


**OVERVIEW****FUNCTIONS****Power On:** Press and hold the MFB (Multifunction Button) for 4 seconds to switch the headphone on**Power Off:** Press and hold the MFB (Multifunction Button) for 4 seconds to power off the headphone**BLUETOOTH PAIRING**

Step 1: Press and hold the MFB for 4 seconds to turn on the headphone and put them into pairing mode, indicated by blue and red LED flashes

Step 2: Open your device's Bluetooth menu and search for 'Rockerz 551ANC' to pair
