Please read this manual carefully before using this product

This product has laser pen (less than 0.4mw), PPT page turning, sound adjustment, print screen and other functions, Bluetooth connection, Black shell, the power supply is 2 No. 7 dry batteries. It can be used for meetings, teaching, home and other scenarios.

If used it with a shared writing board, it has the functions of writing content storage, clearance, interface switching, and other functions.

This product can be connected to computers, mobile phones, readers and other Bluetooth devices.

How to connect Bluetooth: long press the "Bluetooth" button for 2 seconds. looks for "Clint_RCU", after the connection is successful, it can be used normally.

If the Bluetooth is connected and the remoter is not working for 30 minutes, it will turn to sleep mode to save power consumption, and press the "power" button to wake up before working normally.
