●Content description

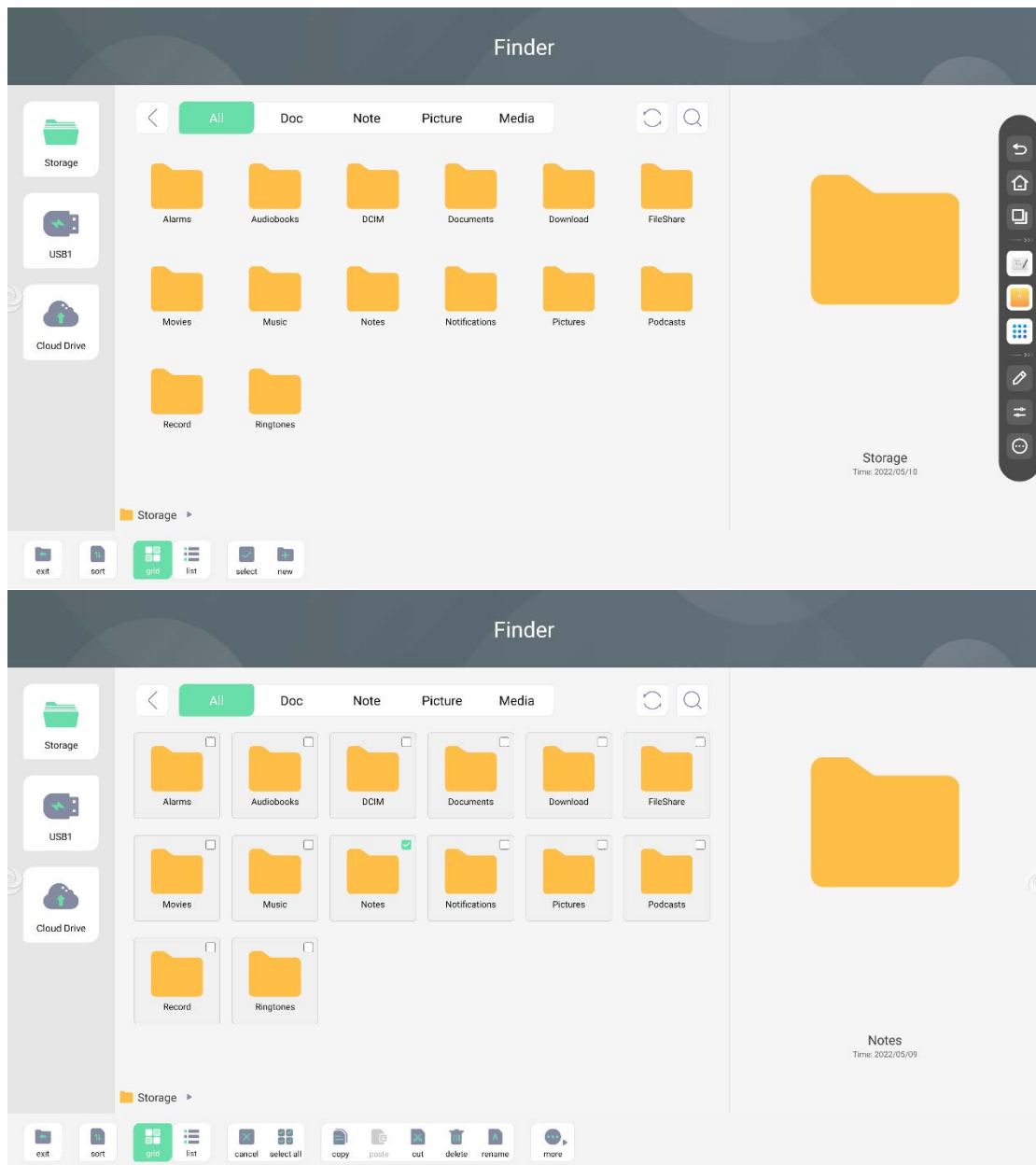
1. Status display: hotspot, wired network, USB, WIFI, etc. As shown in figure:



2. Main desktop: Whiteboard writing, browser, wireless screen transfer, and file browsing.

B. File browsing

1. File classification: documents, blackboard writing, pictures, audio and video.
2. Can refresh, file search.
3. file operation: file selection, full selection, new file, copy, cut, delete, rename.
4. sort: according to the name, type, size, time, sort.
5. File viewing: list, tiling.



C. More tools

●What are more tools?

More Tool is a quick tool App on the meeting board, which provides convenient functions in various scenarios and assists in meeting requests such as file transfer, voting, screen recording, stopwatch, screenshot, and photo taking.



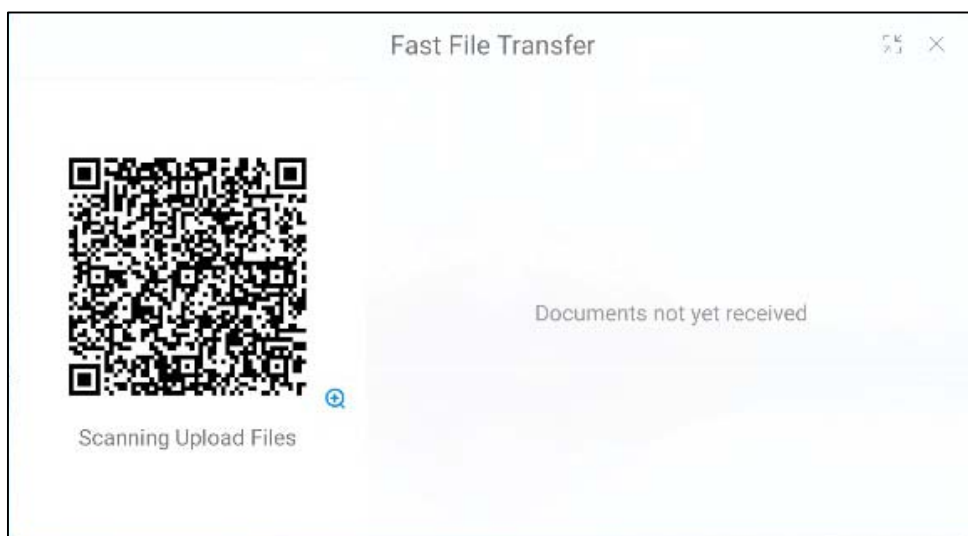
●Batch tool

Click "Annotation" in "More Tools" to open the annotation tool; The annotation function allows users to write content in the current screen and annotate information.

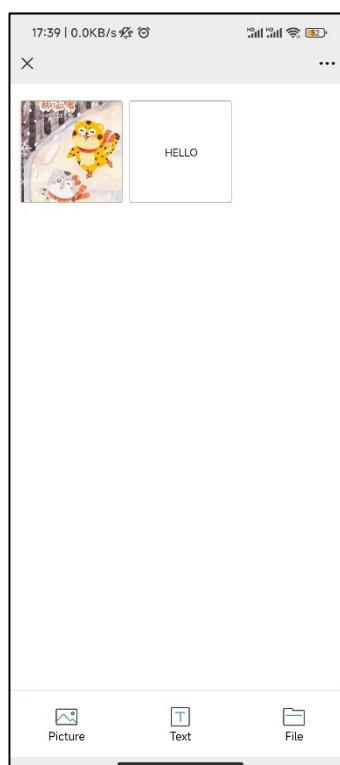
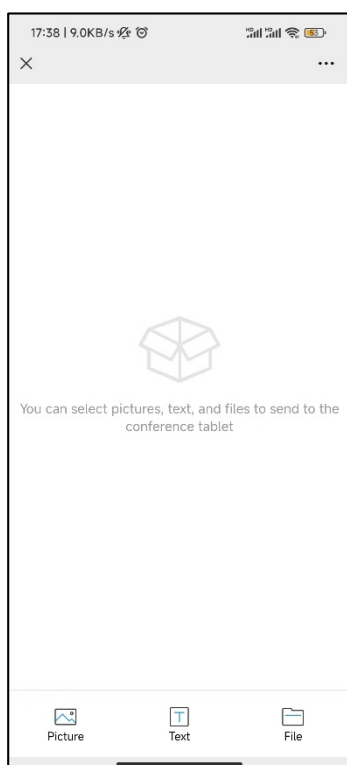


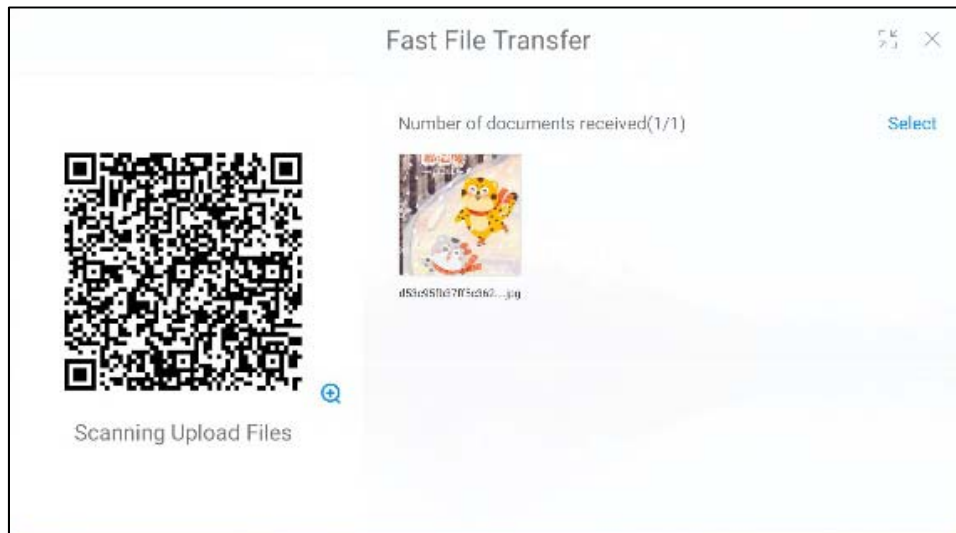
●Quick pass gadget

Click "File Transfer" in "More Tools" to open the file transfer widget.

