## Important safety precautions

Please read this instruction manual if you need to know something or have any problems.

### NOTICE

To prevent electric shock, do not open the chassis. There are no parts in the machine that the customer can repair. Please entrust qualified professional maintenance personnel to carry out maintenance.



This sign reminds the user that great care must be taken in operation and repair, therefore, it must be read carefully to prevent any failures.



This sign warns the user that uninsulated voltages in the unit may cause electric shock from the surface magnetic field, and therefore it is dangerous to contact any part of the unit.

### WARNING

To prevent fire or electric shock, do not expose the unit to rain or moisture. Do not open the case.



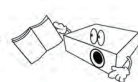
Warning: Do not look directly at or stare at the light beam from the lens. Strong light may cause eye discomfort or damage. Parents should supervise and educate children to use it properly.



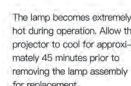
Suitable for altitude less than 2000 m and non-hot climate

## Important safety instructions

Please read this manual before you operate your projector, save it for future reference.



Do not look straight at the projector lens during operation. The intense light beam may damage your eyes.

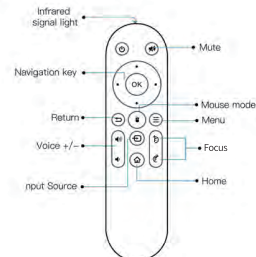


The lamp becomes extremely hot during operation. Allow the projector to cool for approximately 45 minutes prior to removing the lamp assembly for replacement.



Do not block the projection lens with any objects when the projector is under operation as this could cause the objects to become heated and deformed or even cause a fire. To temporarily turn off the lamp, use the blank function.

## Check before use Bluetooth remote control

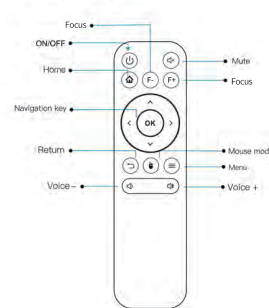


Remote control shall be working within 5m distance from projector.

Pairing method (Bluetooth connection)

- Press and hold the left & right direction buttons at the same time for 3-5 seconds until the red light flashes.
- Open "Settings"-"Bluetooth & Remotes", click the name of the remote to connect.

### FCC Statement

## How to install and debug projector quickly Installation and commissioning

### Image focal length adjustment

According to the fuzziness of the projection picture, Press the focus button on the remote control Until the picture is in perfect sharpness



Distorted picture diagram



Clear picture

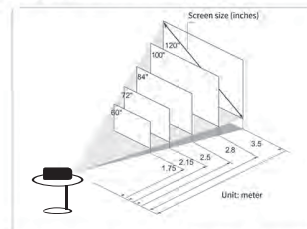


Trapezoidal correction: When the projector is side projection, it can be adjusted through the remote control to achieve a square image  
Global zoom: Press the "left and right" buttons on the remote control to zoom the screen, supporting 30% -100% screen adjustment

### common problem

- The screen is blurry  
Please maintain a distance of at least 1.0 meters for focusing until the image is clear
- How to adjust the size of the screen  
Find "Settings" in the upper left corner of the main interface and open it. Find "Projection" and "Global Zoom". Press the "Left and Right" keys on the remote control to zoom the screen, supporting 30% -100% screen adjustment
- Unable to connect to the internet  
1. Please check the router settings connected and ensure that the projector device's WiFi is turned on. Enter the correct password and connect to the network.  
2. Open the mobile hotspot test. If the mobile hotspot can be connected to the internet, it is a problem with the router's settings. Please contact the router manufacturer for debugging

Design tolerance error  $\pm 8\%$ .  
This chart is measured at the front and center of the lens and assumes that the projector is placed horizontally (the front and rear adjuster are fully drawn out).

## How to install and debug projector quickly Set projection screen trapezoidal scale and projection mode

- Select "Trapezoidal Correction" on the home page.
- Select function keys based on the projection scenario.



## How to install and debug projector quickly Setting up wifi Connection

- Open the Settings menu on the remote control or the Settings on the home page.
- On the WLAN network connection page, enable Wireless and Network as shown in the figure.
- Select the home wifi signal network, enter the wifi password, and connect.



By pressing the home menu, you can now go online and enjoy your home theater.
