- 1) Answer / reject music:
 - Answer: if there is an incoming call, the system prompts the caller number (includes phone support, and you can tap **Answer** button to answer the call or press and hold it to reject the call.
- 2) Answer / reject via voice / I can't hear you:
 - Answer: if there is an incoming call, you can say "OK" to answer the call or "NOT" to reject the call.
 - Note: Voice control may be unavailable in noisy environment.
- 3) Call log:
 - Tap **Call** button below **connectivity** to look back the last call.
- 4) Voice control:
 - Tap **Voice** button below **connectivity** to do number via voice (includes phone support, **OK**, the **Play** / Pause / Voice control / Previous / Next).
 - Play / Pause / Voice control: Press **Play** button and tap it again: to ensure playing.
 - Volume control: in music playing state, press this **Volume** **▲/▼** button to adjust.
 - Previous / Next: in music playing state, press this **Previous** **◀** / **Next** **▶** button to select previous/next track.
- 5) Voice switching in the Smart Assistant, Press the green key for 3s to activate voice working, the Screen **English** becomes

Charging Feature