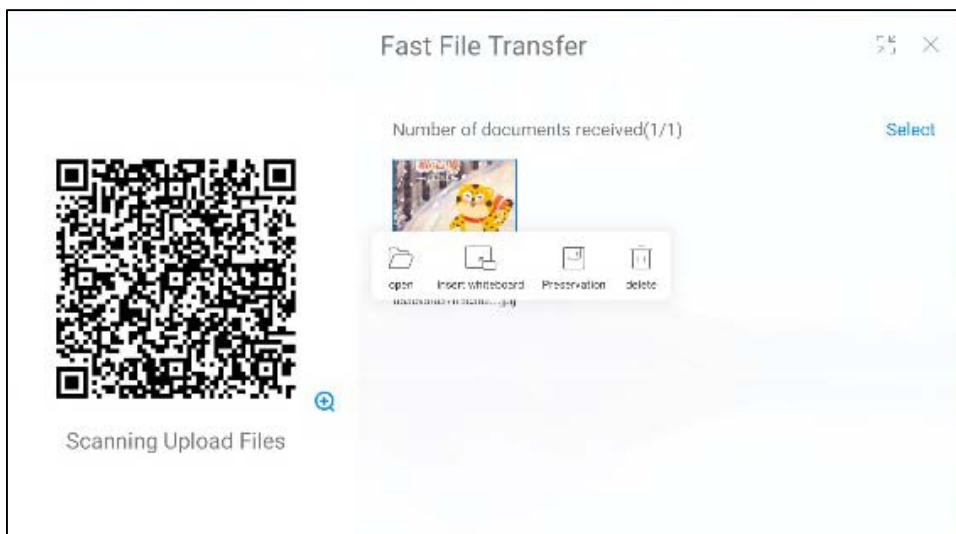


1. Upload pictures, texts and files on the mobile terminal after scanning codes.





2. Click the received file in fast transmission on the big board to display the toolbar, and you can open, insert (picture) into the whiteboard, save and delete the file.



●Recording screen small tools

1. Click the "Screen recording" icon in "More Tools" to open the small screen recording tool.

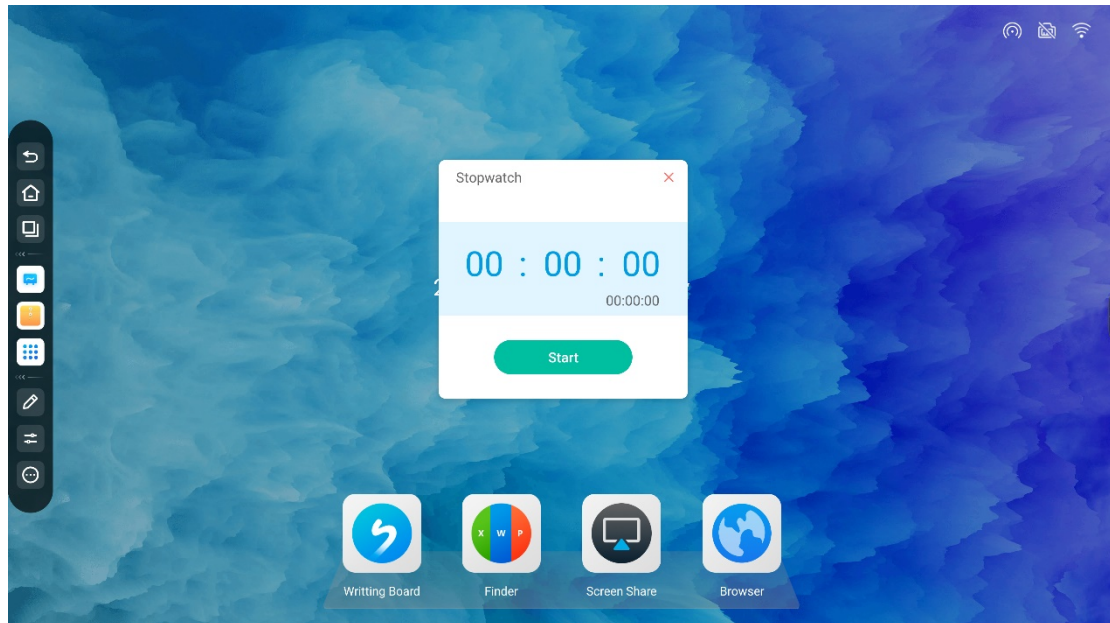


2. Click OK to record on the screen.

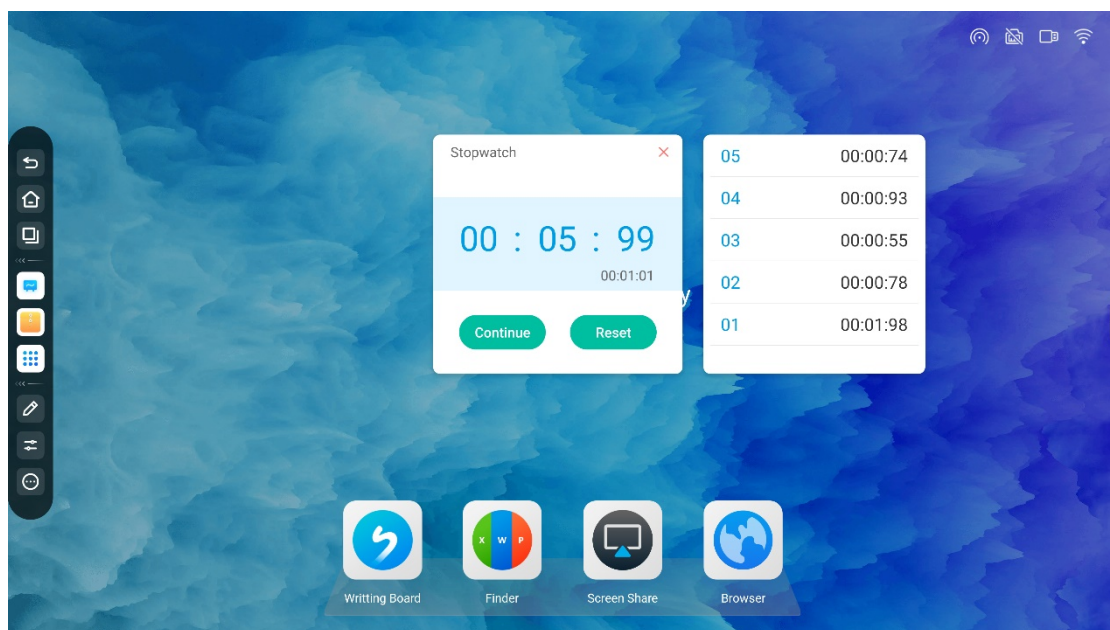


● Stopwatch gadget

1. Click the "Timer" icon in "More Tools" to open the stopwatch.

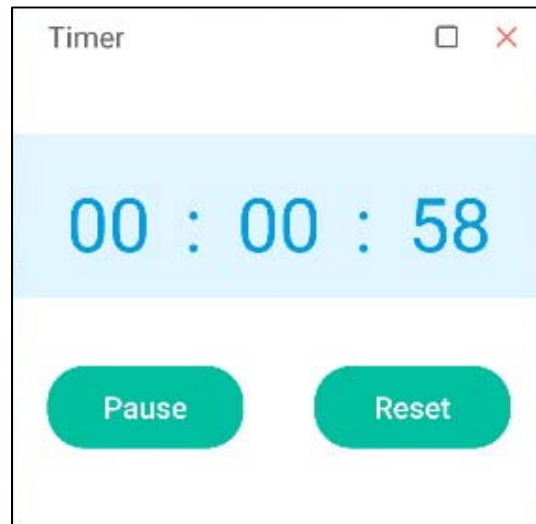


2. Click "Start" to pause and count. Click "pause" to resume or reset the timer.



● Countdown gadget

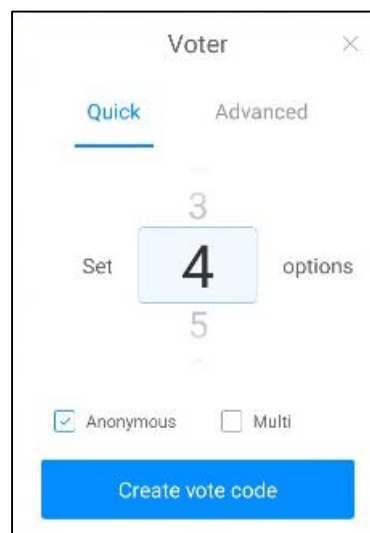
1. Click "Start" button to start the countdown according to the selected time.



2. Check "ringing reminder after the end" before the countdown will be ringing reminder; When the countdown is over, a positive timer will start to record the timeout time.

●Voting gadget

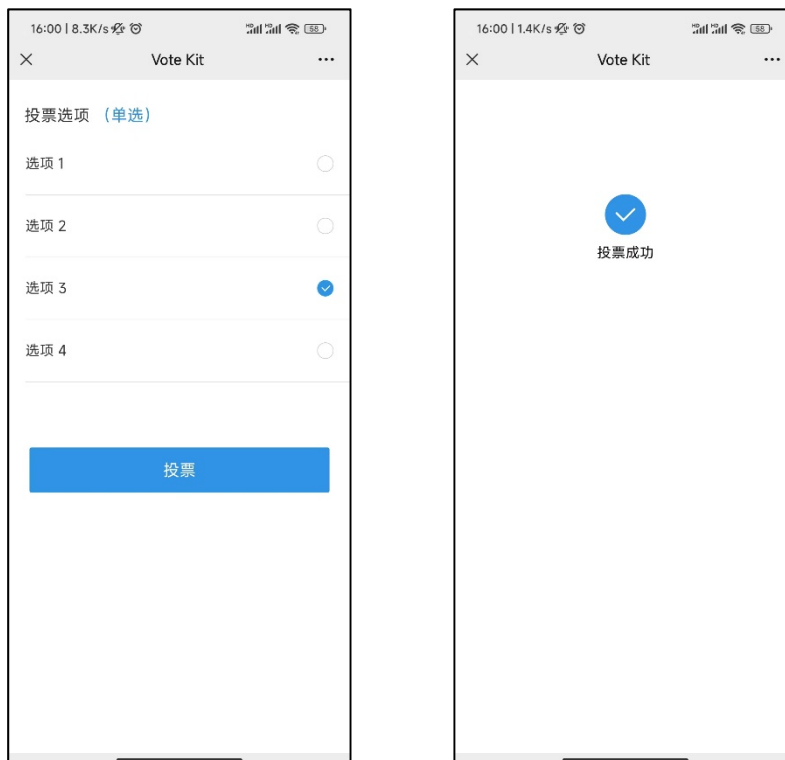
1. Click the "Voting Machine" icon in "More Tools" to open the voting widget.



