Operation

2. Do not use the headset when driving.

3. Please charge the headset every month if you don't use it long time.

4. Go to mobile phone setting, search new BT device and select Tayogo S2. If pairing code needed, enter "0000".

5. LED flashes red and blue pairing.

6. Blue flashes slowly: Connected

7. Full red: Charging

8. Blue flashes fast: Connecting

9. Full blue: Charging finished

10. Red LED blinks: Low power

11. LED flashes blue slowly after pairing finished.

Maintenance

1. Please store the B3 headphones in a cool dry place. The working temperature is 10-45°C (41-113°F). Cold, hot or humid environment will damage the battery.

2. The headphone will connect to the previous mobile phone after power on.

3. If you want to connect the new mobile phone, press the MFB button 5 seconds to the paring mode.

4. Headphone will be powered off if no mobile connected.

Charging

Plug the included Micro-USB cable to the USB Port or Adapter(5V/1A) to charge. Charging time is around 1.5 hours. LED is fully red when charging and fully blue after charging finish.

Note: Please charge the headset fully before your first usage.
