ENGLISH

1. Push and hold the Power button until the speaker turns on.
2. Push and hold the Bluetooth® button until the LED turns to a slow blue pulse.
3. Select **Willen II** from your audio device's Bluetooth list.

1 POWER BUTTON

Push and hold the power button to turn the speaker on or off.

2 BLUETOOTH BUTTON

Push and hold the Bluetooth button until the LED turns to a slow blue pulse to start pairing mode.

3 MICROPHONE

The microphone lets you use Willen II as a speaker phone. Push the Bluetooth button to toggle the call between the speaker and your phone.

4 BATTERY INDICATOR

The 5 segment battery indicator shows the battery charge.

5 CONTROL KNOB

- I. Play/pause – push once
- II. Skip backward/forward – push left/right
- III. Turn up/down the volume – push up/down
- IV. Receive/end a call – push once
- V. Reject a call – push twice

6 USB-C POWER INPUT

Charge the speaker by plugging it into a USB power source via the included USB-C lead.

7 FASTENING STRAP

Unhook the lower-right side of the strap by stretching it gently.