2. Click "Generate Voting Code" to immediately generate the qr code of voting for the specified number of options.

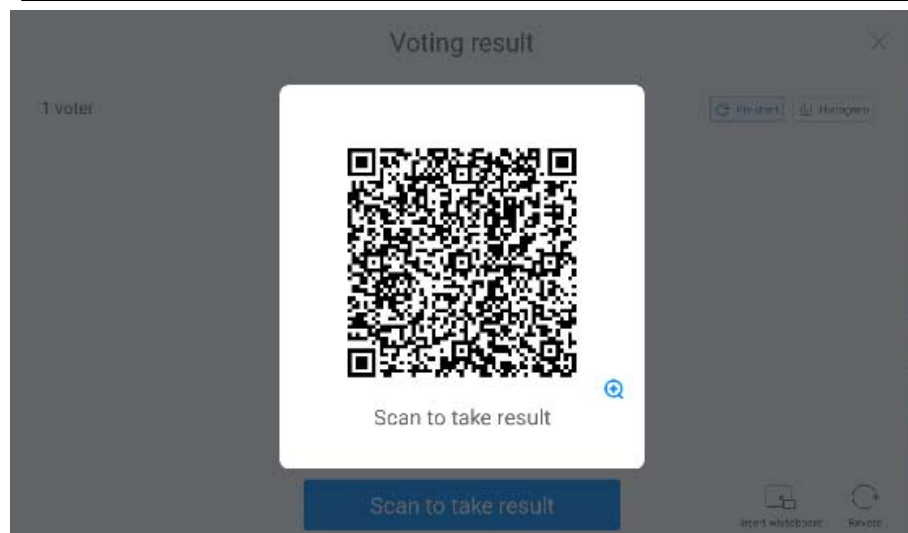
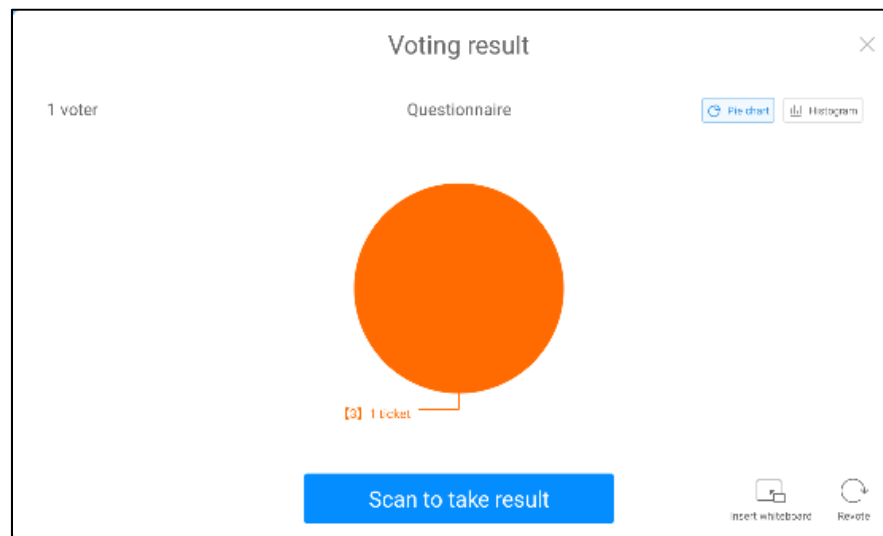


3. Click "Anonymous" to vote anonymously.
4. Click "multiple selection" to allow voters to select multiple options.
5. Click "Scan and Edit", and the poll initiator can edit the questionnaire options on the mobile phone. After clicking to initiate the vote, other participants can scan the TWO-DIMENSIONAL code on the big board to view the questionnaire.



6. Voting results support bar chart, pie chart display, voting results can be

inserted into the white board, scan code away.



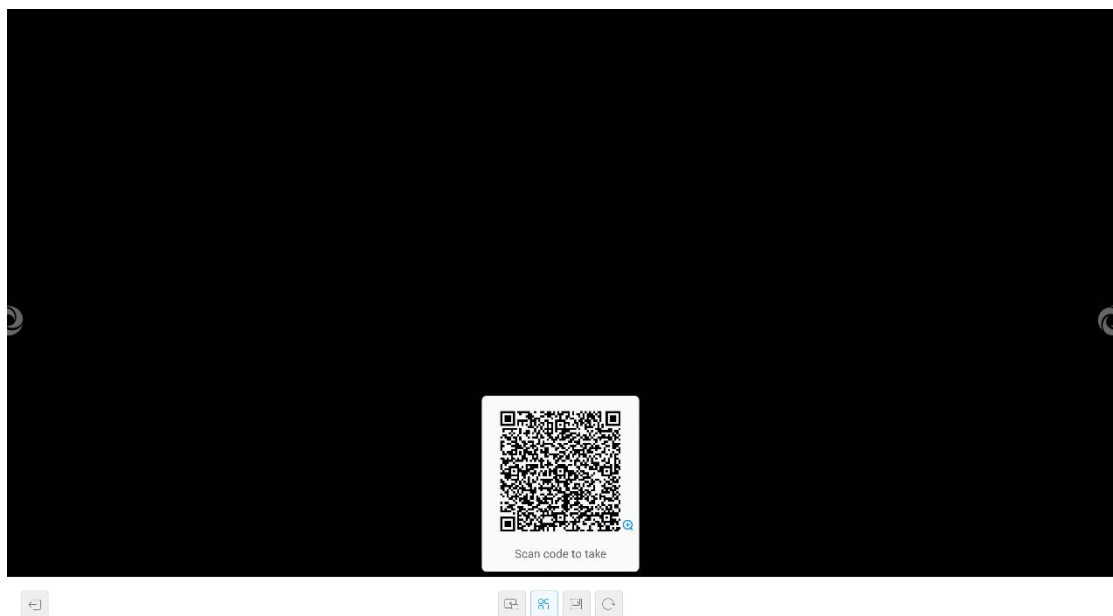
●Screenshot widget

1. Click the "Screenshot" icon in "More Tools" to open the screenshot widget.
2. You can freely adjust the screenshot area, or click the full-screen Screenshot button to capture the whole screen.
3. Click Import whiteboard to import the screenshot into whiteboard.
4. Click the "Save Local" button to save the screenshot to the local board.



