Wireless Speaker Specification

- **charge** External 5V charge for this machine , plug in the USB-C cable for charging, the LED light stays on during charging and turns off when fully charged
 - **ON/OFF** Hold M/⏻ key to ON/OFF. Press:mode switching.
Turn on the Bluetooth function on your phone, search for WONDERLIT and connect to Bluetooth
 - **The Key Operation**
 - 1, “ M/⏻ ” Short press:Bluetooth/ autodyne / FM.Double click is TWS function
 - 2, “ ⏮/V- ” Long press:Reduce volume
Short press: FM model for the previous station, Bluetooth mode is previous song.
The self timer mode short press “ ⏮/V- ” button for the self timer function
 - 3, “ ⏭/V+ ” Long press: Increase volume
Short press: FM Model for the next stage, the Bluetooth mode for the next song.
The self timer mode short press “ ⏭/V+ ” button for the self timer function
 - 4, “ 📞 ” FM / Bluetooth state short press play / pause . FM status
long press for the auto channel search.
Incoming short press the “ 📞 ”key to answer the phone .Long press to reject calls
Short press “ 📞 ” to hang up the call, double click the “ 📞 ” key to dial back the last telephone
 - **The Self Timer Funtion**
click "M", from the Bluetooth mode to the self timer mode
Turn on the Bluetooth function on your phone, search for "WONDERLIT" and connect to Bluetooth
open mobile phone camera interface, press "⏮/V- " or "⏭/V+ " button to take pictures
Attached: Android system requires 4.2.2 IOS requires version 6.0nd above, the other version does not support. Mobile phone with independent pictures button generally do not support.
- TWS connection method:
- I. Open two bluetooth speakers at the same time
 - II. Double-click the " M " key(Heard "tick" is ok)
 - III. Wait for the two bluetooth speakers to interconnect(Two speakers also appear the sound at the same time,express connect success)
 - IV. Open the phone bluetooth,search for the matching name for another bluetooth speaker and connect it
 - V. Two bluetooth speakers were connected successfully,and can start playing music
- Remark:**
1. Two bluetooth speakers that already connected successfully,can automatic connect another bluetooth speaker when open the speaker again. **Turn off TWS function: Double click the M key on one of the machines**
 - 2.If no automatic connection,please turn off the bluetooth,restart two speakers(didn't need press any key)
 3. When the two speakers automatic connect,open the phone bluetooth again and connect the two bluetooth speakers
