## 3. Operation

3.1 Press and hold the ① On/Off button for 3 seconds to turn on the speaker. When it is turned on, you will hear a prompt sound “Power on”. At the same time, all 4 indicator lights ⑥⑦⑧⑨ will be on for 3 seconds, and then the ⑥ light will remain on. ⑦⑧⑨ indicator lights will flash in sequence to enter the BT pairing mode; Open the BT interface of the mobile phone, search and find the L9 device to click, they will auto connect; After successful connection, the indicator lights ⑥⑦⑧⑨ will automatically turn off.

3.1.1 If the pairing failed or disconnected for more than 3 seconds, the speaker will automatically shut down!

3.1.2 At “standby” status, press and hold this button for 3 seconds to turn off the device.

3.1.3 When playing music, short press the ① button once to pause or replay music;

3.2 When playing music, short press ② to play the next song; Long press ② to increase the volume

3.3 When playing music, short press ③ to play the long song; Long press ③ to decrease the volume

3.4 Short press ④ timer key once to enter the 30-minute timer, press once again to enter the 1 hour timer, press the timer key for the third time to cancel the timing setting, and cycle in sequence. At the end of the timer, the speaker will automatically shut down.

3.5 ⑤ TYPE-C charging port, supporting power supply with output below 5V2A to charge the speaker. For example, you can use the power adaptor or power bank with output below 5V2A to charge the device.

### 3.6 ⑥ ⑦ ⑧ ⑨ indicator lights:

- 1) Indicate the pairing status: ⑥ light remain on, ⑦ ⑧ ⑨ is flashing in sequence, when pairing finished, all 4 lights turn off.
- 2) Indicate the battery volume: at standby status, short press the ① power button to activate the indicator lights. Each light represents 25% of the power volume.

#### Remark:

The "short press" means to shortly press the key once and then release the key;

The "long press" means to press and hold the key for 3 seconds and then release the key.