●Camera gadget

1. Click the "Camera" icon in "More Tools" to open the camera tool.



●Touch lock widget

1. Click the "Touch lock" icon in "More Tools" to open the touch lock widget.

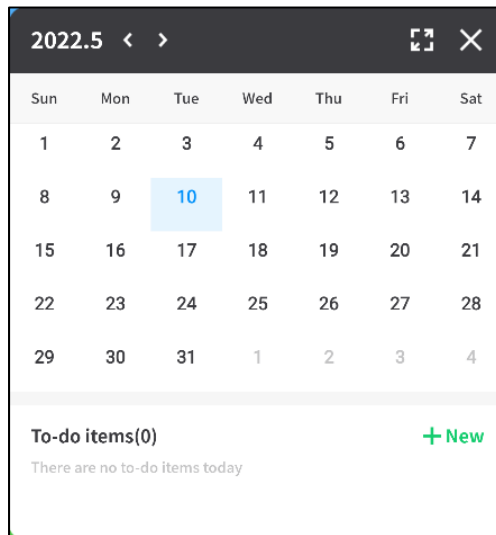


2. Click the touch lock to switch the touch disabled state, as shown below.

2. The calendar tool can be queried, with the function of adding items, help note.



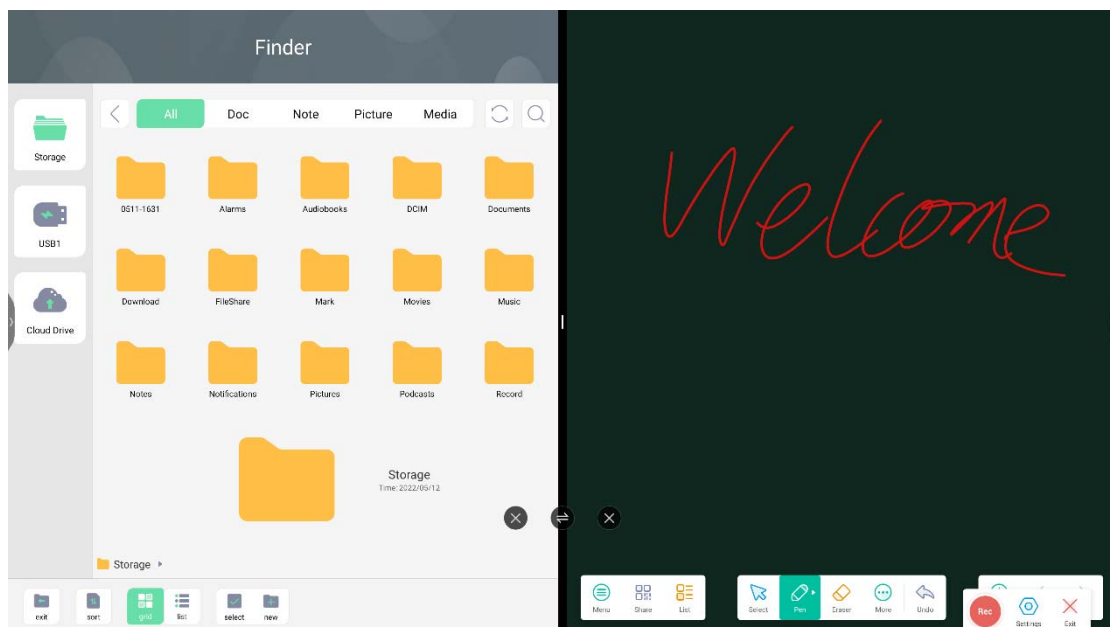
●Frozen screen small tool

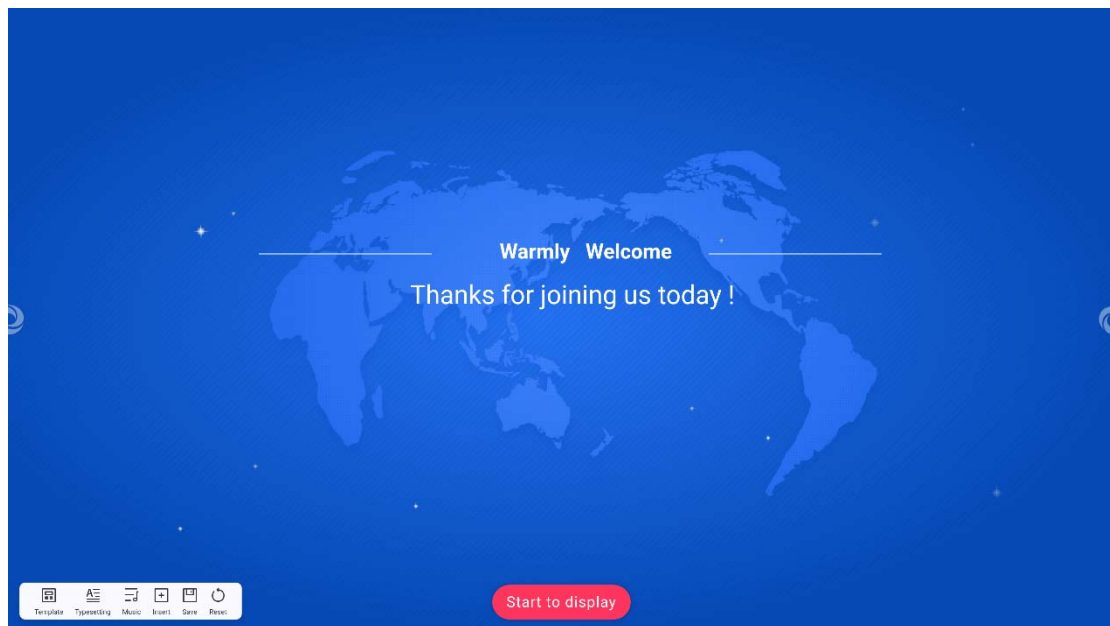
- What is a welcome speech?

Use welcome words to turn the big board into a welcome display screen.

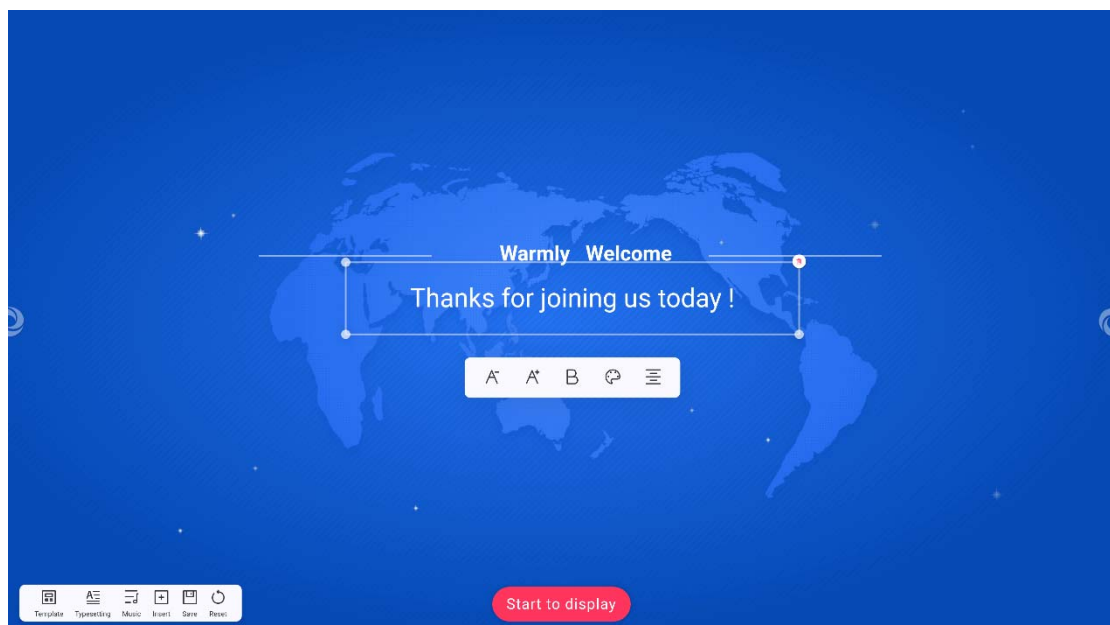
- How to use the welcome speech?

1. Home right swipe to enter "Welcome interface".
2. Interface introduction: The following figure shows the theme of the Web

welcome interface, including the following elements: background image, welcome text, start display, toolbar.



3. Edit display contents: Click the text on the main interface to appear the editing toolbar.



4. Click the "Zoom out" and "Zoom in" buttons to control the text size to zoom in and out.

5. Click THE B button to control the bold and cancel the bold.

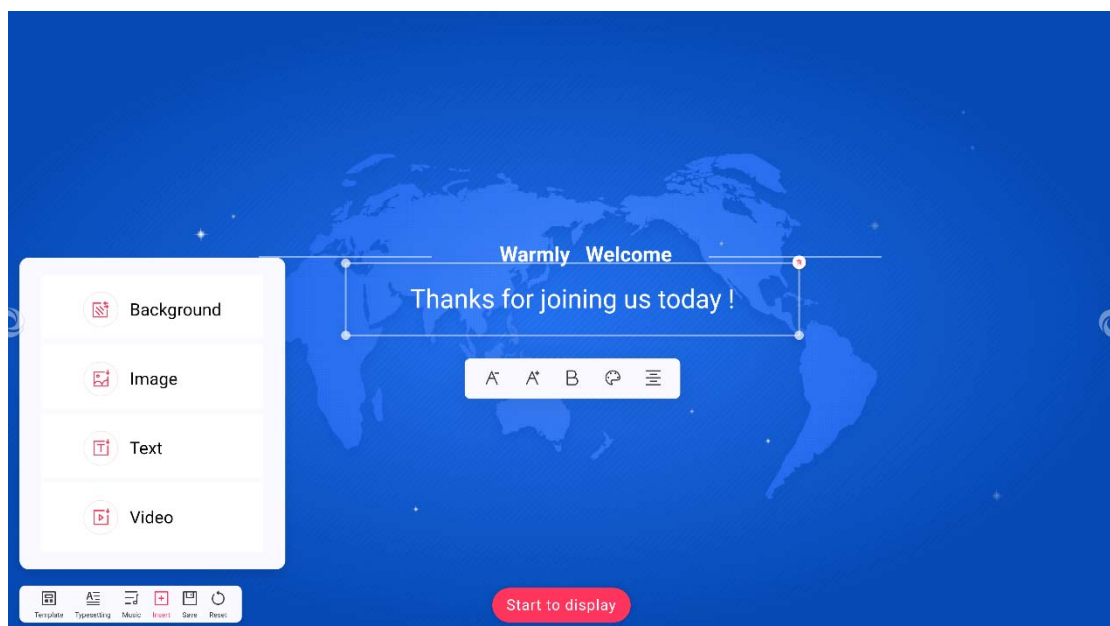
6. Click the color button to pop up the color selection box and select the text color.

7. Click the button on the right of the toolbar to switch between center, left and right.

(1) Hold down the dot of the text box and drag it to change the size of the text box.

(2) Click the delete button in the upper right corner of the text box to delete the text box.

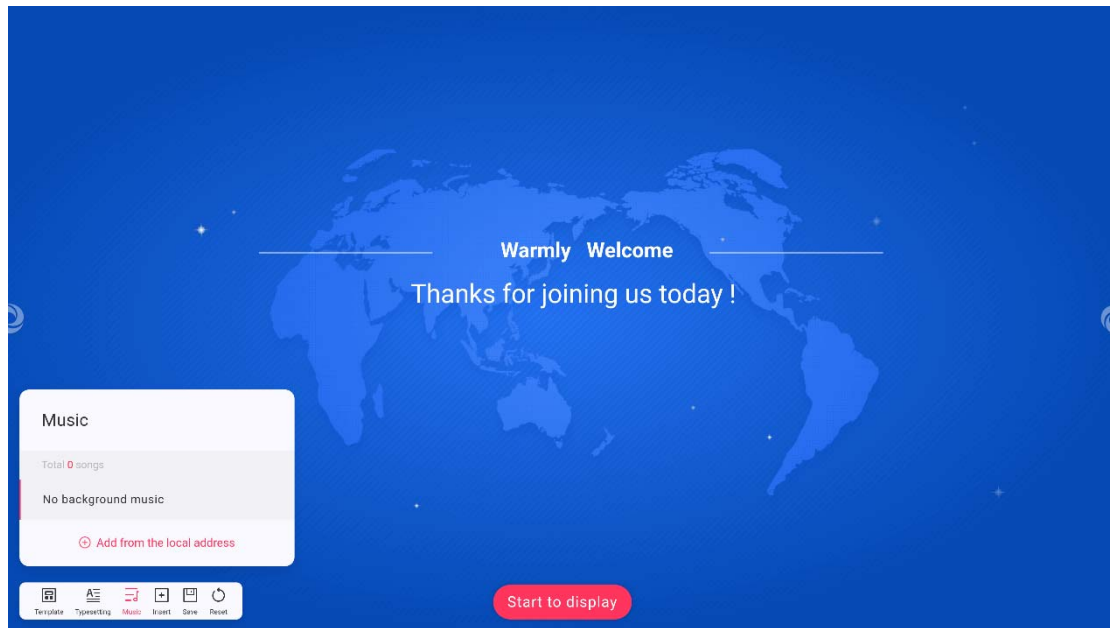
(3) Hold down any position of the text box, you can drag to move the text box position.



