

1. Install App

Install "MUBY" App from App store (IOS) or Google Play Store (Android).

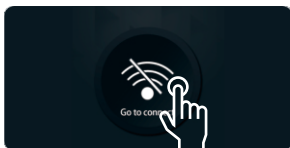

2. Connect To Phone

- 1 Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds, and the device will power on after hearing two beeps.
- 2 Open "MUBY" App and click "Go to Connect" icon.



- Find “Muby-XXXX” (X represents any digit or letter.) in WiFi list and connect.



- ! Tap “CONNECT “ if there is warning message “**This WLAN network has no internet access. Connect anyway?**” from phone.

- Go back to App interface and click home icon to enter live image.



- ! If there is still no image at this time, please uninstall and reinstall the App.

3. How To Use

- Adjust the camera tube so that the tweezers are positioned properly in the image, typically in the center of the frame.
