To Whom it may concern,

Textron Specialized Vehicles TRUPIN device operating under FCC ID: 2BBDD-TRUPIN encompasses two prior registered modules from Telit and Espressif. After these devices go to market in their base level there will be no further integration of the full unit into any other product. Because of this, we kindly ask for an exemption to providing the Integration Module as specified in KDB Publication 69 D03, paragraph two:

"If the modular transmitter is only approved for use by the grantee in its own products and not intended for sale to third parties, the integration instructions may not be detailed but this must be declared in the filing. In that case, it is permitted to place the instructions in the theory-of-operation exhibit folder using long term confidentiality. The applicant must include a statement in the filing that the module is not for sale and the user manual integration instructions are internal confidential manufacturing documents. The grant of certification for such a modular transmitter must be limited."

There will be no third party involved which gives us the right to file this statement that the module is not for sale to said third party. Without that sale we can confidently say this module will not be offered for further integration into other products only to our own.

Please accept this letter to validate this and exclude this submission from needing an integration guide.
