5.3 Bluetooth+BR+EDR

## Parameter configuration

The mobile Bluetooth headset adopts the duplex advanced asynchronous serial port of DMA; Wireless connection (TWS) realizes wireless stereo, HIFI sound effect, and the left and right sides have complete Bluetooth function, which can be used alone or in pairs.

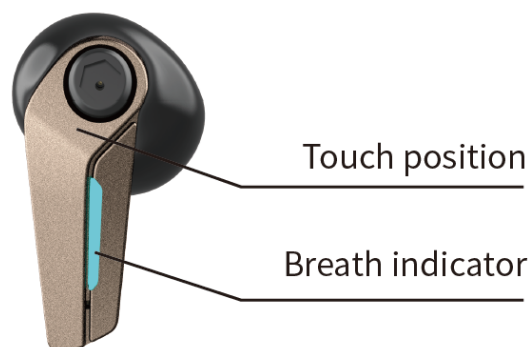
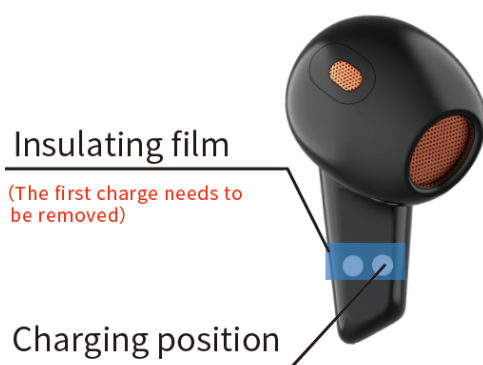

## Headphone use steps

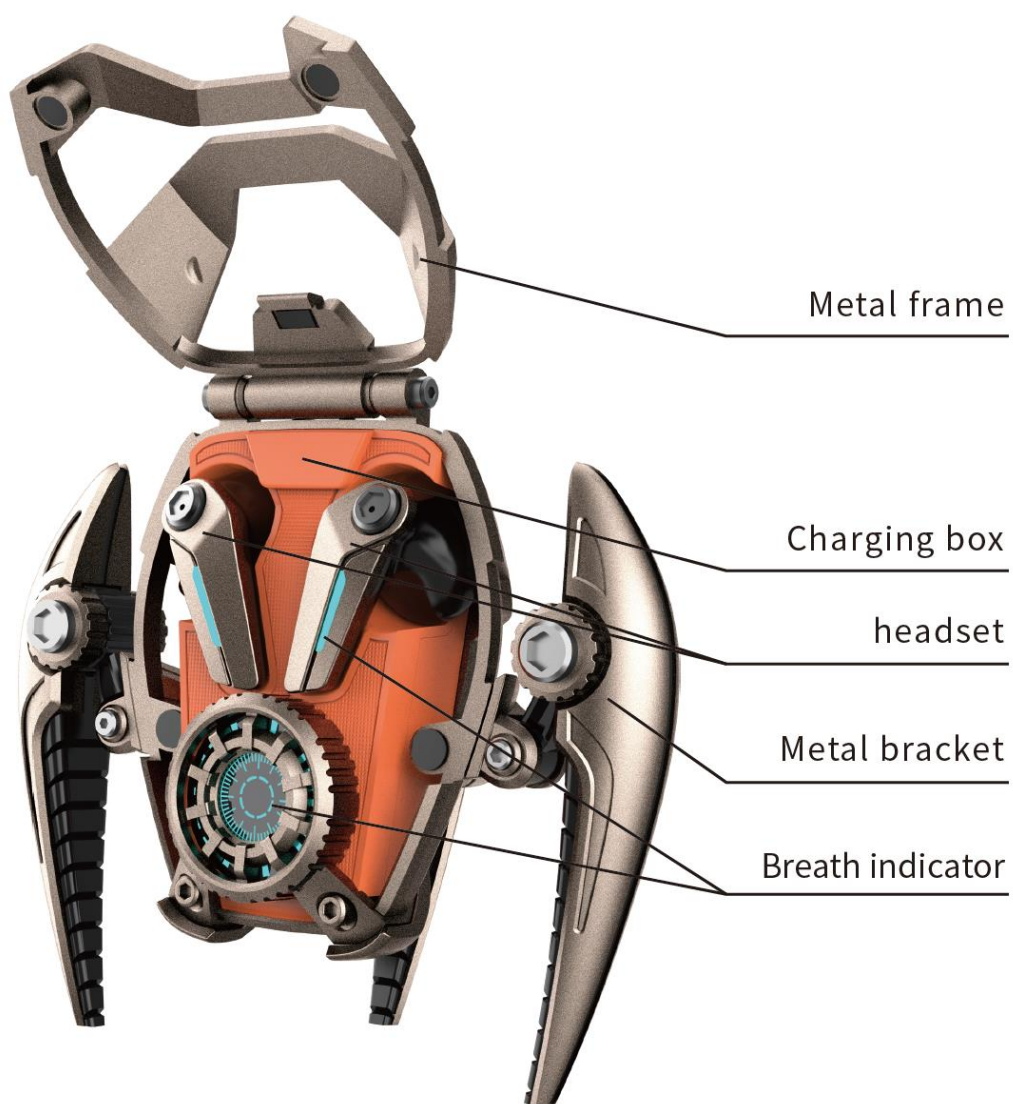
1. Open the upper cover of the charging box, and the headset will automatically turn on and pair.
2. Pair with other devices: open the Bluetooth settings of mobile phone or other devices, search for the Bluetooth name "CD-3", and click Connect Bluetooth.
3. Put the headset into the charging box, close the charging compartment cover, the headset will automatically shut down and enter the charging mode, and automatically power off when full.
4. The left and right headset of the CD-3 wireless headset can be separately connected to other Bluetooth devices.
5. If the CD-3 wireless headset is not connected to the Bluetooth device for 3 minutes, it will automatically shut down.

## Headphone touch function description

function	State	Action description
Power on	When charging/shutting down	Press and hold for 3 seconds/take out the headset
Shutdown	At startup	Press and hold for 5 seconds/warehousing charging
Language switching	When the phone is not connected	Three clicks on the left or right ear
Volume increase	During call/song	Double-click the right ear
Vol	During call/song	Double-click the left ear
Next song	When playing songs	Three strikes on the left ear
Previous song	When playing songs	Three strikes on the right ear
Play/Pause	When playing songs	Click the left or right ear
Answer/end	On call/on call/off call	Click the left or right ear
Reject call	When calling	Press and hold the left or right ear for 1.5 seconds
Siri Voice Assistant	Standby/song playing	Press and hold the left or right ear for 3 seconds
Low latency (game)/normal mode switching	After startup	Four clicks on the left or right ear
DUT mode	headset not connected / the phone is not connectednot	Five clicks on the left or right ear



## Operation tips





The electric box and metal bracket are detachable

**1 Manual pairing is required for first use**

Open the mobile phone Bluetooth, search for the device, and display CD-3 on the mobile phone  
Click to connect to

**2 After the first pairing, open the charging chamber, and it will automatically start up and pair automatically**



## matters needing attention:

1. Do not treat this product with violence, nor squeeze it with heavy objects, and keep away from high temperature and high humidity environment.
2. Keep away from high frequency transmitting equipment such as WIFI and router, which will affect the signal reception of the machine and cause the sound to be stuck and disconnected.
3. Please use this product within 10 meters of the effective environment, and there should be no physical barrier (such as wall) between the Bluetooth device and the headset.
