Install Your Dash Cam

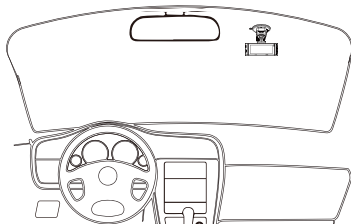
We will guide you through the installation process step by step to ensure your dash cam is installed properly. Whether you are a first-time user or an experienced one, this video will provide helpful tips to make the process easy.



How to install the main body

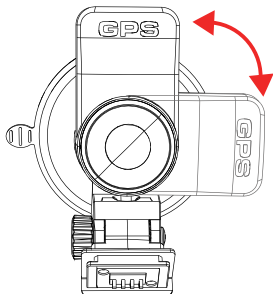
> Start the vehicle generator, and do a bench test before officially installing the dash cam: connect the car charger to the cigarette lighter port and the dash cam, connect the rear camera and the GPS bracket, and insert the MicroSD card to ensure that the dash cam can work normally.

> Find the right spot on the front windshield. Wipe the pre-installed location with a clean cloth.

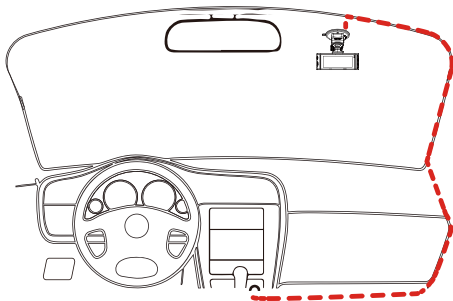


Install Your Dash Cam

> Use the suction cup to fix the F7NP dash cam on the windshield, adjust its angle to record clearer video. Then turn off the vehicle to pay attention to safety.



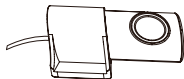
> Use the crowbar to run the power cable along the front windshield and the roof, and hide the cable on the A-pillar, so as not to block the driver's sight and cause danger.



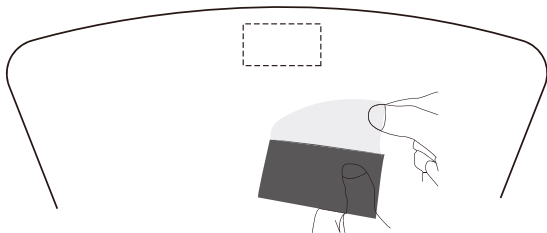
Install Your Dash Cam

How to install the in-car rear cam

NOTE: This rear camera is a special rear camera in the car, the effect is better if it is installed in the car and it is not waterproof. We recommend that you install it on the rear windshield of your car.

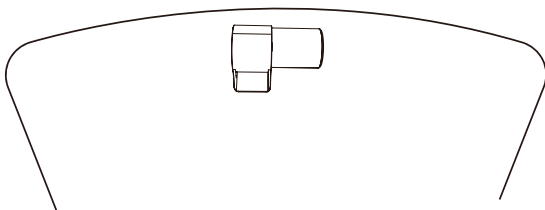


- > Use a clean cloth to wipe the rear windshield where the rear camera needs to be installed.
- > Then peel off the electrostatic sticker from the cellophane, transfer it to the place you want to stick it.

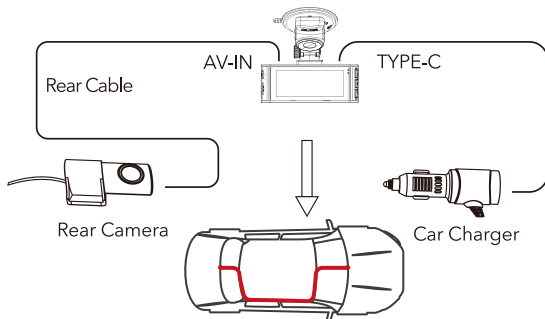


Install Your Dash Cam

> Eliminate the air bubbles on the static stickers. It is recommended to install the back camera after standing still for half an hour to make the static stickers stronger



> Insert the power cord along the gaps between the front windshield and the ceiling, between the car body and the ceiling on the side of the passenger seat, and between the rear seats and the ceiling.



Setting Up Your Camera



MicroSD (TF) card

With your camera off, insert the card into the card slot with the label facing the back of your camera.

You can eject the card by pressing it into the slot with your fingernail.

You'll need a MicroSD card (sold separately) to save your videos and photos. Use a U3 Class 10 SD™ Card dedicated or your camera may malfunction.

MicroSD cards can degrade over time and affect your camera's ability to save your media. Try swapping out an older card for a new one if you're having any problems.

WIRING SET UP


Connect your camera to a **Cig** charger using the included cig charge cable.

POP-UP: Want to know what software version you're using? Here's where you can find out.

1. Press M button and enter Settings
2. Press UP button > Version

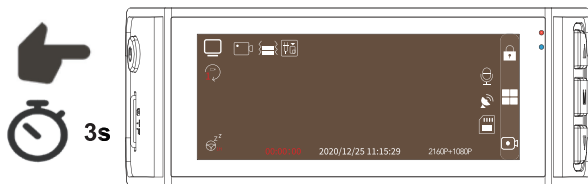
POWERING ON

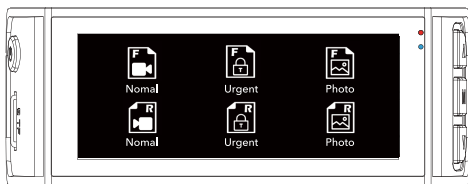