8. Click the Insert button to insert elements of the current welcome interface.

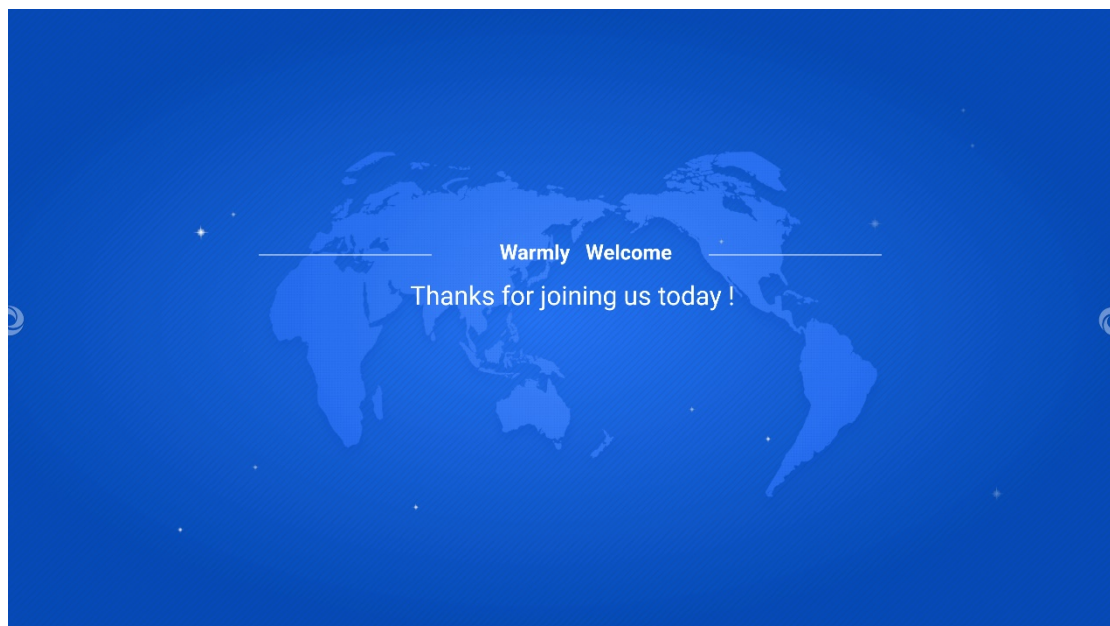
9. Click the Template button to select the alternative welcome interface template.

10. Click the music button to insert alternative or local audio files into the welcome interface.



11. Click the reset button to reset the welcome interface to its initial state.

12. Display effect: After modifying elements of the welcome interface, click the start display button of the main interface to enter the full-screen display state.

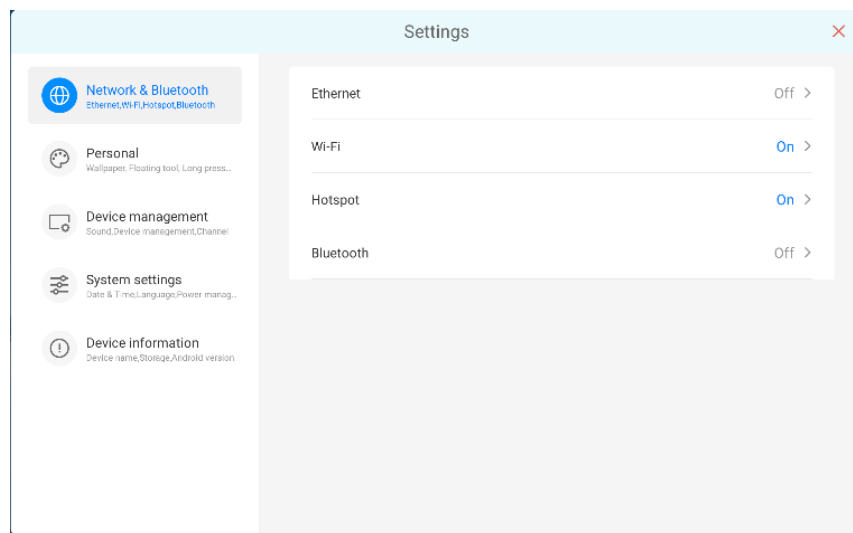


E. Setting

1. Click the button  in the sidebar to access more apps.

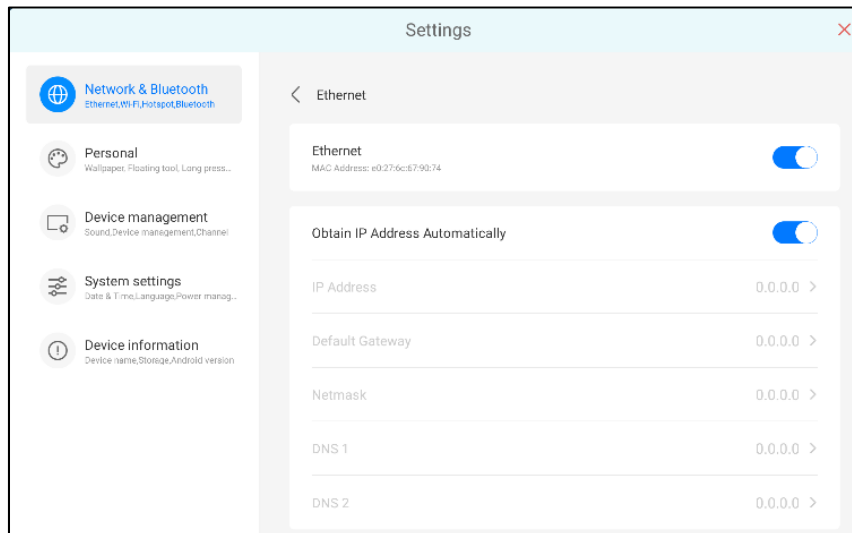


2. Click the button  to enter the Settings, including network and Bluetooth, personalized, device management, system Settings and device information five modules

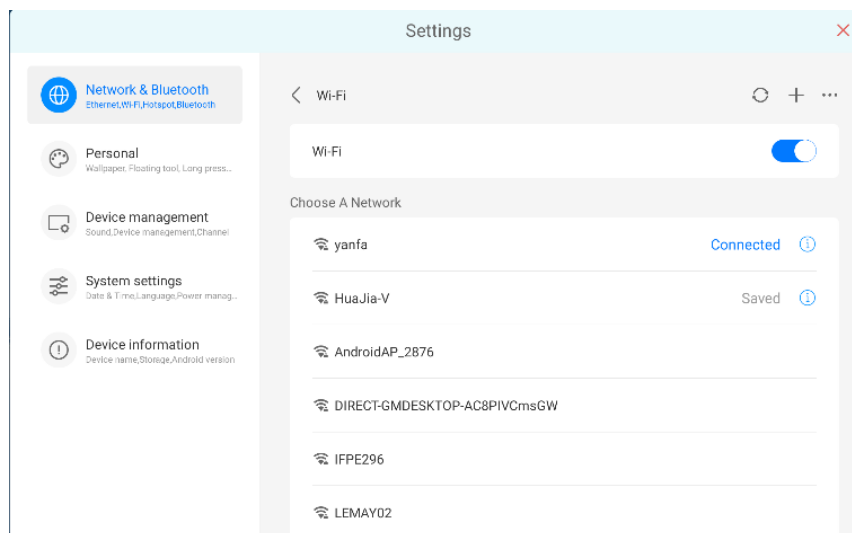


● Networking and Bluetooth

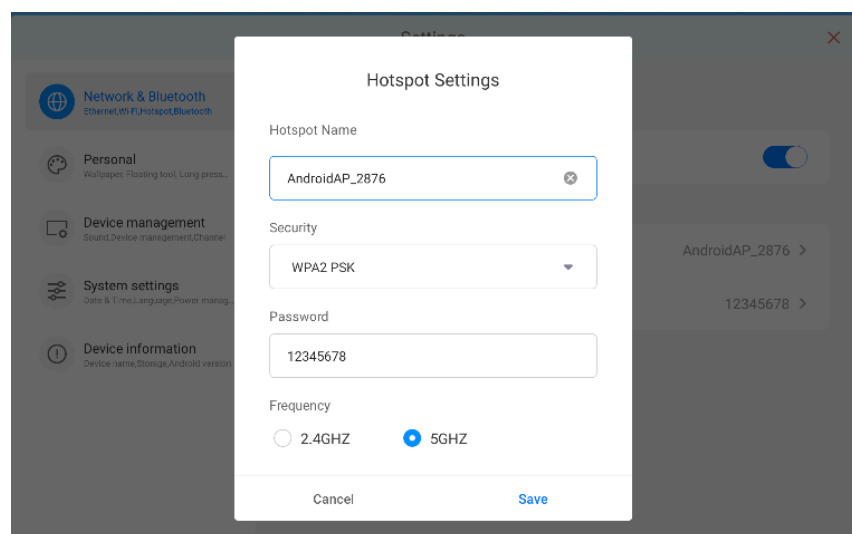
Wired network: support wireless network and wired network, but do not support simultaneous connection.



