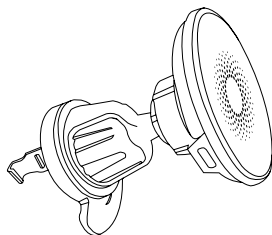

Installation

1. Clip the tail clamp onto the most suitable spot of the air vent.
2. Connect wireless charging to the car charging or USB port.
- 3.Place the phone with magnet plate into the mount,or stick a iron sheet on the back of Android phones.
