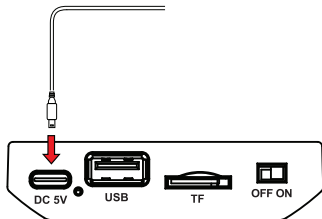

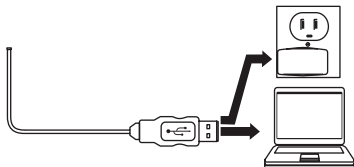

CHARGING

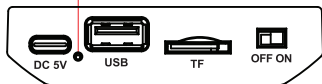
Insert one end of the included Type-C charging cable (included) into the DC 5V charging port on your speaker.



Insert the other end of the USB cable into the USB port of a computer or suitable USB charging adapter.

-  Charging Complete (Indicator is OFF)

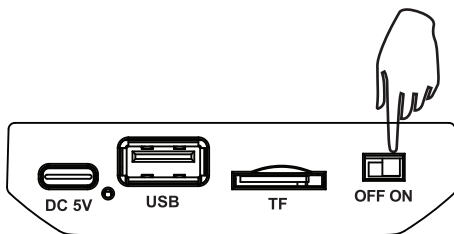

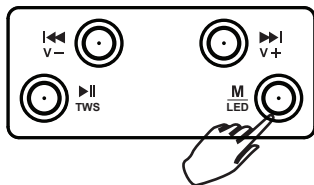
POWERING ON/OFF



Slide the power switch to the ON position to power ON the speaker. After powering ON, the speaker will automatically go into Bluetooth pairing mode.

Slide the power switch to the OFF position to power OFF.

BLUETOOTH PAIRING

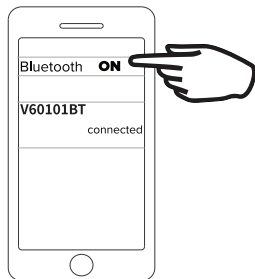


Power on your speaker. Then press the mode button repeatedly to toggle through your speaker's various modes. Make sure BT (Bluetooth) mode is selected.

NOTE: Your speaker has three modes:

- Select BT mode to pair your speaker to a Bluetooth-enabled device.
- Select FM mode to listen to FM radio channels.
- Select USB/TF mode to listen to music from a connected USB drive or an inserted memory card.

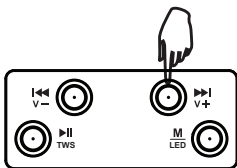
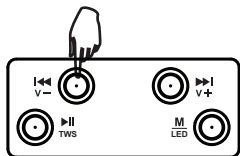
ADDITIONAL NOTE: Press and hold the Mode button to turn on/off the speaker's light.



Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone. Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on. Connect to the device listed as "V60101BT"

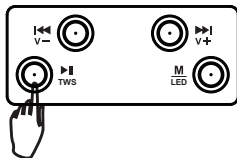
LISTENING TO MUSIC

Press the **⏮** button to go back to the last track in a playlist. Press and hold to decrease the volume.

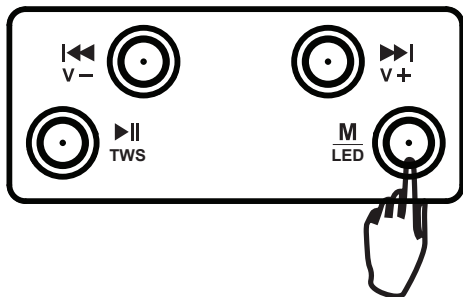


Press the **⏭** button to go forward to the next track in a playlist. Press and hold to increase the volume.

Press the **⏸** button to play or pause a track.



LIGHT CONTROL

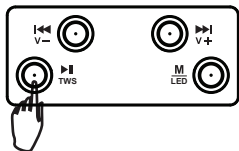


Press and hold the LED button to turn on/off the speaker's light.

ADDITIONAL FEATURES

TWS Function

If you have two V60101BT speakers, enjoy high-quality sound by using the TWS pairing function.



Power ON both speakers then quick press the TWS button 2 times on either one of the speakers.

The two speakers will pair together.

You can then go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone. Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on. Connect to the device listed as "V60101BT".

USB Port

Insert a USB drive into the USB port on your speaker. On USB mode, the speaker will play any .MP3 files found on the USB drive. The USB port is NOT for charging other devices and can only be used to access files.

TF Card Port

Insert a TF or Micro SD type card into the TF card port on your speaker. On TF mode, the speaker will play any MP3 files found on the memory card.

FM Mode

When the speaker is in FM mode, quick press the Play/Pause button to search through FM channels.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

When using your wireless speaker, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

1. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING YOUR WIRELESS SPEAKER.
2. Never expose your wireless speaker to high temperatures, extreme cold, high humidity or any moisture or water.
3. In order to avoid the risk of electric shock, never attempt to open your wireless speaker or repair it without the assistance of certified professionals.
4. Your wireless speaker is not to be used by children or the infirm without suitable adult supervision.
5. Always press all buttons carefully. Do not manhandle your wireless speaker.
6. Do not use your wireless speaker at temperatures under 32°F (0°C) or over 104°F (40°C).
7. Do not drop your wireless speaker, throw it, or subject it to strong impacts or physical trauma.
8. If you detect any abnormalities when using your wireless speaker, contact the manufacturer for support. In addition, do not continue to use your wireless speaker if you detect any smoke or fire.
9. Unplug your wireless speaker when not in use for extended periods of time.
10. When plugged in, do not place your wireless speaker on flammable materials such as rugs, carpets, or bedding.
11. Please recycle or dispose of your wireless speaker properly based on the laws and rules of your municipality. Contact local recycling facilities and/or the manufacturer of for further information.
12. Clean your wireless speaker using a soft cloth or paper towel. Do not use harsh chemicals when cleaning your wireless speaker, and never submerge your wireless speaker in water.

Maintenance and Care

- Use a soft cloth or paper towel to clean your speaker. Never use any harsh chemicals or detergents for cleaning. Make sure your speaker is dry before charging.
- When your speaker is not in use, it should be stored in a cool, dry place.
- Never tug or yank on a cable while it is connected to your speaker. Connect and disconnect cables as carefully as possible.
- Never expose your speaker to high temperatures or extreme cold.
