

Precautions for using speaker

Switch on / off-

When the machine is turned off, the product starts automatically with the Charge An On / Off key. When the TF is not inserted when the card is used, it will enter the 'Bluetooth mode', and when the card is inserted, it will enter 'Bluetooth mode'. Long press the ON / OFF key turn off the machine.

Bluetooth connectivity-

Open your phone's Bluetooth settings, search for the device name, and then select a pair. After the connection is successful, there will be a pair tone and the blue light will always be on.

Mobile Playback

After the Bluetooth connection is successful, open the mobile music player and download your favorite songs or the accompaniment can be played, and the volume can also be adjusted to the appropriate level on the mobile phone.

TF card play-

Insert the TF card into the device, and the device will automatically play the music in the TF card.

Charge-

Connect the standard charging line to the charger for charging. The red light is always on when charging, and it is full off.

Attention

1. Please disconnect the charger and turn it off before cleaning the machine. 2. Please do not use the machine in a high-temperature environment. The machine tends to self-ignite and cause failure and loss of warranty rights. 3. Please do not use the machine in a high-humidity environment to avoid short-circuiting of electrical parts.

4. Please do not use the machine in an excessively cold or overheated environment, which may cause the equipment to fail to operate normally. 5. Please do not use the machine in a high-vibration environment. The equipment should not exceed 30°C-40°C, which is relatively moderate (20%-30% humidity). Please do not use the machine in a high-vibration environment to avoid circuit damage. Please do not spill any liquid on the product.

6. Please do not use the machine in a high-pressure environment. Please do not scratch, fall off or other hardware damage.

7. Please do not use the machine in a high-temperature environment. Please do not touch the device to disassemble, impact, squeeze or put the product into fire if the battery has serious failure. Do not continue to use.

8. The manual contains important information, please reserve it.

Bluetooth

1. Press and hold the speaker power on key to turn on the machine, and the blue prompt "Bluetooth mode" will flash at the same time. Connecting success blue light is always on.

2. Turn on the mobile phone's Bluetooth and scan, search for the device, and then pair and connect, and you can hear it after connecting. The device sends a connection request to the mobile phone.