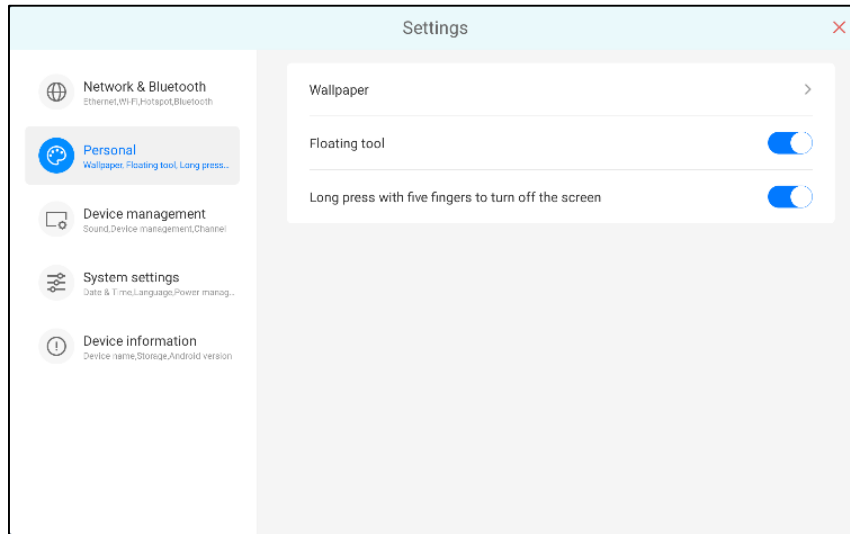
Wireless network: support wireless WIFI connection.



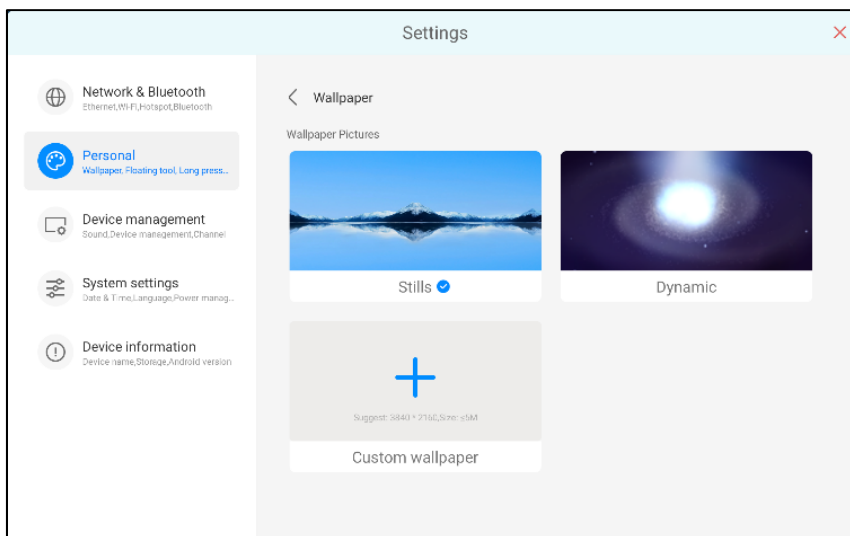
Hotspot: the hotspot supports two frequency bands: 2.4GHz and 5GHz.



●personalized

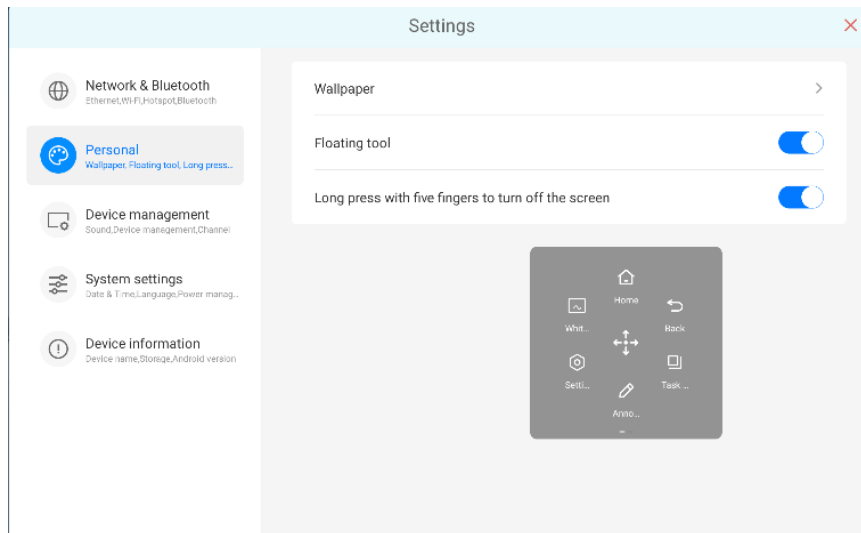


Wallpapers: There are static and dynamic wallpapers, and you can customize wallpapers.



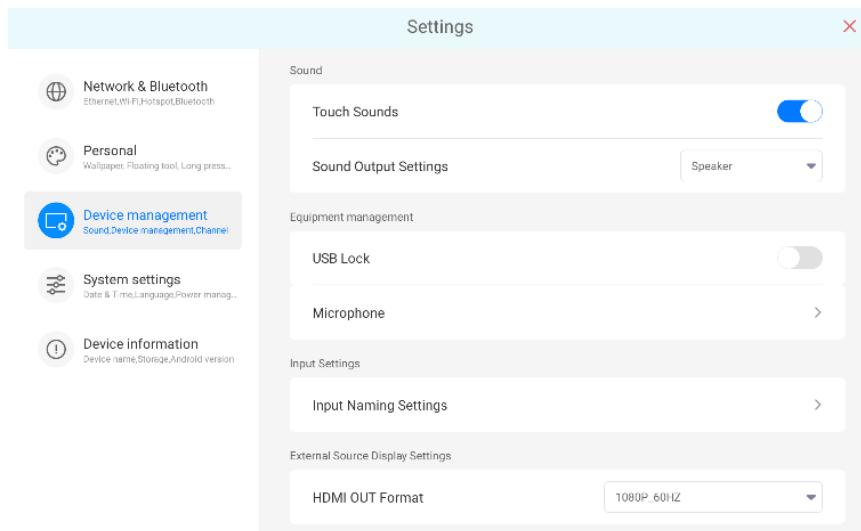
Suspension tool: Double click to call out the suspension tool, you can customize the shortcut.

Long press with five fingers to turn off the screen.

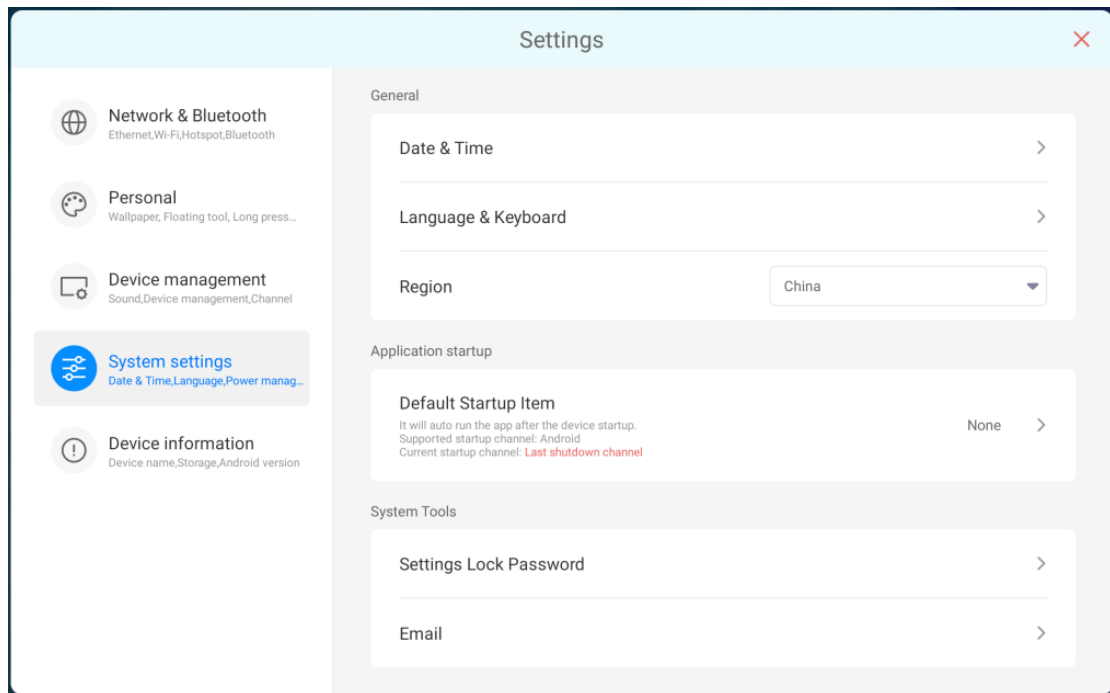


●Equipment management

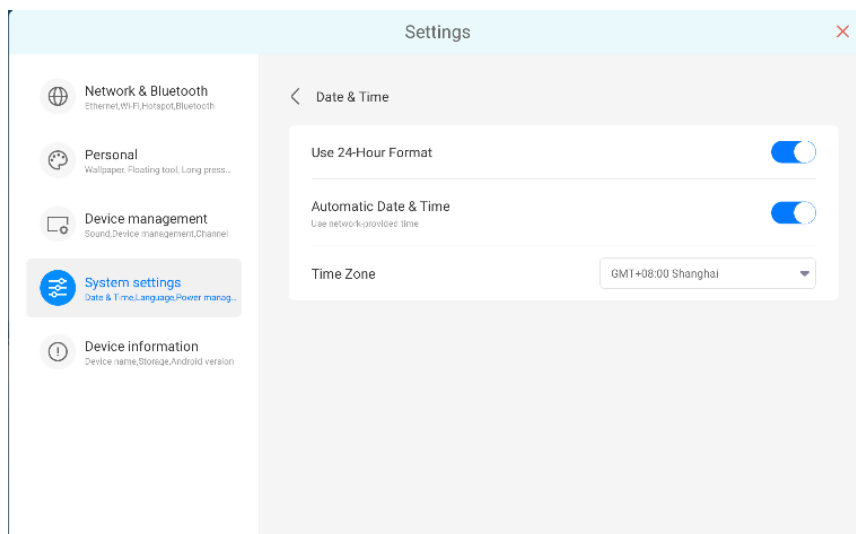
1. Touch Sound: Tap to turn on touch sound.

