


Turn on the antenna for optimal reception



Turn on/off system power: Press the Power button on the radio

After pressing Power for the first time, it will automatically enter the FM radio search state.

Press the Power button on the radio to enter standby mode. Press again to enter the previous open Mode mode: Press the MODE button on the radio. Available modes: FM/Bluetooth/USB/AUX will be displayed on

the screen Press will like to select and confirm with the key volume/Tune/Select.

Adjusting the volume

Rotate the volume/Tune/Select knob on the radio or press VOL+or VOL - . The volume range is: 0 (minimum) -20 (maximum).

FM mode (30 preset stations)

Note: When starting the radio in FM mode for the first time, it will automatically search for FM stations

On the radio, press MODE and the display screen will display "FM". Press the volume/Tune/Select button to confirm, and the FM mode selection is successful.

Adjust the antenna on the back of the product to receive the best signal.

1. Conduct a radio search on the product, scanning stations displayed on the screen indicates automatic searching.

C. Short press with for manually selection

- A. Long press scan or volume/Tune/Select to achieve automatic scanning stations

Store your favorite radio stations

After successfully searching for a radio station in FM mode

1. Long press and hold the Preset button on the radio to access the Preset store list. Rotate volume/Tune/Select to select the numerical position of the preset list you want. Confirm storage by pressing volume/Tune/Select. The screen displays Favourite station set, indicating that the preset was successful.

1. On the radio, short press Preset to enter the Preset recall list, rotate volume/Tune/Select to select a radio station, and press volume/Tune/Select to confirm playback

Quickly store your favorite radio stations

There are 1-5 buttons below the display screen for storing your favorite radio stations.

In FM mode, after searching for a radio station, simply press and hold one of the buttons in 1-5 to quickly store the radio station. After successful storage, the Favorite Station Set will be displayed.

Quickly play your favorite radio stations

Press one of the buttons 1-5 on the radio to play your favorite radio station

Press Info in different modes to display different information on the display screen

The displayed information includes the following

- 1. Platform information
- 2. Signal strength/signal error 3. Program Type


