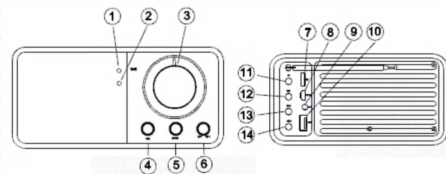

FUNCTION INTRODUCTION

Location of controls

1. Play/Charging light/FM indicator light. Blue light is on when playing, red light is on when charging. The radio works best when green light is on under FM mode.
2. Microphone position
3. FM radio station knob
4. Volume button
5. Adjust bass volume button
6. ON/OFF Switch
7. TF card socket
8. DC 5V charging port

9. AUX in socket. In FM mode, please connect with a 3.5mm data cable as movable antenna to search the channel.
10. USB plug
11. Mode conversion button
12. Previous Track/Volume Down: Press to play previous track, long press to decrease the volume.
13. Play/Pause: Press to pause and resume playback. Answering Phone Call: Press once to pause the track and answer incoming phone call, long press to reject incoming phone call.
14. Next Track/Volume Up: Press to play next track, long press to increase the volume.

PAIRING BLUETOOTH SPEAKER

1. Set the ON/OFF button to the ON position. The device will turn on - The blue signaling the BT mode will flashing quickly.
2. Turn on the Bluetooth function on your mobile device and search for the "TB-RETS-WOD"
3. Once the connection is successful the blue BT LED will light steadily.

Note: If a previously connected device comes within range of unit, the unit will connect to this device automatically.

CHARGING THE SPEAKER

Plug the pin of the Micro USB charging cable in to the micro usb socket on the back side of the speaker. Plug the other end into a USB Port on your computer or any other device allowing usb charging. It will shut off when the battery is fully charged.

SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Please read the instructions carefully before use and keep them for reference.
- Keep the speaker away from heat and open fire.
- Do not insert sharp objects and metal into the speaker to avoid a short circuit.
- Do not attempt to repair the speaker
- Turn the device off if exposed to extreme heat or liquid
- Do not attempt to use the speaker with AC input, be sure the device is unplugged from power and charged before each use.
