose two-ways sync or one-way sync as you need.
 - ② Enter your Google Calendar email address and press Sync a new calendar.
 - ③ Choose the account you want to sync.
 - 4 Wait for your calendars to download.
 - ⑤ Choose the calendars you want to sync and press Sync Calendar.
 - 6 Tap "See Events" to complete process.







1.Matters

You can view your events in different views on the app or device to suit your needs.

2.Matters-APP

You can view your events in a Month or Week view. Tap into an event to view details.






Event Details

Viewing Calendar-Device

You can view your events in a Day, a Week, a Month, or Schedule view. Tap on an event to view details. You can pinch and zoom to show more or fewer hours in the day.

Creating Matters

You can create events on your AI-Calendar from both the mobile app and the device. Events created on the device will syncto the AI-Calendar app and vice-versa. If you have synced a Google Calendar with two-way-sync, changes you make with AI-Calendar will reflect back too.

1. Press the inthe bottom right. In Month View, you can press and hold on a date to quickly add an event on that date (not shown).

- 2. Choose Event.
- 3. Enter your details and press Save.





- 1. Press the (+) in the bottom right corner and choose Event.
- 2. Enter your event details and press Save.





Recurring Events

You can create events that occur on a recurring basis. Events can recur in the following ways:

- Daily
- On certain days of the week (e.g., Tues, Thurs)
- Weekly
- · Every X weeks
- Annually

Events can also repeat until a specified end date.


- 1. Open an Event's details and press Edit.
- 2. Edit your event details and press Save.






Once created, you can set notifications in "My Calendar - Notice - Open Push Notifications".





Edit Event

- 1. Tap an event to view details and press Edit Event.
- 2. Enter your new event details and press Save.



Chore Chart

Chores are an effective way to keep track of tasks for the entire household. Different types of chores can be created to organize the various tasks that need to be completed.


- 1. Press 'matter cate'
- 2. Tap to create a new category
- 3. Select a category to assign chores





Chore Chart

- 1. Press th ⊕ in the bottom right of the Chores screen to add a new chore.
- 2. Name the chore and assign it to as many family members as you'd like. This will create a separate chore for each member. If you'd like the chore to repeat daily, weekly, or monthly, toggle on 'Repeats'.



3. Press 'Save' to create your chores.



Meal plan-APP

Plan dinners for the entire week or month using the Meal Plan feature, which is included with your Al-Calendar.

- 1. Tap 'Meal, then press the in the bottom right comer of the home screen or meal screen, and select 'Breakfast' 'Lunch' 'Dinner' 'Snack' Plan
- 2. Enter the dinner name, date, and details, then press 'Save.'
- 3. The dinner has now been added! You can view it in the list of events.

4. Click on the dates corresponding to 'Breakfast', 'Lunch', 'Dinner' and 'Snack' to add the "Meal Plan".




Photo & Video

The photo album supports uploading pictures and videos, and allows multiple people to share.

Photo & Video-App

You can upload your pictures or videos using the app's photo gallery function.

- 1. Press the 'Add 'icon to share pictures or videos with others who use the device.
- 2. Click the 'Add Image' icon to upload an image or video.
- 3. Click on the uploaded pictures or videos to add titles and comments.








Photo & Video-Device

- 1. Photo albums can display the pictures or videos uploaded from our phones.
- 2. Clicking the button at the lower right corner can automatically play the photo.



Weather

- 1. Click the weather icon on the left side of the homepage to search for the temperature of any city
- 2. Click the °C°F icon to display the air temperature at "°F" or "°C"
- 3. Display the weather forecast for the current day and the next 7 days.



Sleep Mode

Sleep Mode automatically turns off your device between the scheduled hours.


Tap the screen anytime to wake Al-Calendar.

(Sleep Mode can only be configured from the device.)

Scheduled Sleep and Instant Sleep

- 1. Tap the moon icon located at the bottom of the sidebar.
- 2. Toggle on "Sleep Mode Schedule" and select the time for your Calendar to go to sleep and wake up. Press "Saveto confirm. When your Calendar is in Sleep Mode, you can press the power button at any time to wake it up.
- 3. Tap "Enter Sleep Mode Now" to tur off the display. Press the power button again to wake up your Al-Calendar.


- 1. Choose from Small, Medium, or Large font sizes in "Settings.

install

Wall Mounted

1. Use the provided hooks and matching screws (A) to secure the stand to the wall, ensuring the U-shaped side faces outward.



2. Align the U-shaped section with the groove on the back of the device. Hang the device byhooking it onto the top, allowing it to be mounted either horizontally or vertically.

Troubleshooting Guide

The device responds slowly or stutters

- Clean up storage: Delete unnecessary files, photos, or apps.
- Restart the device: Shut down and restart the device to release the memory.
- Check applications: Close unused background applications.
- Restore Factory Settings (only if necessary): After backing up the data, select Restore factory Settinas in the Settings.

Unable to play audio or video

- Check volume Settings: Confirm that the device is not silent and adjust the volume to an appropriate level.
- Check file format: Ensure that the file format is compatible with the format supported by the device.
- Restart the device: Try to shut down and restart the device

The device automatically shuts down or restarts

- Check the temperature of the device: The device may automatically shut down due to overheat. Avoid use
- in high temperature environment.
- Update system firmware:Ensure that the device is running the latest system version.

Unable to update the system or application

- Check the network connection: Ensure that the device is properly connected to the network
- Check storage space: Ensure that the device has sufficient storage space for updates.
- Try manual update: Go to Setting check and perform system or application updates.