4. External signal source display Settings: 3840x2160_60HZ, 1080P_60HZ.



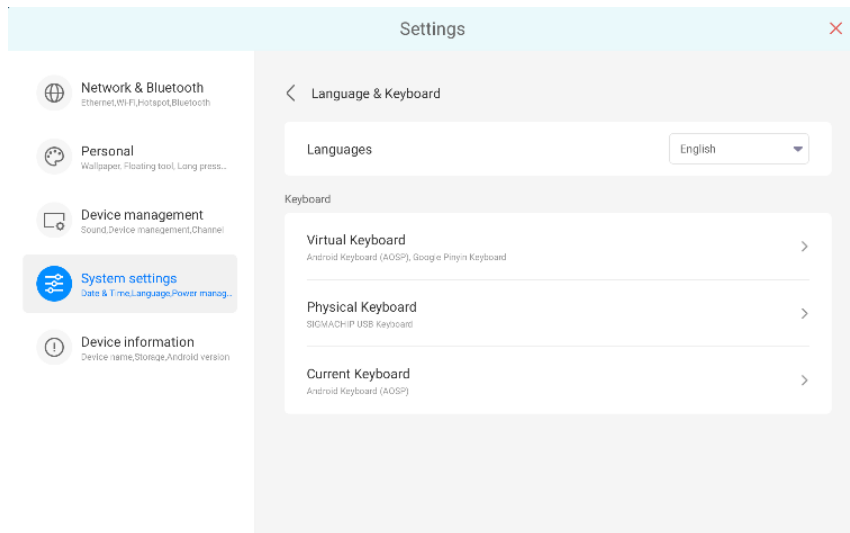
●System Settings



1. Date and time: supports the 24-hour system. Support setting different time zones, manual modification & automatic networking modification.

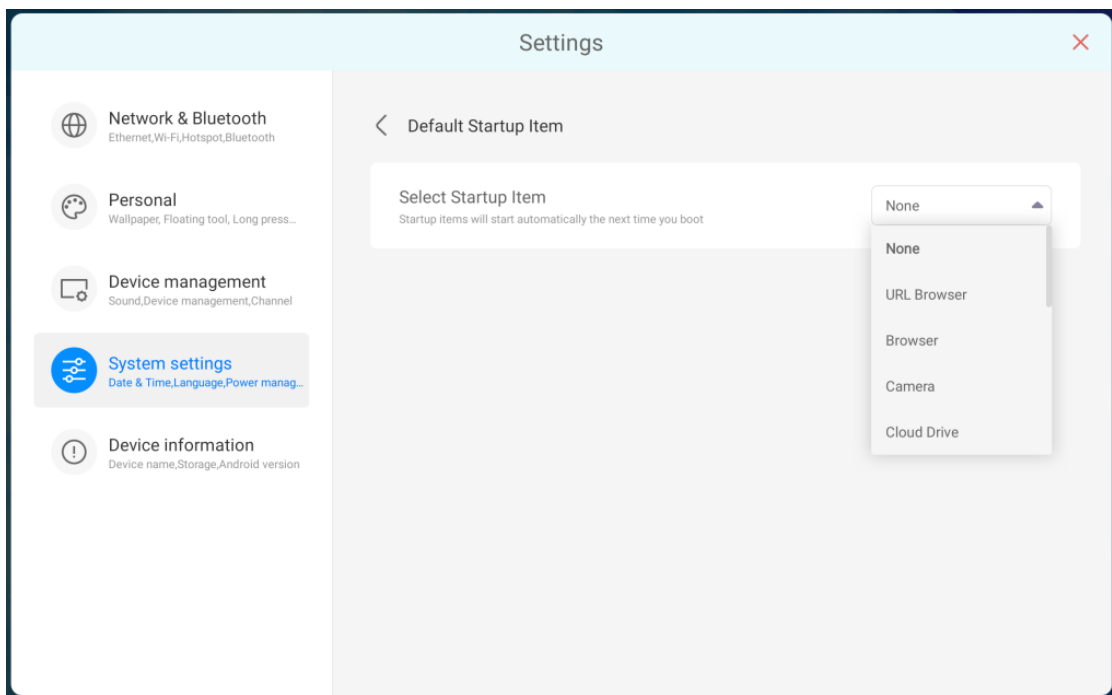


2. Language and keyboard: system language can be set; Switch keyboard Settings.



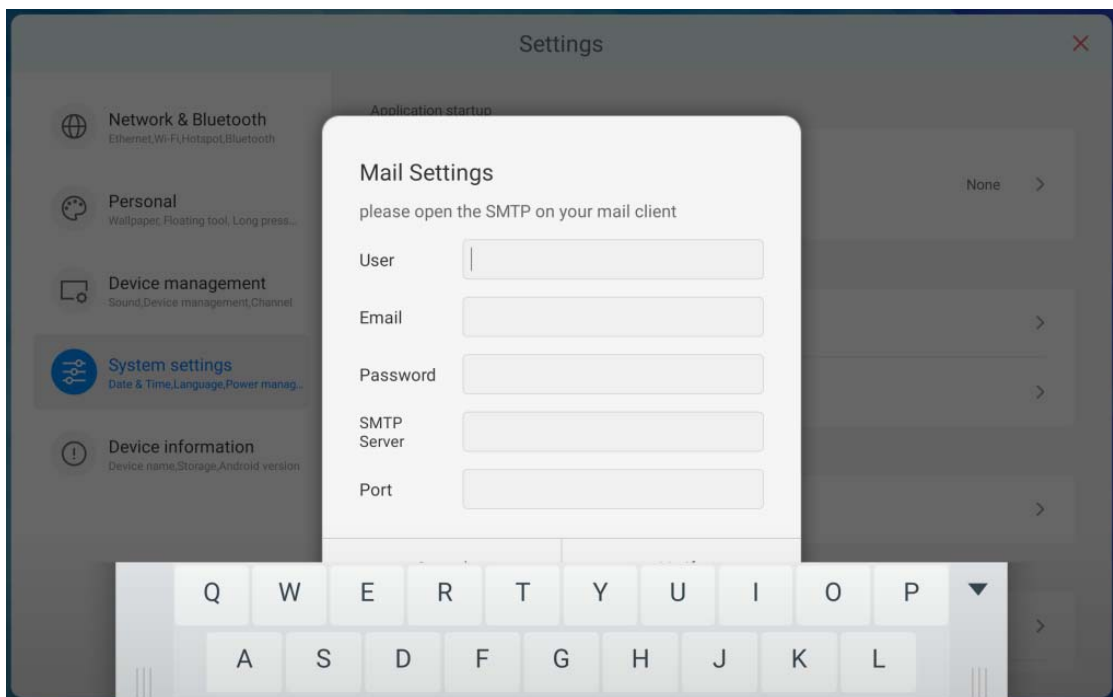
3. Region: The region can be changed.

4. Default Startup Item: It will auto run the app after the device startup.

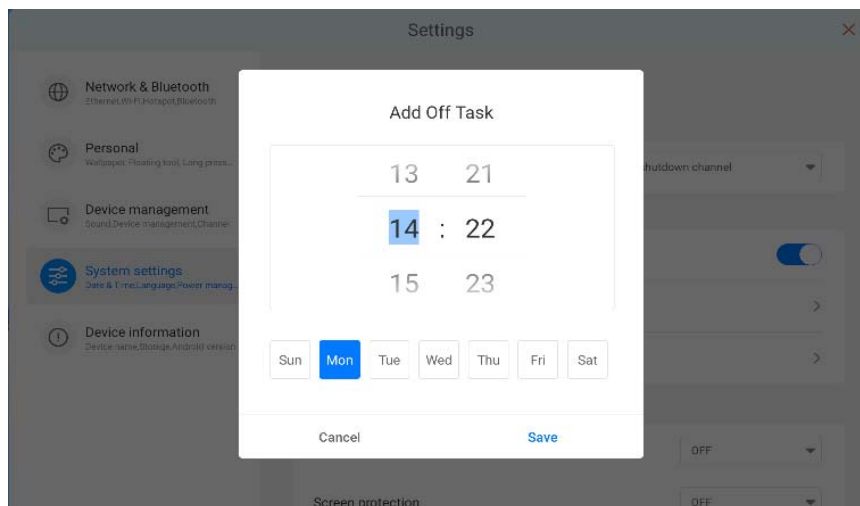
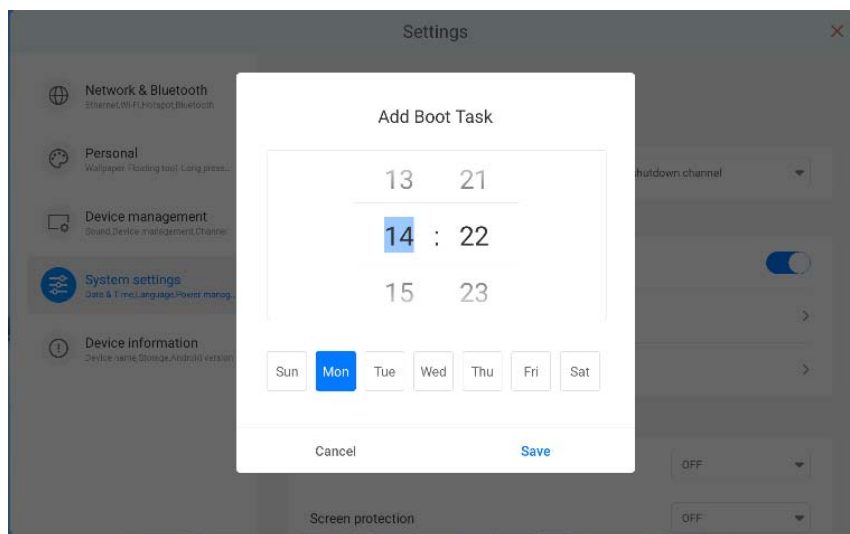


