一、Item Activation & Binding & Reset

Turn On

Hold function button for 2s – "Di" confirms activation.

Turn Off

Hold function button until hearing:
"Di" → "Di-Di" → "Di-Di-Di" (Release at final tone)


Reset

Hold button until tones:
"Di" → "Di-Di" → "Di-Di-Di" → keep holding 5s
Release at sustained "Diiii" to restore defaults.

二、How to Connect




① Open Apple "Find My" App



③ Click "Add Item"

② Turn on the Gi tag



④ Select "Other Supported Items"



⑤ Click "Connect" on Gi tag

[Note: Keep Gi tag within ≤5cm of device]

Directions in Maps
View this item on a map and use the Maps app to navigate to it.

Play Sound
Find your item by playing a sound from your iPhone

Lost Mode

Allow others to locate your item in Find My.

⑦ Select item emoji, click "Continue"

⑧ Click "Finish" (Mandatory)

⑨ Select associated Apple ID - Click "Finish" (Mandatory)

⚠ Note:

- Successful connection: Item beeps “Di-Di”.
- If the item is already registered to someone else's Apple ID, the original owner will need to “remove Item” before it can be added. (Single-device pairing limitation)

⚠ Requirements

(1) Apple-Exclusive Compatibility

✓ iPhone/iPad with iOS/iPadOS 14.5+

✓ Apple Watch (latest watchOS)

✗ **Android incompatible**

(2) Pre-Connection Checklist

- Bluetooth: Active
- Internet: Connected
- Share My Location : “Settings” App → Apple ID → Find My

Pairing Other Devices

⚠ Single-Device Limitation

- Remove existing pairing ("Remove Item" in Find My)
- Reset Gi tag
- Connect new device

三、Function Introduction


Locate your Item

(1) Find Item Locator

- Tap "Play Sound" → Item Locator emits "Di Di Di" sound when it is nearby

(2) Find your Item Locators location

- Last known location appears as your custom emoji on map → Tap "Directions"
- Navigates to recorded location



Find Item when Out of Range

(1) Enable the "Notify When Left Behind" toggle

- you will receive a notification when you leave your Item Locator behind and it is no longer in range of your device.



Notify When Left Behind Except at 2 locations



(2) Enable the “Notify when Found” toggle

- when your Item location is seen by another "Find My" enabled device, you will receive a notification of its updated location.



(3) Activation Rules

⚠️ “Notify when Found” only activates when:

- Item is out of Bluetooth range
- “Left Behind” mode is triggered

When Your Item is Lost

(1) Enable Lost Mode

- Open Apple "Find My" App
- Select your "Gi tag" under "Items"
- Select "Enable"
- Tap "Continue"
- Enter Phone → Next
- Enter E-Mail → Next
- Activate

WHAT WILL HAPPEN?

- Notify When Found**
You will receive a notification when the location becomes available.
- Find My Lock**
This item is linked to your Apple ID so no one else can pair with it.
- Leave a Message**
Leave a phone number or email address for the finder of your item to contact you.

⚠️ Critical Notes:

- “Notify When Found” auto-enables with “Lost Mode”.
- Device lockout: when “Lost Mode” is enabled, your Item locator is locked and cannot be paired to a new device.

Updating Contact Information in Lost Mode

(1) Access Lost Mode Settings

- ① Open Apple "Find My" App
- ② Select your "Gi tag" under "Items"



(2) Access Lost Mode Settings


- ① Tap "Enabled"
- ② Update Phone/Email → Tap "Save"

⚠ Critical Notes:

- "Turn Off Lost Mode" when you don't need to activate lost mode.


Identify Found Item & Contact The Owner

- ① Turn on the Gi tag
- ② Open Apple "Find My" App
- ③ Tap "Identify Found Item" ("Item" page)
- ④ "Searching items..."
- ⑤ Select "Gi tag" → Tap "Continue"
- ⑥ Access "Learn About This Item" interface
- ⑦ Activate product portal via "Learn More" link
[Press and hold the button for 5s, 1 beep will sound, and then 2 beeps.]
- ⑧ Tap "Continue On Website"
- ⑨ Displays your item's contact information (requires internet)




四、Item Removal

Delete Specific Gi tag



- ① Open Apple "Find My" App
- ② Tap "Items" Swipe left target tag → Tap "Remove Item"
- ② Or Slide down to the bottom tap → Tap "Remove Item"
- ③ "Remove Item?" → Tap "Remove"
- ④ Tap "Remove"

[Wait for the device to emit a "Di Di" sound to indicate successful removal]
 [Once item has been removed, it will need to be set up to use it again]



Confirm with Remove in pop-up

- ⚠ Prerequisite: Ensure "Lost Mode" is disabled before deletion
- ⚠ Successful deletion: Item beeps "Di-Di-Di"

五、Battery Replacement & Maintenance

Preparation


- ① Tools: Plastic spudger × 1
- ② Environment: Dry, dust-free, anti-static

Disassembling the Housing


- ① Gently insert the spudger into the edge gap of the "Gi tag" locator. Slowly pry open the cover along the seam.
 [Press and hold the button for 5s, 1 beep will sound, and then 2 beeps.]
- ② Separate the housing into two parts (typically top/bottom plates). Store securely to prevent loss.

Remove Old Battery


- ① Hold battery edges with fingers, remove with positive (+) pole facing up

⚠ CRITICAL NOTES

- ① SAFETY: Swollen/leaking batteries → Handle with gloves
→ Dispose at recycling points
- ② ORIENTATION: New battery MUST have (+) pole facing up
- ③ TEST: Check power via 「Find My」 + Shake gently to confirm stability

◆ KEY STEPS:

Align Force · Orient (+) · Clean & Dry · Secure Cover

六、Share items

七、Privacy & Security Configuration

Anti-Tracking Alerts & Protection

(1) Trigger Scenario


When unpaired devices detect an unknown Gi tag moving with you for **3–6+ hours**.

(2) Response Protocol

- ① iPhone displays "Gi tag Found Moving With You" alert
→ Tap "View Details"
- ② Tap "Items Detected With You"
- ③ Activate "Sound Playing" → Locate tag via distinct chime


⚠ If malicious:

Remove battery + give a warning



Temporary Alert Deactivation

- ① Tap "Gi tag Found Moving With You" alert notification message
- ② Tap "Pause Tracking Notifications"
- ③ Tap "Pause for Today"