5. Settings Lock Password: Set the lock password and use it to unlock the screen that is locked.

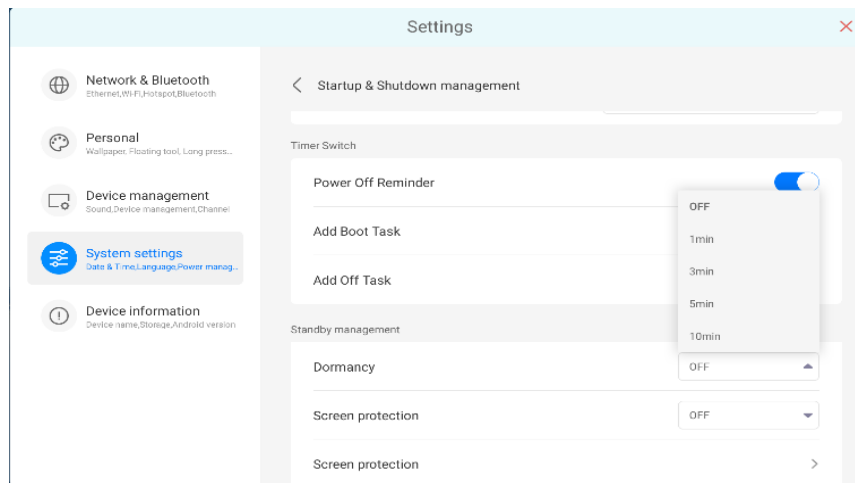
6. Mail Setting: Set the mail settings to transfer the files through emails.



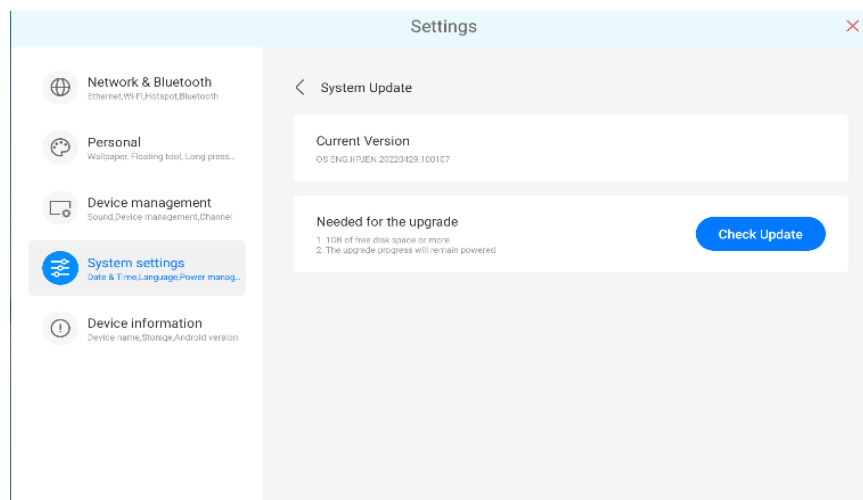
7. Switch on/off management: support automatic switch on/off.



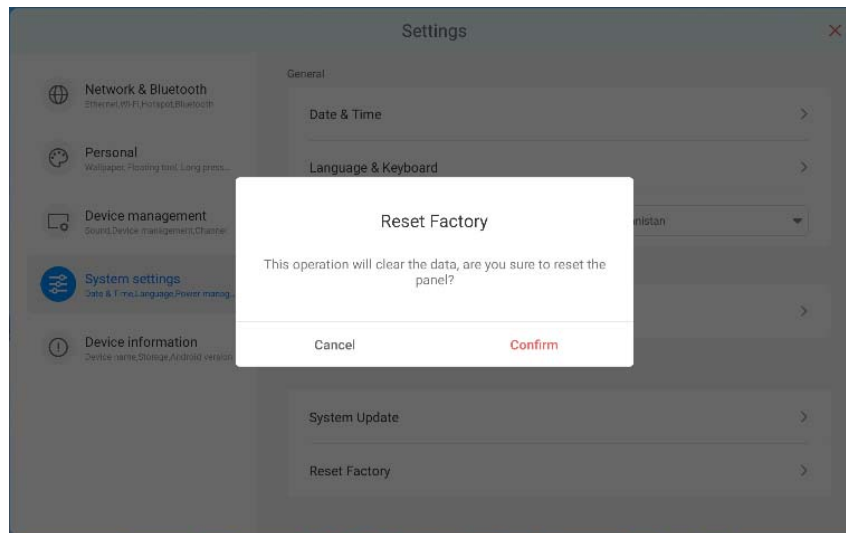
6. Hibernation: You can set the hibernation time when no operation is performed.



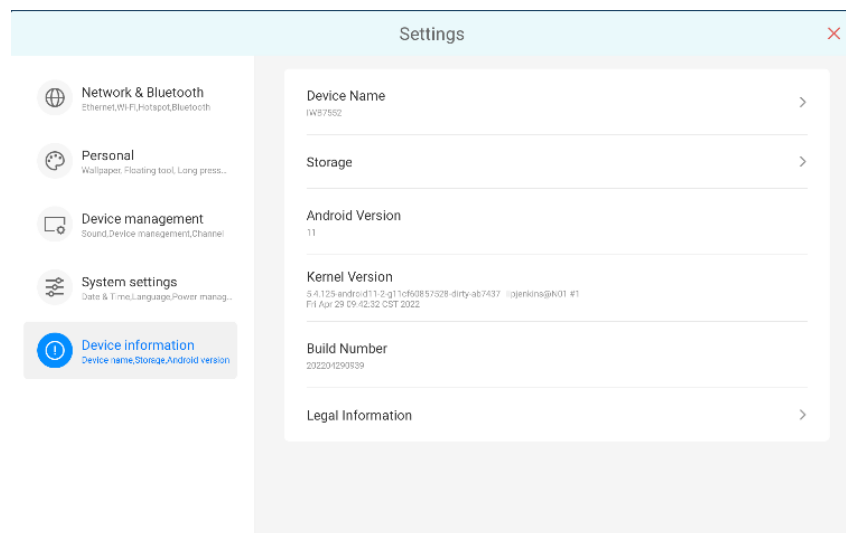
7. System upgrade: Check the current version of the system and upgrade the latest version.



8. Restore factory Settings: Deletes all data to restore factory Settings.

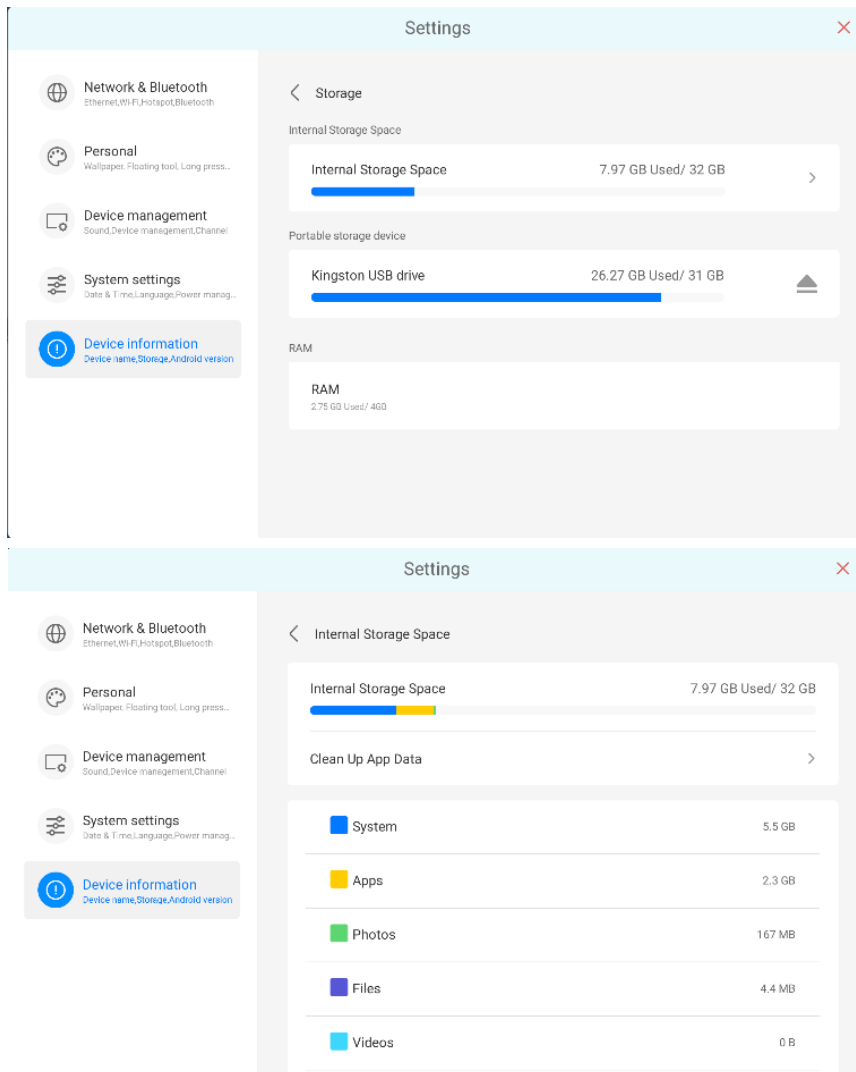


● Equipment information



Device name: Supports user-defined device names.
